WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Veer Kunwar Singh University, Department of Education, Dist.-Bhojpur, Ara, Bihar-802301** (Code No.APE00529) was granted recognition for B.Ed. course with an intake of 100 vide ERC's order No. ERC/7-69.6.1/2006/3508 dated 04.10.2006, followed by revised order vide No.F.ERC/NCTE/APE00529/B.Ed.(Revised Order)2015/32507 dated 30.05.2015 with an intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014

2. **AND WHEREAS**, a complaint dated 30.07.2024 was received from the Complaint Section, NCTE (HQ). The complaint was placed before 353rd meeting of ERC held on 13th – 14th November 2024 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee observed that:

Taking into consideration, the facts of the complaint, the committee decided to seek report from the affiliating University. Copy may be endorsed to the applicant also."

3. In view of the above decision of ERC, a letter dated 11.12.2024 was issued to the Registrar, Veer Kunwar Singh University to seek report. However, in response to letter dated 11.12.2024, no reply has been received to till date.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the letter No. F.No./NCTE-C/PG012/4/2024- Complaint Section Hqrs./ Computer No.85166/126237 dated 30.07.2024 has been received from the Complaint Section, NCTE (HQ). The matter was again placed before 358th meeting of ERC meeting held on 06 February 2025 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Complaint Letter dated 30.07.2024, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were considered by ERC:

- 1. The institution is required to submit copies of appointment letters and joining reports clearly mentioning the name and Saving Bank account number of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed. programme and also stating therein that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should be supported with documents like photocopy of passbook of each of faculty, showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months.*
- 2. A copy of updated Teaching faculty issued by the Registrar of the concerned affiliated university/body alongwith with PAN card copies is required to be submitted.*

In view of the above, the Committee has decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of issue of show cause notice on the above deficiencies."

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice dated 21.02.2025 was issued to the institution.


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5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution/university has not submitted reply of Show Cause Notice which was issued on 21.02.2025 within the stipulated time.

6. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice dated 27.03.2025 was issued to the institution. The institution has not submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice in stipulated time.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 367th Meeting held on 04th June, 2025 and committee decided that:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *A complaint dated 30.07.2024 was received.*
- *Show Cause Notice dated 21.02.2025 was issued to the institution followed by the Final Show Cause Notice dated 27.03.2025. However, no reply has been received to till date.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

8. **Accordingly**, Withdrawal order vide Order No. F.No.ER-367.26/NCTE/B.Ed /APE00529/BR/2025/(71198-71202) date 03.07.2025 was issued to the institution.

9. **ANDWHEREAS**, the institution has preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE against the Order dated 17.12.2025 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE decided to remand back the case to ERC.

10. **ANDWHEREAS**, the institution has submitted the reply dated 09.01.2026 as per appeal order. The matter was placed before ERC in its 387th Meeting held on 16th January, 2025 and committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

1. *The institution was recognized for two units of B.Ed course. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn on 03.07.2025 on certain grounds.*
2. *The institution filed an appeal against the Order no. F.No.ER-367.26/NCTE/B.Ed. /APE00529/BR/2025/(71198-71202) dated 03.07.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and the NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:*

"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 03.07.2025 and remand back the case to ERC with a direction to carefully re-examine the matter, verify the authenticity and relevance of all documents submitted, and pass a reasoned order strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, and Regulations. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

3. *The institution has submitted reply dated 03.01.2026 received in the office of ERC on 13.01.2026.*

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In view of the above, the committee decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. ERC/7-69.6.1/2006/3508 dated 04.10.2006 be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly. Further, the committee decided that the show cause notice be issued to the institution to submit the reply through the portal on deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice on following grounds.

- *The institution has not submitted copies of appointment letters and joining reports of the teaching faculty.*
- *The institution is required to submit Saving Bank account number of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed. programme being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should be supported with documents like photocopy of passbooks of each of faculty, showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months.*
- *The institution is required to submit the PAN card details of Teaching Faculty.*

11. *Accordingly, Restoration order was issued and also Show Cause Notice dated 23.02.2026 was issued to the institution and the institution has not submitted the reply of Show Cause Notice dated 23.02.2026.*

12. *AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed again in ERC in its 398th Meeting held on 10-11th June, 2026 and committee decided as under:-*

Decision of ERC

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *The institution was recognized for two units of B.Ed course. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn on 03.07.2025 on certain grounds.*
- *The institution filed an appeal against the Order no. F.No.ER-367.26/NCTE/B.Ed./APE00529/BR/2025/(71198-71202) dated 03.07.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and the NCTE Appellate Authority decided to set aside the impugned order dated 03.07.2025 and remand back the case to ERC with a direction to carefully re-examine the matter, verify the authenticity and relevance of all documents submitted, and pass a reasoned order strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, and Regulations.*
- *The institution submitted reply dated 03.01.2026 received in the office of ERC on 13.01.2026.*

After careful examination of the Appeal order, documents submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. ERC/7-69.6.1/2006/3508 dated 04.10.2006 be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly. Further, the committee decided that the show cause notice be issued to the institution to submit the reply on deficiencies mentioned above within 15 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice on following grounds:

1. *The institution has not submitted copies of appointment letters and joining reports of the teaching faculty.*
2. *The institution is required to submit Saving Bank account number of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed. programme being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should be supported with documents like photocopy of passbooks of each of faculty, showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months.*

3. The institution is required to submit the PAN card details of Teaching Faculty

Accordingly, restoration order was issued and also Show Cause Notice dated 23.02.2026 was issued to the institution. However, the institution has not submitted the reply.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 7 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice on the deficiencies mentioned above.

13. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice dated 18.06.2026 was issued to the institution and the institution has not submitted the reply of Final Show Cause Notice.

14. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed again in ERC 403rd Meeting held on 22-23rd July, 2026 and committee decided as under:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the ERC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

- 1. Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 18.06.2026. Accordingly, they have not submitted the reply.*

After carefully observing the reply to Final SCN along with other related documents, the ERC concluded that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds: -

- 1. The institution has not submitted copies of appointment letters and joining reports of the teaching faculty.*
- 2. The institution is required to submitted Saving Bank account number of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed. programme being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should be supported with documents like photocopy of passbooks of each of faculty, showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months.*
- 3. The institution is required to submit the PAN card details of Teaching Faculty.*

Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2027-2028.

15. **NOW THEREFORE,** in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to **Veer Kunwar Singh University, Department of Education, Dist.-Bhojpur, Ara, Bihar-802301** for running running B.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the end of academic session 2027-2028..

16. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

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17. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
