WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Jagannath Jain College, At/PO- Jhumri Telaiya, Dist – Koderma, Jharkhand – 825409** was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. programme of one year duration vide Order No. ERC/7-191.12.14/APE00425/2015/34289 dated 27.07.2015 with an intake of 100 seat from the academic session 2015-2016, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a complaint dated 21.11.2024 has been received from Dr. Sanjay Kumar against Smt. Rimjhim Rukhriyar and Sh Ashok Abhishek working in Jagannath Jain College for using forge/fake certificate.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 354th Meeting held on 04th June, 2025 and committee decided that:-

“The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee observed that:

The complaint documents submitted by Dr. Sanjay Kumar be forwarded to concerned university for authentication and needful action.”

4. **Accordingly**, A letter was issued by ERC-NCTE on 17.12.2024 to the Registrar Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh, Jharkhand for authentication of the documents submitted by Dr. Sanjay.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the university has not informed in this regard. Thereafter, two reminders was also issued to the concerned university on 12.02.2025 & 17.03.2025 respectively. However, no reply has been received to till date.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 367th Meeting held on 04th June, 2025 and committee decided that:-

“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *A Complaint letter has been received in the O/o ERC.*

After carefully observing the content of the complaints, the ERC concluded the following:

1. *The institution is required to submit latest faculty duly approved by the affiliating body concerned in the prescribed format to be signed and stamped on the document.*
2. *The institution is required to submit salary statements indicating salary paid to each faculty appointed in the institution through Bank.*
3. *Further, a copy of complaint be forwarded to institution and affiliating body for taking needful action on priority basis under intimation of ERC office.*

In view of above, the Committee has decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of

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issue of show cause notice. Further, a copy of complaint be forwarded to the affiliating body for taking needful action on priority basis under intimation to O/o ERC."

7. **Accordingly**, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dated 03.07.2025. The institution has submitted the reply of Show Cause Notice on 12.08.2025.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 374th Meeting held on 25th -26th August 2025 and committee decided that:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

1. *First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 03.07.2025. Accordingly, they have submitted the reply 12.08.2025.*

After carefully observing the reply to SCN along with other related documents, the ERC concluded the following:-

1. *The institution is required to submit latest faculty -list in the prescribed format as per NCTE Regulations.*
2. *The institution is required to submit the documents/bank statements duly certified by the bank establishing that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT for the last six months.*
3. *Further, the said complaint be also forwarded to the concerned university with a request for taking needful action on priority basis under intimation to this office.*

In view of above, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution before withdrawal of recognition to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice.

9. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 18.09.2025.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has not submitted reply to Final SCN which was issued to the institution on 18.09.2025. The matter was placed before 384th meeting of ERC held on 09th – 10th December 2025 and the committee decided as under:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *First SCN was issued to the institution on 03.07.2025 on certain grounds. The institution had not submitted the reply against the First SCN.*
- *Thereafter, the final SCN was issued to the institution on 18.09.2025. however, the institution has not submitted reply of Final SCN which was issued on 18.09.2025.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

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11 NOW THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to **Jagannath Jain College, At/PO- Jhumri Telaiya, Dist – Koderma, Jharkhand – 825409** for running B.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session next following the date communication of withdrawal order.

09. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
