RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition was granted to **Namrup College of Teacher's Education, P.O.-Parbatpur, Dist.-Dibrugarh, Assam-786623 (AS-S/N-25/96)** for conducting B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 60 seats *vide* order No. ERC/7-17/2001/528(6) dated 12/13.03.2001, followed by revised recognition for B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students (One Basic Unit) from the academic session 2015-2016 *vide* order No.F.ERC/NCTE/AS-S/N-25/96/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/31775 dt.20.05.2015, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, recognition of the institution was withdrawn *vide* Order No.F.No.ER-274.14.33/AS-S/N-25/96/B.Ed./2019/61400 dated 26.08.2019.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an Appeal against the order of ERC. The Appellate Authority *vide* its Order No. F.No.89-281/E-171746/2020 Appeal/3rd Mtg.-2021/20th January, 2021/97391 dated 11.02.2021 concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal, to be sent to them by the appellant, and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014.

4. AND WHEREAS, recognition of institution was again withdrawn by Order No. F.No.ER-302.18/AS-S/N-25/96/B.Ed./2022/65127 dated 03.03.2022 from the academic session 2022-2023 in terms of Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

5. AND WHEREAS, the institution preferred an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before NCTE-(HQ).

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the ERC in its 313th (Virtual) meeting of the ERC held on 16th November, 2022 and the committee decided as under:-

The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee observed that:

- *The Appeal Committee of the Council *vide* its Order No. F.No.89-130/E-253758/2022 Appeal/7th Meeting 2022/APPLERC202214361/114440 dated 19.10.2022 concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal which are required to be sent to them by the appellant institution and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.*

The Committee noted that the withdrawal order has already been set aside by the Appellate Authority; therefore, the recognition granted to the Institution for running B.Ed. programme is hereby restored.

The Committee further observed that:

- *In compliance of the Appeal Order, the institution has not submitted the documents to the office of ERC.*

The Committee, therefore, decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution for non-submission of documents as per order of the Appellate Authority to submit the same within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice.

Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 24.11.2022. The institution has submitted representation dated 26.11.2022 & 08.12.2022 which is received in ERC office on dated 30.11.2022 & 12.12.2022.


7. AND WHEREAS, the original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC in its 319th (virtual) meeting held on 25.01.2023 and the Committee observed that:-

- *The Appeal Committee of the Council vide its Order No. F.No.89-130/E-253758/2022 Appeal/7th Meeting, 2022/APPLERC202214361/114440 dated 19.10.2022 concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal which are required to be sent to them by the appellant institution and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time.*
- *As per decision taken by ERC in its 313th meeting, the institution was issued Show Cause Notice on 24.11.2022 for submission of documents as per orders of the Appellate Authority*
- *In compliance of the SCN, the institution submitted the documents to the office of ERC on 26.11.2022 & 08.12.2022.*

In view of above, the Committee decided that recognition granted to the institution vide Order dated 20.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of one unit (50 students) is hereby restored.

Orders may be issued accordingly.

8. NOW THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to the institution viz. **Namrup College of Teacher's Education, P.O.-Parbatpur, Dist.-Dibrugarh, Assam-786623** vide order No. ERC/NCTE/AS-S/N-25/96/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/31775 dated 20.05.2015 for B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 50 students (one units) is hereby restored.
