RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely Naveen Bharti B.Ed. College, Khasra No. 1357, VPO- Khood, Tehsil- Danta Ramgarh, Sikar Road, District- Sikar-332023, Rajasthan for conducting of B.Ed. Programme of one year duration with annual intake 100 vide Order No.F.NRC/NCTE/RJ-989/2008/59244-50 dated 26.08.2008 followed by Revised Order vide F.No./NRC/NCTE/F-7/RJ-989/2015/104555-60 dated 25.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with annual intake of 100 (2 basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to compliance of conditions mentioned therein.

2. AND WHEREAS, the PAR matter was considered by WRC in its 416th Meeting held on 20th – 21st March 2025, wherein the Committee decided as under:

“As per provisions contained in Section 12 (k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, it is mandatory for all the recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to fill the Performance Appraisal Report (PAR).

In pursuance to the decision taken by the Council in its 61st General Body Meeting held on 5th August 2024, a public notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued inviting online applications for filling Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE portal. The last date of submission of PAR was 10.11.2024 which was extended to 10.12.2024 and further extended to 31.12.2024.


The Regional Director, NCTE apprised the Committee members about the status of the institutions which have submitted PAR on the on-line portal.

Committee noted the status of PAR applications submitted by the institutions through online PAR Module. Committee further decided that Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to all the remaining recognised Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) who failed to submit duly filled in PAR through online mode for the academic session 2022-2023 giving 15 day time to submit the reply failing which appropriate action will be taken as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations.”

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution through online mode dated 30.04.2025.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter of institutions (including this institution), which have not filled PAR/not submitted reply to the show cause notices/ reply to the show cause notices received but reply not accepted was considered by WRC in its 424th (Part-I) Meeting held on 20th – 23rd May 2025, wherein the Committee decided as under:

"On careful consideration of the reply/non-submission of reply to the show cause notice(s) of the Teacher Education institution, NCTE Act, 1993 Rules and Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the WRC decided that the recognition granted to the institutions for the Programme(s) mentioned against each institution be withdrawn u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2025-26.

The institution are not permitted to make further admissions in the above Teacher Education Programme henceforth w.e.f. 2025-2026.

The WRC further decided that before issue of Withdrawal order, the Regional Director may re-verify that the institutions have not submitted the reply to the Show Cause Notice."

Accordingly, as per decision of the Committee withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide Order No.NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/RJ-989/6861-6865 dated 29.05.2025.


4. AND WHEREAS, being aggrieved with the withdrawal Order dated 29.05.2025 the institution has filed an appeal at NCTE, Hqrs. dated 03.08.2025. The Appellate Authority vide its order dated 26.09.2025 remanded back the case to WRC with a direction re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, and guidelines issued from time to time. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

5. AND WHEREAS, the appeal remand back Order dated 26.09.2025 was considered by WRC in its 437th (Part-III) Meeting held on 03rd October 2025, wherein the Committee decided as under:

"The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Western Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- i. *The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide order dated 26.08.2008 followed by revised recognition order dated 25.05.2015 for B.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 100 students (2 units).*
- ii. *The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by WRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/RJ-989/6861-6865 dated 29.05.2025.*
- iii. *The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 26.09.2025 concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 29.05.2025 and remanded back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.*

In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed of two-year duration. However, the said Institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Western Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order. The order be issued accordingly."



6. **NOW, THEREFORE,** the Western Regional Committee hereby restores recognition of **Naveen Bharti B.Ed. College, Khasra No. 1357, Vpo- Khood, Tehsil- Danta Ramgarh, Sikar Road, District- Sikar-332023, Rajasthan** for **B.Ed. programme two years duration** with an annual intake of **100 (two basic units)**.

7. The conditions mentioned in the Revised Order vide No./NRC/NCTE/F-7/RJ-989/2015/104555-60 dated 25.05.2015 shall remain unchanged.
