ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition was granted to Dharikshan Singh Teachers Training College, Vill.-Kulharia, Street/Road-NH-30, Taluka/Mandal-Ara, Town/City-Kulharia, Dist.-Bhojpur, Bihar-802160 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic Units of 50 Students Each) from the academic session 2016-17 vide order ER-213.6.11/ERCAPP2764 /B.Ed./2016/46171 dated 02.05.2016, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 and another vide order no. F.No.242.6.8/B.Ed.(Addl.Intake)/2017/54018 dated 02.08.2017 from the academic session 2017-18 followed by, vide order no. F.No.242.6.8/B.Ed.(Addl.Intake)/2017/54637 dated 11.10.2017 with an intake of 150 three basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2018-2019.

2. ANDWHEREAS, a letter No.NCTE-CDN016(13)/18/2018-CDN-HQ dated 02.08.2018 was received from NCTE HQ. In compliance of the said letter, the matter was placed before 284th meeting of ERC-NCTE held on 17-18 September, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue the show cause notice to the institutions which have been recognized without NET qualified teachers. Accordingly, first SCN was issued to the institution on dated 30.09.2020. The institution has not submitted any reply in response to First Show Cause Notice.

3. ANDWHEREAS, the matter was placed before ERC in its 303rd(Virtual) meeting held on 24th March, 2022 and the committee decided to issue final show cause notice under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to all ninety seven (97 TEIs). Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dated 09.04.2022. The reply of the institution was received in ERC on 11.05.2022.

4. ANDWHEREAS, the original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC in its 313th (virtual) meeting held on 16th November, 2022 and the Committee observed that:

“The institution has submitted its reply dated 11.05.2022 in response to the Final Show Cause Notice dated 09.04.2022 which is still deficient on the following grounds:

- ***The institution has submitted the list(s) of faculty approved on 13.09.2019 & 01.06.2017 by the affiliating university. The institution has not submitted the latest list of faculty duly approved by the affiliating University.***
- ***The institution has not appointed teaching faculty for Health and Physical Education, Fine Arts and Performing Arts.***

- ***The institution has not uploaded the requisite information on its web-site as required under clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time. From the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the academic session 2021-21, it is observed that the institution has not updated its website as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.***

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition for B.Ed. programme for basic and additional units be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.”

Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 24.11.2022.

5. **AND WHEREAS**,the institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqrs. against the ERC’s withdrawal order dated 24.11.2022. The Appellate Authority *vide* its Order No. F.No. F.No.89-39/E-290414/2023 Appeal/3rdMeeting, 2023 APPLERC202214493dated 07.03.2023 passed an order as under:-

“Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal which are required to be sent to them by the appellant institution and take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time. The Appellant is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal. The ERC is at a liberty to verify the submitted documents from the concerned issuing authority.”

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted a representation dated 11.03.2023 received in ERC office on dated 16.03.2023.

7. **AND WHEREAS**,the matter was considered by the ERC in its 324st(Virtual) meeting of the ERC held on 21.03.2023 and the committee decided as under:-

“The original file of the institution alongwith Appeal Order No. F.No.89-39/E-290414/2023 Appeal/3rdMeeting, 2023 APPLERC202214493/117455 dated 07.03.2023, other related documents submitted by the institution, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC.

The Committee noted that the withdrawal order 24.11.2022 has already been set aside by the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 07.03.2023 and remanded back to ERC for consideration, therefore, ERC decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running three units (one hundred & fifty students) of B.Ed. programme is hereby restored. Order be issued accordingly.

8. **NOWHEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to Dharikshan Singh Teachers Training College, Vill.-Kulharia, Street/Road-NH-30, Taluka/Mandal-Ara, Town/City-Kulharia, Dist.-Bhojpur, Bihar-802160 *vide* order No. F.No.242.6.8/B.Ed.(Addl.Intake)/2017/54637 dated 11.10.2017 for B.Ed. programmewith annual intake of 150 students (three units) is hereby restored.
