The institution does not fulfil the requirements for recognition laid down in the regulations notified in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and therefore the Committee further lays down conditions which are to be complied as follows–

1. Construction work be expedited.
2. Hostel and quarters should be provided as per NCTE norms.
3. Working hours be according to NCTE norms.

The institution is advised to send a compliance report upto 31 January, 1998 as to the removal of deficiencies so that a new team may be sent to verify the same.

If the construction of hostel and staff quarters has not yet been started then, at least, an approved plan may be obtained and construction started. The progress should be mentioned in the report.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee grants recognition to **Dinkarao K. Shinde College of Education, Gandhinglaj, Dist. Kolhapur** for **B.Ed.** course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 80 students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
2. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
3. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/State Government.
4. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
5. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
6. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
7. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 7 above.

ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 D.K. SHINDE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, CHH. SHAHU INSTITUTE OF BUSINESS EDU & RESEARCH TRUST SHIVAJI UNIVERSITY ROAD KOLHAPUR had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. of one year duration, from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- or
- (iii) The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in rented premises.
 - (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. two lakhs.
 - (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal/Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to D.K. SHINDE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, CHH. SHAHU INSTITUTE OF BUSINESS EDU & RESEARCH TRUST SHIVAJI UNIVERSITY ROAD KOLHAPUR for B.Ed. of one year duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with and annual intake of 100 students subjects to fulfillment of the following.

- (a) The institution shall ensure that it gets duly affiliated for this course to the concerned university and all other formalities required by the university are also completed before the commencement of the course and admission of the students to the course and a report to this effect should sent to the Committee.
- (b) That the institution will ensure that 08 (one Principal and 07 lecturers) faculty members are in position for an intake of 100 or less students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Registrar of the concerned University shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course. For intake of students in excess of the prescribed limit, the number of full time teachers shall be increased proportionately.
- (c) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.

- (d) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- (e) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating university shall ensure that, among other things, an institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal/Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE/UGC/affiliating University)
5. Further, the recognition is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


