WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Kazigram College of Education**, Plot No-5472, 5476, Street/Road – Madapur, Vill-Madapur, P.O-KG, Chandipur, Town/City-Malda, Dist-Malda, West Bengal-732103 was granted recognition for conducting D.El.Ed. programme of two year duration with an intake of 50 students (one basic unit) Vide Order No. F.No.ER-218.6.3/ERCAPP3884/D.El.Ed./2016/48768 Date 03.08.2016, as per NCTE Regulation 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter vide letter no. NCTE-C/PG011/49/2025-Complaint Section-HQ dated 21.07.2025 has been received from the Complaint Section, NCTE (HQ).

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before 374th meeting of ERC meeting held on 25-26th August 2025 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution.

4. **Accordingly**, Show cause notice dated 18.09.2025. However, the institution has not submitted reply of Show cause notice which was issued to the institution dated 18.09.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 394th Meeting held on 01st April, 2026 and committee decided to issue Final Show Cause notice to the institution.

6. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice dated 20.04.2026 was issued to the institution. However, the institution has submitted the reply dated 20.04.2026 received in ERC office on 05.05.2026.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, Again the matter was placed in ERC in its 396th Meeting held on 07th May, 2026 and committee decided under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, complaints, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

1. *First SCN was issued to the institution on 18.09.2025 on certain grounds. The institution had not submitted the reply.*
2. *Thereafter, the final SCN was issued to the institution on 20.04.2026 as per decision of the 394th meeting of ERC held on 01st April, 2026. Accordingly, the institution has submitted reply on 05.05.2026.*

After carefully observing the reply of final show cause notice, the ERC concluded that the reply is satisfactory and decided that no further action is required in respect of B.Ed Course. A letter be issued to the institution accordingly.

Further, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running D.El. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order on following grounds.

1. *The institution has not submitted latest faculty-list in the prescribed format for D.El.Ed. programme as per NCTE Regulations.*
2. *The institution has not submitted the documents/bank statements duly certified by the bank establishing that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT for the last six months for D.El.Ed programme.*

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8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted **Kazigram College of Education**, Plot No-5472, 5476, Street/Road – Madapur, Vill-Madapur, P.O-KG, Chandipur, Town/City-Malda, Dist-Malda, West Bengal-732103 for running D.El.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session next following the date communication of withdrawal order.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
