ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research**, Po – Dev sangha – Bompas town, District – Deoghar, Jharkhand-814114 was granted recognition for:

- B.Ed. programme** of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) seats *vide* Order No. ERC/7-46(ER-46.6.4)/2004/2094 dated 12.07.2004 from the academic session **2004-2005** and additional intake of 100 seats, thus making total annual intake of 200 (two hundred) seats *vide* Order No ERC/7-140.6.23/NCTE/B.Ed./2012/13698 dated 25.08.2012 from the academic session **2012-2013** followed by Revised Recognition with an annual intake of 200 intake (four basic units) seats *vide* Order No F.ERC/NCTE/APE00219 & ERCAPP1074/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/32749 dated 31.05.2015 from the academic session **2015-2016**.
- D.El.Ed. programme** of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) seats *vide* Order No. ERC/7-55.6(8)/2005/1270 dated 20.04.2005 from the academic session **2005-2006**.
- M.Ed. programme** of one year duration with an annual intake of 25 (Twenty Five) seats *vide* Order No. ERC/7-83.6.(III)/1/2008/102088 dated 28.02.2008 from the academic session **2008-2009**, followed by Revised Recognition with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) seats *vide* Order No .ERC/NCTE/APE00735/M.Ed.(Revised Order)/ 2015/32690 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting M.Ed. programme of two year duration from the academic session **2015-2016** as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a complaint *vide* letter no. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 was received from NCTE(HQ) thereby forwarding the complaint dated 04.07.2023 requesting for strict action against the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the aforesaid complaint was considered by ERC in its 333rd (Virtual) meeting held on 27th September, 2023, and the committee decided that show cause notice under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

4. **Accordingly**, Show Cause Notice dated 17.10.2023 was issued to the institution. The institution has submitted the reply dated 26.10.2023 & 14.12.2024 to the office of ERC-NCTE.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was placed before ERC in its 358th Meeting held on 06th February, 2025 and the committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice.

6. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.02.2025 was issued to the institution. The institution has submitted the reply dated 06.03.2025 received in ERC office on 21.03.2025.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 382th Meeting Held on 17th November, 2025 and committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -



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- *First SCN was issued to the institution on 17.10.2023 and Final SCN was issued to the institution on 21.02.2025. The institution has submitted reply on 06.03.2025*

After carefully observing the reply to the final show cause notice, the ERC concluded the following:

1. *The institution has appointed only one teaching faculty of Fine Arts, music and Physical Education whereas there is the requirement of two teaching faculty each for Fine Arts, Music and Physical Education.*
2. *The several teaching faculties appointed by the institution is matching with B.Ed., M.Ed. and D.El.Ed. programme each other's which is not acceptable as per NCTE Regulations.*
3. *The total land area is 3724 sqmts as per CLU which is less than for running four-unit B.Ed. course, one unit D.El.Ed. course and one unit M.Ed. course.*
4. *The total built up area is 4774.56 sqmt for running four-unit B.Ed. course, one unit D.El.Ed. course and one unit M.Ed. course which is less than the requirement under NCTE Regulations amended from time to time.*
5. *The institution has not submitted approved Building Plan with course wise earmarked area for proposed course and existing course.*
6. *The institution has not submitted latest NEC issued by the Competent Government Authority.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. M.Ed. and D.El.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

7. Accordingly, Withdrawal order vide Order No. F. No.ER-382.35/NCTE/B.Ed.& B.Ed add./APE00219&ERCAPP1074/D.El.Ed./APE00444/M.Ed./APE00735/JH/2025/(72419-72425) date 02.12.2025 was issued to the institution.

8. AND WHEREAS, the institution has preferred appeal vide File No. 89-56/E-397517/2026 Appeal/3rd Meeting, 2026 APPLERC202615530/E-89493 Date 26.02.2026 before Appellate Authority, NCTE against the Withdrawal Order dated 02.12.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE decided to remand back the case to ERC.

9. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted the reply dated 09.03.2026 received in ERC office on dated 24.03.2026 as per appeal order The matter was placed before ERC in its 396th Meeting held on 07th May, 2026 and committee decided as under:-

Decision of ERC

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, Appeal Order passed by the NCTE-HQ, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:-

1. *The Withdrawal order No. F.No. ER-382.35/NCTE/B.Ed.& B.Ed Add./APE00219&ERCAPP1074/D.El.Ed./APE00444/M.Ed./APE00735/JH/2025 dated 02.12.2025 was issued in respect of B.Ed, M.Ed and D.El.Ed programmes on certain grounds.*
2. *The institution accordingly preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ against the order dated 02.12.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ, passed an order vide Order No. File No. 89-56/E-397517/2026 Appeal/3rd Meeting, 2026 APPLERC202615530/E-89493 Date 26.02.2026 which is as under:*

"After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 02.12.2025 and remand back the case to ERC for fresh consideration strictly in accordance with the direction specified hereinabove. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of the Appeal order".

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3. The institution has submitted the reply dated 09.03.2026 received in ERC office on 24.03.2026.

In view of the above, the committee decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order No. F.ERC/NCTE/APE00219 & ERCAPP1074/B.Ed. (Revised Order)/2015/32749 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed programme, ERC/7-55.6(8)/2005/270 dated 20.04.2005 for D.El.Ed programme and F.ERC/NCTE/APE00735/M.Ed./(Revised Order)/2015/32690 dated 31.05.2015 for M.Ed programme be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly.

Further, the committee decided that the show cause notice be issued to the institution to submit the reply on deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice on following grounds.

1. The institution is required to appoint one professor for M.Ed programme as per NCTE Regulation amended from time to time.

10. **NOWTHEREFORE**, in term of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted for **Dev Sangha Institute of Professional Studies and Educational Research**, Po – Dev sangha – Bompas town, District – Deoghar, Jharkhand-814114 for running B.Ed. programme vide Order No. ERC/7-55.6(8)/2005/270 dated 20.04.2005, followed by Revised order vide order no. F.ERC/NCTE/APE00219 & ERCAPP1074/B.Ed. (Revised Order)/2015/32749 dated 31.05.2015 & for D.El.Ed. Programme vide Order No. ERC/7-55.6(8)/2005/1270 dated 20.04.2005 & M.Ed. Programme vide Order No F.ERC/NCTE/APE00735/M.Ed./(Revised Order)/2015/32690 dated 31.05.2015 is hereby restored.
