WITHDRAWAL ORDER

Dated: 6/11/2025

WHEREAS, DAV College of Teacher Education, Koraput, Plot No-445, Street No.- Ashoknagar, Vill. Kumbha ii, PO – Koraput, Tehsil/Taluka-Koraput, Town/ City –Koraput, Dist. Koraput, Odisha – 764020 was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 20 from the academic session 2014-2015 vide ERC's order F.No. ERC/7-169.11.12.17/NCTE/B.Ed.- Additional Intake/2014/24231 dated 24.04.2014, followed by Revised Recognition for B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order F.ERC/NCTE/OR-S/E-17/96 & ERCAPP1865/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/32689 dated 31.05.2015 as per NCTE Regulation, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course was withdrawn by ERC in its 274th meeting held from 15th -16th July, 2019 from the academic session 2020-2021 and the withdrawal order dated 05.08.2019 was issued to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the withdrawal of ERC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs., and the Appellate Authority in order dated 13.12.2019 confirms the order of withdrawal.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, again the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs., and the Appellate Authority in its orders dated 31.11.2019 and 22.05.2023 decided that “....the same issue adjudicated by the Appeal Committee for the second time, hence the current order dated 13.12.2019 will continue to stand.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed a court case in W.P© no. 1825/2024 & CM APPL.7639/2024 and it has directed as “...the petitioner is permitted to submit its latest faculty list to the appellate committee within two days from today. If so submitted, the said faculty list would also be taken into consideration by the Appellate Committee”.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution preferred an appeal before NCTE (HQ) and the Appellate Authority in its order dated 27.02.2024 decided as under:

“.....After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the council concluded to remand back the case to ERC with a direction to verify the submitted document field by the appellant institution with Appeal from the record available with ERC and if it feel necessary and appropriate then documents may also verified from the concerned complement authority. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal with in 15days from the receipt of order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above”.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted documents on 03.04.2024. The same was considered by ERC in its 343rd meeting of ERC held on 09.05.2024 and the committee decided for show cause notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of ERC, a Show Cause Notice dated 17.05.2024 was issued to the institution.

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5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has not submitted reply to SCN dated 17.05.2024. The matter was placed before 353rd meeting of ERC held on 13th -14th November, 2024 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee observed that:

The First Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide dated 17.05.2024 with a direction to submit reply within 21 days, on the following deficiencies, but the institution has not submitted its reply within specific time.

- *Principal is not qualified.*
- *Seven Assistant professor appointed are not qualified as they do not have M.Ed Degree.*

In view of the above, the Committee has decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice on the above deficiencies."

6. **AND WHEREAS**, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.11.2024. The institution has submitted its reply on 30.12.2024.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 374th Meeting held on 25th - 26th August, 2025 and committee decided that:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, reply of RPRO, guidelines issued from time to time, a letter from Special Secretary to Government of Odisha, Department of Higher Education to the RD/ERC dated 05.06.2025 mentioning that the deficiencies regarding the engagement of faculties in the respect of TEIs have been taken care by the Government of Odisha on priority basis and all possible steps are being taken to fill up these vacancies as per NCTE norms, were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

1. *Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 26.11.2024. Accordingly, they have submitted the reply on 30.12.2024.*

After carefully observing the reply to Final SCN along with other related documents, the ERC concluded the following:-

1. *The institution has appointed teaching faculty namely at Sr. 15. Sri Pradeep Sabar, Sr. No.16 Sri Dolamani Kumbhar, Sr. No.17. Dr. Rakhee Nayak, Sr. No. 18. Dr. Purna Chandra Tanti, Sr. No.20. Smt Sashmita Nayak and Sr. No. 21. Dr. Dillip Kumar Dalai are found not qualified due to not having M.Ed degree as per requirement of NCTE Regulation, 2014.*

2. *The institution has not appointed the faculty in performing arts (Music/Dance/ Theatre) as per requirement of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order."

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to DAV College of Teacher Education, Koraput, Plot No-445, Street No.- Ashoknagar, Vill. Kumbha ii, PO – Koraput, Tehsil/Taluka-Koraput, Town/ City –Koraput, Dist. Koraput, Odisha – 764020 for running B.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session next following the date communication of withdrawal order."

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9. Further, the institution and affiliating body are also hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

10. **FURTHER**, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
