WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Banuali and Ajiran Teachers Training Institute**, Vill/PO - Radhakrishnapur, Dist - South 24 Parganas, West Bengal - 743373 was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. programme of one year duration with an intake of 100 students vide Order No. ERC/7- ER-130.6(i).20/2011/11244 dated 20.05.2012 followed by Revised Recognition order of two year duration with an intake of 100 students vide F. ERC/NCTE/(ERCAPP178)/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/32489 date 30.05.2015 from the academic session 2015-2016, as per NCTE Regulation 2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, A letter vide letter no. F.No.NCTE-C/PG011/391/2025-Complaint Section-HQ/134391 Dated 26.12.2025 has been received from Complaint section, NCTE (HQ).

3. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was placed before 387th meeting of ERC meeting held on 16th January, 2026 and Committee decided that Show Cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on the following grounds:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, Complaint dated 26.12.2025 received from NCTE-HQ, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed and decided to the issued first show cause notice. **Accordingly**, Show Cause Notice dated 20.02.2026 was issued to the institution and the institution has submitted the Reply dated 07.03.2026 received in ERC office on 24.03.2026.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before ERC in its 396th Meeting held on 07th May, 2026 and committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

1. First SCN was issued to the institution on 20.02.2026. Accordingly, the institution has submitted the reply on 07.03.2026.

After carefully observing the reply to the show cause notice, the ERC concluded the following:

1. The institution is currently functioning with only five (05) teaching faculties and the Principal. Hence, the institution is required to submit latest teaching faculty approved from concerned affiliating Body in prescribed format for B.Ed. Course as per NCTE Regulation amended from time to time.
2. The institution is required to submit the list of total students admitted in B.Ed. Course duly countersigned by affiliating body.



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3. The institution is required to submit (i) copies of appointment letters and joining reports of the teaching faculties in respect of B.Ed. Course (ii) the documents clearly mentioning the names of the teaching faculties and Saving Bank account numbers of each of the faculties appointed for B.Ed.Course programme and (iii) the documents/bank statements duly certified by the bank establishing that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT for the last six months.
4. The institution is required to submit details of the resolution of the society.
5. The institution is required to submit details of PAN and Aadhar No of the respective members of the society.
6. The institution has submitted FDRs which is very old and not in joint operation with Regional director, ERC, NCTE. Hence, the institution is required to submit details of FDRs in respect of the B.Ed. Course in joint operation as per NCTE Regulation amended from time to time.
7. The institution is required to submit AUDIT REPORT for the Year 2024-2025

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Final Show Cause Notice be issued under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the institution to submit reply within 7 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice on the deficiencies mentioned above.

6. **Accordingly**, Final Show Cause Notice dated 20.05.2026 was issued to the institution and the institution has not submitted the reply.

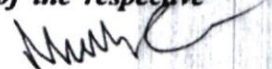
7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed again in ERC 403rd Meeting held on 22-23rd July, 2026 and committee decided as under:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the ERC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

1. Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.05.2026. Accordingly, they have not submitted the reply.

After carefully observing the reply to Final SCN along with other related documents, the ERC concluded that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds: -

- 1. The institution is currently functioning with only five (05) teaching faculties and the principal. Hence, the institution is required to submit latest teaching faculty approved from concerned affiliating Body in prescribed format for B.Ed. Course as per NCTE Regulation amended from time to time.*
- 2. The institution is required to submit the list of total students admitted in B.Ed. Course duly countersigned by affiliating body.*
- 3. The institution is required to submit (i) copies of appointment letters and joining reports of the teaching faculties in respect of B.Ed. Course (ii) the documents clearly mentioning the names of the teaching faculties and Saving Bank account numbers of each of the faculties appointed for B.Ed. Course programme and (iii) the documents/bank statements duly certified by the bank establishing that the faculties are being paid salary through cheque/RTGS/NEFT for the last six months.*
- 4. The institution is required to submit details of the resolution of the society.*
- 5. The institution is required to submit details of PAN and Aadhar No of the respective members of the society.*



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6. The institution has submitted FDRs which is very old and not in joint operation with regional director, ERC, NCTE. Hence, the institution is required to submit details of FDRs in respect of the B.Ed. Course in joint operation as per NCTE Regulation amended from time to time.

7. The institution is required to submit AUDIT REPORT for the Year 2024-2025.

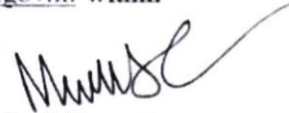
Hence, Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for running B.Ed. Programme be withdrawn under Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the academic session 2027-2028.

8. NOW THEREFORE, in terms of above decision of ERC, the recognition granted to **Banuali and Ajiran Teachers Training Institute**, Vill/PO - Radhakrishnapur, Dist - South 24 Parganas, West Bengal - 743373 for running running B.Ed. programme is hereby withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2027-2028.

9. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act:-

If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing recognition under sub-section (1), or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.

10. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 in the "Online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of the issue of the order.
