RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **D.K. Shinde College of Education, 163/1/k/2, 163/1/d, Mal Maruti, Kadgaon Road, Gijawane, Gadhinglaj, Kolhapur, Maharashtra-416502.** For B.Ed. programme of 2 (two) years duration for the academic session 1997-1998 with an annual intake of 80 students Vide Order WRC/5-6/97/4676-77 dated 25.11.1997.

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **D.K. Shinde College of Education, 163/1/k/2, 163/1/d, Mal Maruti, Kadgaon Road, Gijawane, Gadhinglaj, Kolhapur, Maharashtra-416502.** For B.Ed. programme of 2 (two) years duration for the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 80 students Vide Order WRC/5-6/20/2000/7524-29 dated 05.10.2000.

WHEREAS, the Increase Intake recognition order was granted to the institution namely **D.K. Shinde College of Education, 163/1/k/2, 163/1/d, Mal Maruti, Kadgaon Road, Gijawane, Gadhinglaj, Kolhapur, Maharashtra-416502.** For B.Ed. programme of 2 (two) years duration for the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students Vide Order WRC/5-6/59/2004/6163-68 dated 17.09.2004.

AND WHEREAS, the Revised Recognition order was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2015-2016 with an annual intake of (one basic unit of 50 students each) Vide order No. WRC/APW0547/113085/2015/144804 dated 31.05.2015.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding Compliance by the institutions of the condition of the revised recognition order, was placed before the WRC in its 255<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22-24 June, 2016 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted Compliance.

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC show cause notice was issued vide No. Ref. No. Ref. No./WRC/APW0547/113085/MH/2016/177341-342 dated: 23 December, 2016.

4. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply vide letter No. Ref.No.DKSCE/Document in Compliance /2016-17 dated: 12 January, 2017.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 416<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

*"The matter was considered by WRC in its meeting and as per decision taken by the Western Regional Committee, Show cause Notice to provide reasonable opportunity to submit representation before withdrawal of the above recognition/permission u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the ground of non-submission of the PAR for the academic session 2022-23 was issued by the WRC to the institution through online mode on 31.03.2025, a copy of the same was also sent through speed post."*

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC show cause notice was issued vide No. Ref. No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/APW0547/113085 dated: 31 March, 2025.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in 421<sup>st</sup> meeting of WRC held on 05<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 and committee decided as under:-

*"Institutions who have not filled PAR (2022-23) and did not submit reply of Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 within stipulated time period of 15 days, recognition to teacher education programmes in all such cases be withdrawn from the academic session next following the issuance of withdrawal order with a copy to all concerned.*

*2. Withdrawal orders be issued to all such Teacher Education Institutions after verification of their records/ status of recognition from the physical files/e-files/scanned records."*

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution vide Order No. File No. File No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW0547/113085 dated 26.05.2025.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an appeal against the Withdrawal order No. File No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW0547/113085 dated 26.05.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:

*"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 14.05.2025 and remand back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions specified hereinabove. The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order, the documents submitted along with the appeal, whereupon the Regional Committee shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the directions contained herein."*

8. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was considered by the WRC in its 437<sup>th</sup> (Part-III) meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> October, 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

"The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Western Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -


- (i) The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 80 students vide order dated 25.11.1997 and enhanced intake to 100 vide order dated 17.09.2004 followed by revised recognition order dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. course of two year duration with annual intake of 50 students (1 unit).
- (ii) The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by WRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW0547/113085 dated 26.05.2025.
- (iii) The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 18.08.2025 concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 26.05.2025 and remanded back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

**"In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed of two-year duration. However, the said Institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Western Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order. The order be issued accordingly."**

11. NOW THEREFORE, the Western Regional Committee hereby restores recognition of D.K. Shinde College of Education, 163/1/k/2, 163/1/d, Mal Maruti, Kadgaon Road, Gijawane, Gadhinglaj, Kolhapur, Maharashtra-416502 for B.Ed. programme 2 years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (One basic unit of 50 students each).


