**RESTORATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, “MAT College of Education, Narwar Road, Village Satanwada, AB Road, Shivpuri-473551, Madhya Pradesh” was granted recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session vide Order No.WRC/5-6/100<sup>th</sup>/2008/31936-31941 dated 31.03.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution Vide Order No. WRC/APW04038/223497/100/2015/137528-41 dated 27.05.2015 for B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units 50 students each) from the academic session 2015.2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 225<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on June 22<sup>nd</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued the institution on 28.09.2016. the institution has submitted reply received on 12.02.2018.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 268<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on February 09<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued the institution on 15.02.2017.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 310<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and the Committee decided as under:-

*“The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 15/02/2017 but no reply was submitted by the institution.*

*Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.”*

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Withdrawal Order No. WRC/APW04038/223497/B.Ed./310<sup>th</sup> /2019/205902 to 205909 dated 04.09.2019.

6. AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed W.P.(C)7290/2021 dated 30.07.2021 challenging the WRC withdrawal order dated 04.09.2019 and The High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, the details as under:-

*“The proceedings in the matter have been conducted through video conferencing.”*

1. Issue notice. Mr. Jai Sahai Endlaw, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-National Council for Teacher Education ["NCTE"]. The petition is taken up for disposal with the consent of learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner was granted recognition by Western Regional Committee ["WRC"] of the NCTE for its B.Ed. course on 31.03.2008. A revised recognition order was issued on 27.05.2015, pursuant to the notification of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. However, the WRC withdrew the petitioner's recognition by an order dated 04.09.2019. The petitioner approached this Court against the withdrawal order by way of W.P.(C) 12567/2019. By an order dated 19.02.2020, the Court set aside the withdrawal order of the WRC and restored the recognition of the petitioner for the academic session 2020-21. The matter was remanded to the WRC for a fresh decision on the petitioner's case. The matter remains pending with the WRC since then.
3. In these circumstances, the withdrawal order having been set aside by this Court, there is no impediment to the petitioner's participation in counselling or admitting students, until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is issued by the WRC.
4. Consequently, the WRC is directed to restore the petitioner's status as a recognised institution for the year 2021-22 and subsequently until a fresh recognition order is passed. The WRC will issue a restoration of recognition order within one week and also incorporate the petitioner's name on its website as a recognised institution. The NCTE is also directed to inform the petitioner's affiliating university and the concerned department of the State Government within the same period.
5. The petition, alongwith the pending application, stands disposed of in these terms."

7. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 459<sup>th</sup> (Part-II) held on 06<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> May 2026, wherein Committee observed as under:-

The Committee noted that the institution has filed the court case W.P. No- 7290/2021 before the hon'ble high court of Delhi and the court has passed order dated: 30.07.2021 with following directions:

*"The proceedings in the matter have been conducted through video conferencing.*

1. Issue notice. Mr. Jai Sahai Endlaw, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-National Council for Teacher Education ["NCTE"]. The petition is taken up for disposal with the consent of learned counsel for the parties.



*In view of the above, the Committee decided that in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 30.07.2021, the recognition for the B.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each). The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance."*

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Court Orders dated 30.07.2021, the Western Regional Committee hereby restores the recognition of "MAT College of Education, Narwar Road, Village Satanwada, AB Road, Shivpuri-473551, Madhya Pradesh for B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).
