WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Kumri Vivekananda B.Ed. College, Plot No- 2481, 2483, 2494, Street No- 64, Vill- Kumari (Mathpara), PO- Gopalpurghat, Tehsil/Taluka- Tehatta, Town/City- Karimpur, Dist- Nadia, West Bengal- 741122** was granted recognition for B.Ed. programme of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2017-2018 vide ER-239.6.77(Part-3)/ERCAPP3686/B.Ed./2017/52728 dated 02.05.2017 as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, two complaints dated 01.09.2023 & 03.10.2023 received from the Registrar of Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education University (BSAEU) in the office of ERC against the existing teacher training institutions regarding short comings/deficiencies prevailing in the institutions.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the aforesaid complaint was considered by ERC in its 336th meeting held on 20th December, 2023, and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on the following grounds:-

"The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, two Complaints dated 01.09.2023 & 03.10.2023 received from the Registrar of Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education University (Erstwhile WBUTTEPA), Kolkata, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, was considered by ERC and the Committee noted the following:

- Latest faculty duly approved by the affiliating body concerned to be submitted
- The institution has not uploaded the essential documents on the website of the institution as required under clause 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- Copy of renewed FDRs in respect of Endowment & Reserve Fund along Form "A" duly signed by the Manager of the issuing bank concerned to be submitted.
- Fire Safety Certificate, Building Safety Certificate, Land Use Certificate and Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Building Plan with course-wise demarcation and Building Completion Certificate duly approved by the Competent Government Authority to be submitted.
- Salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution through Bank duly certificated by the disbursing bank for the last 6 months is required to be submitted.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice."

4. **Accordingly**, Show Cause Notice dated 06.02.2024 was issued to the institution.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply to SCN dated 06.02.2024 received in ERC office on 20.02.2024. Further, a complaint letter vide letter no. NCTE-C/PG012/95/2024-Complaint Section-HQ dated 08.04.2025 has been received from the Complaint Section, NCTE (HQ) alongwith a letter dated 01.10.2024 of the complainant namely Sh. Arabindu Barai. The matter was placed before 363rd meeting of ERC-NCTE held on 21th April, 2025, the committee considered the matter and decided as under:-

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"The original file of the institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, reply of First Show Cause Notice, Complaint letter dated 01.10.2024, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were considered by ERC:

1. *The institution has submitted faculty list approved by the Affiliating University i.e Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education University (Erstwhile WBUTTEPA), which is not in prescribed format. Seal and Signature of the approving authority is not clear.*
2. *The institution has submitted latest copy of renewed FDRS in respect of Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund. But the institution has not submitted Form 'A' duly signed by the Manger of the issuing bank.*
3. *The institution has not submitted land use certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.*
4. *The institution has not submitted Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.*
5. *The institution has submitted BCC wherein the total build up area of 8145.66 sq ft is allotted for the teacher education programme which is less than as per NCTE Regulation.*
6. *The institution has submitted copy of salary statement for payment of salary paid to the faculty appointed in the institution which is not clear.*
7. *The institution is required to submit copies of appointment letters and joining reports clearly mentioning the names and Saving Bank account numbers of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed programme and also stating therein that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should be supported with documents from banks , showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months*

In view of the above, the Committee has decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 15 days from the date of issue of show cause notice on the above deficiencies.

6. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.05.2024.

7. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply dated 17.05.2025 which has been received in the office of ERC-NCTE on 21.05.2025. The matter was placed before 384th meeting of ERC held on 09th – 10th December 2025 and the committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *First SCN was issued to the institution on 06.02.2024. The institution submitted the reply on 20.02.2024.*
- *Final SCN was issued to the institution on 07.05.2025. The institution submitted reply on 17.05.2025.*

After carefully observing the reply to the final show cause notice, the ERC concluded the following:

1. *The institution has not submitted land use certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.*
2. *The institution has submitted BCC wherein the total built up area is 8145.66 sq ft which is lesser than what is required as per NCTE Regulation.*
3. *The institution has not submitted copies of appointment letters, joining reports and the documents clearly mentioning the names and Saving Bank account numbers of each of the faculty appointed for B.Ed programme and also that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT. It should have been supported with concerned documents from banks, showing the disbursement of salary through bank account to individual faculty members for last six months.*

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Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order.

8. Accordingly, Withdrawal order vide order dated F.No.ER-384.8/NCTE/B.Ed./ERCAPP3686/WB/2025/ Date 02.01.2026 was issued to the institution.

9. ANDWHEREAS, the institution has preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE against the Order dated 02.01.2026 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE decided to remand back the case to ERC and the institution has submitted reply dated 08.06.2026 received in ERC office on 09.06.2026.

10. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed again in ERC in its 398th Meeting held on 10-11th June, 2026 and committee decided as under:-

Decision of ERC

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Appeal Order passed by the NCTE-HQ, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- *The institution was recognized vide ERC order ER-239.6.77(part-3)/ERCAPP3686/B.Ed./2017/52728 date 02.05.2017 for conducting B.Ed course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two units) from the academic session 2017-2018.*
- *Withdrawal order vide order dated F.No.ER-384.8/NCTE/B.Ed. /ERCAPP3686 /WB/2025 / Date 02.01.2026 was issued to the institution on certain grounds. .*
- *The institution preferred appeal before Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ against the order dated 01.01.2026 and the Appellate Authority, NCTE-HQ, passed an order vide Order No. File No. 89-103/E-401400/2026 Appeal/7th Meeting, 2026 APPLERC202615556 Date 02.06.2026 which is as under:*
"After careful consideration of the Appeal Report, the impugned order, the records available on file, and the submissions made by the appellant institution, the Appeal Committee of the Council, in exercise of appellate jurisdiction under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, concluded to remand the matter to the Eastern Regional Committee (ERC) for limited factual verification and regulatory reassessment. Accordingly, the impugned order dated 02.01.2026 shall remain kept in abeyance until the ERC takes an appropriate decision after examination of the submissions of the appellant institution vis-à-vis the verified substance of the complaint and verification of staff/faculty particulars from the affiliating University, strictly in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993, Rules and the NCTE Regulations, 2014."
- *The institution has submitted reply letter dated 08.06.2026 received in the ERC office on 09.06.2026 as per direction contained in the appeal order.*

After careful examination of the submissions of the appellant institution and the faculty particulars properly verified by the registrar of the affiliating University, the Committee has decided that the recognition of the institution granted vide order no. ER-239.6.77(part-3)/ERCAPP3686/B.Ed./2017/52728 date 02.05.2017 be restored. Concerned Affiliating Body be informed accordingly.

11. NOW THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to Kumri Vivekananda B.Ed. College, Plot No- 2481, 2483, 2494, Street No- 64, Vill- Kumari (Mathpara),

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PO- Gopalpurghat, Tehsil/Taluka- Tehatta, Town/City- Karimpur, Dist- Nadia, West Bengal- 741122 for running B.Ed. vide order No. ER-239.6.77(part-3)/ERCAPP3686/B.Ed./2017/52728 date 02.05.2017 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) is hereby restored.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the Official Gazette.
