ORDER

Dated: 02/01/2026

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Godda College, PO./Dist.-Godda, Jharkhand-814134** was granted recognition for B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) seats vide Order No. ERC/7-60.6.9/2005/243-251 dated 12.09.2005 from the academic session **2005-2006** followed by restoration recognition vide Order No ERC/7-191.12.19/APE00437/B.Ed./2015/34588 dated 07.08.2015 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a complaint letter vide no. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 was received from NCTE (HQ) thereby forwarding the complaint dated 04.07.2023 requesting for strict action against the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the aforesaid complaint was considered by ERC in its 333rd (Virtual) meeting held on 27th September, 2023, and the committee decided that show cause notice under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on the following grounds:-

“The original file of the institution and the letter No. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 received from NCTE (HQ), other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee decided that to seek the following document from the institution:

- Latest faculty duly approved by the affiliating body concerned to be submitted.
- Uploading of documents on the web-site of the institutions as required under clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- Copy of renewed FDRs in respect of Endowment & Reserve Fund along Form “A” duly signed by the Manager of the issuing bank concerned.
- Fire Safety Certificate, Building Safety Certificate, Land Use Certificate and Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Building Plan with course demarcation and Building Completion Certificate duly approved by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution through Bank duly certificated by the disbursing bank for the last 6 months is required to be submitted.

In view of above, the Committee also decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice.”

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4. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice dated 17.10.2023 was issued to the institution.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has not submitted to SCN within specific time. The matter was considered by ERC in its 356th meeting of ERC held on 10 January 2025 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution and the letter No. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 received from NCTE (HQ), other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee decided that to seek the following document from the institution:

The First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide dated 17.10.2023 with a direction to submit reply within 15 days, on the following deficiencies, but the institution has not submitted its reply within specific time.

- Latest faculty duly approved by the affiliating body concerned to be submitted.
- Uploading of documents on the web-site of the institutions as required under clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- Copy of renewed FDRs in respect of Endowment & Reserve Fund along Form "A" duly signed by the Manager of the issuing bank concerned.
- Fire Safety Certificate, Building Safety Certificate, Land Use Certificate and Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Building Plan with course demarcation and Building Completion Certificate duly approved by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution through Bank duly certificated by the disbursing bank for the last 6 months is required to be submitted.

In view of above, the Committee also decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice."

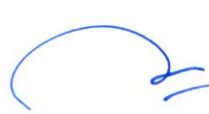
6. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice dated 22.01.2025 was issued to the institution

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply dated 04.02.2025 received in the office of ERC-NCTE on 14.02.2025. The matter was placed before 360th meeting of ERC held on 03rd March 2025 and the committee decided as under:

The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Reply of Final Show Cause Notice, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were considered by ERC:-

1. The institution has appointed one Principal and four Lecturers only for tow unit of B.Ed. course which is less than NCTE Regulations.
2. The institution has not submitted latest Fire Safety Certificate duly approved by the Competent Government Authority.

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3. *The Institution has not submitted copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.*
4. *The Institution has not submitted a copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate duly approved by the Government Competent Authority.*
5. *The institution has submitted a copy of Building Plan approved Assistant Engineer, Building Sub-Division-I, Godda which is not readable.*
6. *The institution has submitted salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution through Bank certificated by the Indian Bank for the last 6 Months which is not clear.*

Hence, Committee has decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order”

8. **Accordingly,** Withdrawal Order dated 18.03.2025 was issued to the institution.
9. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution has preferred an appeal before the NCTE Appellate Authority against the withdrawal order dated 18.03.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE passed an order *vide* Order No. 89-156/E-366233/2025 Appeal/11th Meeting, 2025 APPLERC202515041/32943 dated 26.09.2025 decided to remand back the case to ERC.
10. **AND WHEREAS,** in compliance of the Appeal Order dated 26.09.2025, the institution has submitted reply dated 09.10.2025 which has been received in the office of ERC-NCTE on 27.10.2025. The matter was placed before 384th meeting of ERC held on 09th – 10th December 2025 and the committee decided as under:

“Decision of ERC:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *The institution was recognized for two units of B.Ed course. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn on 18.03.2025 on certain grounds.*
- *The institution has preferred appeal before the NCTE Appellate Authority against the withdrawal order dated 18.03.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE passed an order *vide* Order No. 89-156/E-366233/2025 Appeal/11th Meeting, 2025 APPLERC202515041/32943 dated 26.09.2025 which is as under:-*

After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the council concluded to set aside the Withdrawal Order dated 18.03.2025 and remand back the case to ERC to carefully re-examine the matter. Verify the authenticity and relevance of all documents submitted and pass a reasoned order strictly in accordance with the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the

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receipt of order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

- *The institution has submitted reply dated 09.10.2025 received in the office of ERC on 27.10.2025.*

In view of the above, the committee decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. ERC/7-60.6.9/2005/243-251 dated 12.09.2005 be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly."

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to **Godda College, PO./Dist.-Godda, Jharkhand-814134** for conducting B.Ed. programme vide Order No ERC/7-191.12.19/APE00437/B.Ed./2015/34588 dated 07.08.2015 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) is hereby restored.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the Official Gazette.
