RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Thakur Educational Trust, Thakur ShyamNarayan High Schools BLDG. Opposite Dream Park, Thakur Village, Kandivali (E), Mumbai, Maharashtra- 400101.** For B.Ed. (CO-ED) programme of 2 (two) years duration for the academic 2008-2009 with an annual intake of 100 students Vide Order No. WRC/5-6/100th/2008/32494-32499 dated 03.04.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the revised recognition was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2010-2011 with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) for the academic session 2015-2016 Vide order No. WRC/APW04462/123537/2015/46792 dated 31.05.2015

AND WHEREAS, the Corrigendum was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme for the name change as "Thakur Shyamnarayan College of Education & Research (B.Ed.), High School's Bldg., Opp to Dream Park, Thakur Village, Kndivli (E) Mumbai, Maharashtra- 400101" in place of "Thakur Educational Trust, Thakur Shyamnarayan, High School's Bldg. Opposite to Dream Park, Thakur Village, Kandivli (E) Mumbai, Maharashtra-400101." Vide order No. WRC/APW04462/123537/2015/46792 dated 31.05.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the Order for reduction of Unit/Intake was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme for the 100 students (two units of 50 students each) to 50 students (one unit of 50 students) Vide order No. F.No.NCTE/WRC/APW04462/123537/B.Ed./387th/MH/2023/223464 dated: 30.06.2023.

AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding Compliance by the institutions of the condition of the revised recognition order, was placed before the WRC in its 255th meeting held on 22-24 June, 2016 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institution which have not submitted Compliance.

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC show cause notice was issued vide No. Ref. No.WRC/APW04462/123537/MH/2016/182207-208 dated: 17.03.2017.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 416th Meeting held on 20th to 21st March 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

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"The matter was considered by WRC in its meeting and as per decision taken by the Western Regional Committee, Show cause Notice to provide reasonable opportunity to submit representation before withdrawal of the above recognition/permission u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the ground of non-submission of the PAR for the academic session 2022-23 was issued by the WRC to the institution through online mode on 23.04.2025, a copy of the same was also sent through speed post."

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC show cause notice was issued vide No. **Ref. No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/123537** dated. **07.04.2025**.

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in 424th meeting of WRC held on 20 May, 2025 and committee decided as under:-

1. Institutions who have not filled PAR (2022-23) and did not submit reply of Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 within stipulated time period of 15 days, recognition to teacher education programmes in all such cases be withdrawn from the academic session next following the issuance of withdrawal order with a copy to all concerned.
2. Withdrawal orders be issued to all such Teacher Education Institutions after verification of their records/ status of recognition from the physical files/e-files/scanned records.

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution Vide order No. File No. **NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/123537/2471-2475** dated **26.05.2025**

7. AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal against the Withdrawal order No. File No. **NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/123537/2471-2475** dated **26.05.2025** before NCTE Appellate Authority and NCTE Appellate Authority Vide order dated: **13.09.2025** decided as under:

"The said institution filed an appeal against the WRC Order No. File No. **89-223/E-369847/2025 Appeal /8th Meeting, 2025 APPLWRC202515141/E-87631** dated **18.08.2025** before NCTE Appellate Authority vide dated: **18.08.2025** and NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:

After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record, and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to remand back the case to Western Regional Committee with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time. The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within fifteen (15) days from the receipt of order of appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above."



WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 437th (Part-III) meeting held on 03rd October, 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

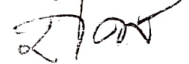
"The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Western Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- (i) The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 03.04.2008 followed by revised recognition order dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 100 students (2 units) and thereafter granted permission for reduction of intake to 50 vide order dated 30.06.2023.
- (ii) The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by WRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/123537/2471-2475 dated 26.05.2025.
- (iii) The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 18.08.2025 concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 26.05.2025 and remanded back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed of two-year duration. However, the said Institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Western Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order. The order be issued accordingly."

11. NOW THEREFORE, the Western Regional Committee hereby restores recognition of Thakur Shyamnarayan College of Education & Research (B.Ed.), High School's Bldg., Opp to Dream Park, Thakur Village, Kndivli (E) Mumbai, Maharashtra- 400101 for B.Ed. programme 2 year's duration with an annual intake of 50 students.
