WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, **A.S. College, PO/Dist.-Deoghar, Jharkhand – 814112** was granted recognition for B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) seats *vide* Order No. ERC/7-59.6.2/2005/2740 dated 12.08.2005 from the academic session **2006-2007** followed by restoration recognition *vide* Order No ERC/7-191.12.18/APE00439/B.Ed./2015/34580 dated 07.08.2015 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a complaint letter *vide* no. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 was received from NCTE (HQ) thereby forwarding the complaint dated 04.07.2023 requesting for strict action against the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the aforesaid complaint was considered by ERC in its 333rd (Virtual) meeting held on 27th September, 2023, and the committee decided that show cause notice under section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on the following grounds:-

"The original file of the institution and the letter No. NCTE-C/PG011/88/2023-Complaint Section-HQ/121408 dated 12.09.2023 received from NCTE (HQ), other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee decided that to seek the following document from the institution:

- *Latest faculty duly approved by the affiliating body concerned to be submitted.*
- *Uploading of documents on the web-site of the institutions as required under clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.*
- *Copy of renewed FDRs in respect of Endowment & Reserve Fund along Form "A" duly signed by the Manager of the issuing bank concerned.*
- *Fire Safety Certificate, Building Safety Certificate, Land Use Certificate and Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.*
- *Building Plan with course demarcation and Building Completion Certificate duly approved by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.*
- *Salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution through Bank duly certificated by the disbursing bank for the last 6 months is required to be submitted.*

In view of above, the Committee also decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice."

4. **Accordingly**, Show Cause Notice dated 17.10.2023 was issued to the institution. The institution has not submitted reply of show cause notice which was issued on 17.10.2023 within the stipulated time.

5. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice dated 27.03.2025 was issued to the institution. However the institution has submitted reply dated 09.04.2025 received in ERC office on 17.04.2025.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 367th Meeting held on 04th June, 2025 and committee decided that:-

“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *The institution has submitted reply to the final show cause notice.*

After carefully observing the reply to the final show cause notice, the ERC concluded the following:

1. *The institution has submitted faculty list of 1+ 9 for B.Ed. course for two unit (100 students) which is less as per NCTE Regulation 2014. Also the Staff list submitted by the institution is not in the prescribed format.*
2. *The institution did not submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority*
3. *The institution has submitted Land Use Certificate on the letter head of the Institution, which is not a competent authority.*
4. *The institution has submitted Non Encumbrance Certificate dated 28.10.2004 issued by Nibhandan Padadhikari. Hence, the institution did not submit the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect.

7. **Accordingly**, Withdrawal Order dated 03.07.2025 was issued to the institution.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has preferred an appeal before NCTE Appellate Authority against the Order No. 367.24/NCTE/APE00439/B.Ed./JH/2025 (71192-71197) dated 03.07.2025 was issued to the Institution and the NCTE Appellate Authority in its Order dated 26.09.2025 decided to remand back the case to ERC.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the appeal order dated 26.09.2025, the institution has not submitted reply. The matter was placed before 381st meeting of ERC held on 03rd – 04th November 2025 and the committee decided as under:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, Appeal order dated 26.09.2025, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:

- *Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 03.07.2025.*
- *The institution had preferred an appeal before the Appeal Authority wherein the Appellate Authority has passed an order dated 26.09.2025 with directions to the institution to forward the documents submitted in appeal to the ERC within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.*
- *The institution has not submitted reply as per direction of the appeal order dated 26.09.2025.*

After carefully observing the online application form, appeal order dated 20.08.2025, along with other related documents, the ERC found the following:

1. *The institution not submitted reply as per direction of the appeal order dated 26.09.2025. Hence the institution is required to submit reply as per direction of the appeal order dated 26.09.2025.*

Hence, the committee decided that the show cause notice be issued to the institution to submit the reply through the portal on the deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice.

10. **Accordingly,** Show Cause Notice dated 25.11.2025 was issued to the institution.

11. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution has submitted reply which was received in the office of ERC-NCTE on 05.12.2025. The matter was placed before 384th meeting of ERC held on 09th – 10th December 2025 and the committee decided as under:

“Decision of ERC:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *The institution was recognized for two units of B.Ed course. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn on 03.07.2025 on certain grounds.*
- *The institution has preferred appeal before the NCTE Appellate Authority against the withdrawal order dated 03.07.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE passed an order vide Order No. 89-392/E-379062/2025 Appeal/12th Meeting, 2025 APPLERC202515349/33043 dated 26.09.2025 which is as under:-*

After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the council concluded to set aside the Withdrawal Order dated 03.07.2025 and remand back the case to ERC with a direction to carefully re-examine the matter regsoned order strictly in accordance with the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

- *As per decision of ERC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 25.11.2025. The institution has submitted reply dated 05.12.2025.*

In view of the above, the committee decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. ERC/7-59.6.2/2005/2740 dated 12.08.2005 be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly.

12. **NOW THEREFORE**, in term of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted tor **A.S. College, PO/Dist.-Deoghar, Jharkhand – 814112** for running B.Ed. Programme vide Order No ERC/7-191.12.18/APE00439/B.Ed./2015/34580 dated 07.08.2015 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) is hereby restored.
