RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely ANANT SHIKSHAN SANSTHAN KUNDALIKRAO NAGARE ADHYPAK VIDALAYA D.ED, TQ.RISOD TQ.RISOD, CITY WASHIM, MAHARASHTRA for D.El.Ed. programme of 2 (two) years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (One basic unit) Vide Order No. WRC/5-6/102nd (2<sup>nd</sup> Sitting)/2008/31461-31466 dated 26.03.2008

2. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 374<sup>th</sup> WRC meeting held on October 18-19, 2022 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 04.01.2023.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter has considered in WRC in 377<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause notice was issued to the institution dated 04.01.2023.

4. AND WHEREAS, the decision taken by the General Body of the Council (NCTE), Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued by NCTE with direction to all recognized teacher education institutions to submit PAR for academic session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 through online mode on the NCTE portal. The last date to submit PAR was 10.11.2024, which was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently extended to 31.12.2024 by NCTE vide public notice dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024.

In addition to above public notices, multiple attempts through press release, regular reminder emails and video messages of the Chairperson and Member Secretary of NCTE in this regard were uploaded across all major social media platforms for all the recognized teacher education institutions for timely submission of the PAR.

Above all directions issued vide above referred public notice. The institution has not submitted PAR for the academic session 2022-2023.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 416<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

*"The matter was considered by WRC in its meeting and as per decision taken by the Western Regional Committee, Show cause Notice to provide reasonable opportunity to submit representation before withdrawal of the above recognition/permission u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the ground of non-submission of the PAR for the academic session 2022-23 was issued by the WRC to the institution through online mode on 24.04.2025, a copy of the same was also sent through speed post."*

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC show cause notice was issued vide No. Ref. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/APW04015/122872 dtd. 15.04.2025.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in 424<sup>th</sup> meeting of WRC held on 20.05.2025 and committee decided as under:-

*"On careful consideration of the reply/non-submission of reply to the show cause notice(s) of the Teacher Education institutions, NCTE Act 1993, Rules and Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the WRC decided that the recognition granted to the institutions for the Programme(s) mentioned against each institution be withdrawn u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2025-26.*

*The institutions are not permitted to make further admissions in the above Teacher Education Programme henceforth w.e.f. 2025-2026.*

*The WRC further decided that before issue of Withdrawal order, the Regional Director may re-verify that the institutions have not submitted the reply to the Show Cause Notice."*

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution vide Order No. File No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW04015/122872/5835-40 dated 27.05.2025.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an appeal against the Withdrawal order No. File No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW04015/122872/5835-40 dated 27.05.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:

**Decision:-**

*"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to remand back the case to WRC with a direction re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, and guidelines issued from time to time. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the SRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above."*

8. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was considered by the WRC in its 437<sup>th</sup> (Part-III) meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> October, 2025 wherein the Committee decided as under:-

*"The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Western Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -*

- (i) *The institution was granted recognition for D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide order dated 26.03.2008.*
- (ii) *The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by WRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW04015/122872/5835-40 dated 27.05.2025.*

- (iii) The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 26.09.2025 concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 27.05.2025 and remanded back the case to Western Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

*In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for D.El.Ed of two-year duration. However, the said Institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Western Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order. The order be issued accordingly."*

11. **NOW THEREFORE**, the Western Regional Committee hereby restores recognition of Anant Shikshan Sanstha, Kundlikrao Nagare Adhyapak Vidyalaya (D.Ed.) Kankarwadi, Tq Risod Dist Washim, Maharashtra for D.El.Ed. programme 2 years duration with an annual intake of 50 (one basic unit) i.e.50 students.
