RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Swami Sahajanand Saraswati College, Plot No. 972 to 978 1011 12 1020 to 1050, Vill.- Bokaro Steel City-P.O- Sector-9, Tehsil/Taluka-Chas, Town/City-Bokaro, Jharkhand-827009** was granted recognition for **B.Ed. programme** of one year duration with an annual intake of **100 seats** Vide order No. ERC/7-148.6.1/NCTE/B.Ed./2013/15784 dated 18.01.2013 from the academic session 2013-2014, followed by revised recognition for B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats (Two Basic Unit) vide order No. F.ERC/NCTE/ERCAPP1185/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/32281 dated 27.05.2015 from the academic session 2015-2016, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter of non-submission of Performance Appraisal Report ("PAR") by the institution for academic session 2022-23 was considered by the Eastern Regional Committee in its Meeting no.362 held on 25.03.2025 and the Committee observed and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, an SCN was issued to the institution on 29.03.2025 and the institution has not submitted the reply of Show Cause Notice.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 366th Meeting held on 13th May 2025 and the Committee decided that the recognition/permission granted to "**Swami SahajanandSaraswati College, Plot No. 972 to 978 1011 12 1020 to 1050, Vill.- Bokaro Steel City-P.O- Sector-9, Tehsil/Taluka-Chas, Town/City-Bokaro, Jharkhand-827009**" be withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2025-2026 under Section 17 of NCTE Act, on the ground of non-submission of PAR for the academic session 2022-23.

4. **Accordingly**, withdrawal order No. NCTE/2025/ERC/PAR/ORDER/ERCAPP1185/(70684-70690) dated 15.05.2025 was issued to the institution.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, against the withdrawal order, the institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by filing Writ Petition W.P.(C) No. 11633/2025. The Hon'ble Court vide its interim order dated 05.08.2025 directed as under:

"13. In the meanwhile, having regard to the submissions noted hereinabove, which prima facie appears to have substance, and further regard being had to the fact that in similar matters stay has been granted while issuing notice, the operation of the

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Impugned withdrawal orders/decisions is stayed till the next date of hearing and the petitioners are permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students in the academic session 2025-26.

14. It is further directed that respondent/NCTE will issue a necessary public notice and upload the list of institutes on its website thereby intimating all concerned, including State authority, affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of such listed institutes have been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2025-2026, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE latest by 12.08.2025."

6. **Accordingly**, in compliance of the above directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, a Public Notice dated 11.08.2025 was issued in respect of the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, in the meantime the institution has also preferred statutory Appeal U/s 18 of the NCTE against the withdrawal order. The Appeal came to be disposed of vide Appeal Order No. 89-305/E-372702/2025 & 89-236/E-370344/2025 Appeal/6th Meeting, 2026 APPLERC202515208 & APPLERC202515044/E-89966 dated 11.05.2026. The operative part of the order reads as under:

"IV. DECISION:

After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the material available on record, the submissions of the appellant institution, the binding decisions of the General Body dated 25.11.2025, and the legal opinion of the Legal Division, the Appeal Committee, in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, hereby sets aside the impugned order dated 14.05.2025 and remands the matter to the Eastern Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with law. The appellant institution shall immediately forward all documents submitted along with the appeal to the Regional Committee concerned. The Eastern Regional Committee shall examine the matter afresh in terms of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE Regulations, 2014 (as amended), the binding decisions of the general body, and applicable guidelines, and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order within a time bound manner."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 25.05.2026 passed in W.P.(C) No. 11633/2025 further directed that the interim order dated 05.08.2025 shall continue till the next date of hearing i.e. 11.08.2026. The operative part of the order dated 25.05.2026 is as under:-


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"List on 11.08.2026.

Interim Orders to continue till the next date of hearing."

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted a representation dated 02.07.2026 along with relevant documents, with a request to issue a Public Notice thereby permitting the institution to participate in the counseling session for the academic session 2026-27.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter of the institution was placed before ERC in its 402nd Meeting held on 08-10th July, 2026 and the Committee decided as under:-

"Keeping in view the above the Committee decided as under:

- 1. Restoration order be issued to the institution for the B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students (2 Basic Units).**
- 2. The name of the institution may also be updated on the website of the NCTE in the list of recognized institutions and a letter be written to the Concerned Affiliating Body and the State Government."**

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above decision of the ERC, the recognition granted to "Swami Sahajanand Saraswati College, Plot No. 972 to 978 1011 12 1020 to 1050, Vill.-Bokaro Steel City- P.O- Sector-9, Tehsil/Taluka-Chas, Town/City-Bokaro, Jharkhand-827009 vide order No. ERC/7-148.6.1/NCTE/B.Ed./2013/15784 dated 18.01.2013 for B.Ed. Programme with an annual intake of 100 students (2 Basic Units) is hereby restored.
