ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to MAHARISHI VEDVYAS MAHAVIDYALAYA, RUN BY-DHARAM SHIKSHA SAMITI, JUNGIPUR, GWALIOR, MADHYA PRADESH under section 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.ED course vide order No.WRC/5-6/105/2008/39756-39761 dated 25.08.2008 with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, the recognition of B.ED course of the said institution was withdrawn by WRC vide order No.WRC/APW03867/223488/131/2010/66681 dated 06.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had preferred an appeal before Council (NCTE) u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993, against the withdrawal order dated 06.04.2010 and the Council vide order No.89-348-2009-Appeal-A17902 dated 07.06.2010 accepted the appeal and set aside WRC order dated 06.04.2010 and the case was remanded to WRC to consider the reply of the institution dated 20.01.2010 and passed an appropriate speaking order.

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid appeal order was placed in the 139th meeting of WRC held from August 13-14, 2010 and the Committee decided that recognition for B.ED course be withdrawn. Accordingly, withdrawal order issued to the institution on 25.08.2010 on the following grounds:-

- Building is inadequate.
- Staff not qualified as per the NCTE norms.

AND WHEREAS, the institution again preferred an appeal against the aforesaid withdrawal order and the Council vide an order dated 19.11.2010 accepted the appeal and reversed WRC's order dated 25.08.2010 with direction to the WRC for allowing the institution a period of two months to select and appoint qualified staff through duly Constituted Selection Committee and to grant recognition to the institution with prospective effect if it fulfills the requirement.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before WRC in its 143rd meeting held from October 17-18, 2010 and the Committee decided that letter be issued to the institution to appoint qualified staff as per NCTE norms within 2 months. Accordingly, letter issued to the institution on 22.01.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the institution did not submit any reply. Reminder letter was issued to the institution on 11.05.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the representation dated 14.06.2012 submitted by the institution was placed before WRC in its 174th meeting held from November 19-21, 2012 and the Committee decided that recognition for B.ED course be withdrawn. Accordingly, withdrawal order issued to the institution on 21.01.2013 on the following grounds:-

- Since no reply was sent by the institution a reminder was issued on 11.5.2012. Vide the letter of the institution dt. 14.6.2012, the institution informed that all the shortcomings will be fulfilled within the time limit. However, till date there has been no further communication from the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the institution again preferred an appeal to the Appellate Authority of NCTE, New Delhi under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid withdrawal order.

AND WHEREAS, the Appellate Authority passed an order No. 89-146/2013Appeal dated 22.05.2013. The Council decided that the appeal deserved to be rejected and the order of the WRC be confirmed.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had filed W.P. No.5297/2013 before Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Gwalior and the Hon'ble High Court had passed an order dated 30.12.2013.

AND WHEREAS, the court order was placed in the 201st meeting of WRC held on February 19-22, 2014 and it was decided that the institute be asked to submit some documents. Accordingly letter issued to the institution on 24.02.2014 to submit the following documents:-

- (i) Consolidated staff profile approved by the affiliating University;
- (ii) Experience certificate of the Principal; and
- (iii) As per the management affidavit, the institution has appointed one Principal and eight lecturers, out of these eight lectures, two are part-time - Music and Sports teacher. Thus there is a shortage of one lecturer.

AND WHEREAS, the WRC considered the reply dated 25.02.2014 received on 05.03.2014 submitted by the institute along with supporting documents in its 204th meeting held on April 03-04, 2014 and decided as follows:-

"In this case, recognition was granted for B.Ed. (100 seats) vide WRC order dated 20.08.2008. Recognition was withdrawn on 06.04.2010 on various grounds. Vide Appeal Order dated 07.06.2010, WRC order was set aside with the direction that an appropriate speaking order be passed. After reconsideration, the WRC again passed a withdrawal order dated 25.08.2010. The petitioner went in appeal, and the Appellate Authority in order dated 19.11.2010 accepted the appeal reversing the WRC's order, and directed the WRC to allow the institution a period of two months to select and appoint qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee and to grant recognition to the institution with prospective effect, if it fulfills the requirement. The matter was then seen in the 174th meeting (November 19-21, 2012). The WRC saw that the institution had not given any reply to the letter dated 22.01.2011. Thus reminder dated 11.05.2012 was issued to the institution. The institution then replied that it will fulfill the shortcomings but after 14.06.2012 did not send any communication to the WRO. Accordingly, when the matter came up in the next meeting, Recognition was refused vide withdrawal order dated 21.01.2013. The petitioner went in appeal and in appeal also vide order dated 22.05.2013, the appeal was dismissed. The petitioner has again approached the Hon'ble High Court vide their order dated 26.11.2013, the Hon'ble High Court have again remanded back the matter to WRC to take a fresh decision in regard to Withdrawal of Recognition of the petitioner. After the court order, some papers have been filed by the petitioner. These were examined. It is seen that the petitioner has filed affidavits, one on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper by the Management, and affidavits from each faculty member on Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper. However, some important documents which are required under the NCTE Regulations, 2009/Appendix to the Regulations have still not been submitted. These were as follows:-

- (i) Consolidated staff profile approved by the affiliating University;
- (ii) Experience certificate of the Principal; and
- (iii) As per the management affidavit, the institution has appointed one Principal and eight lecturers, out of these eight lectures, two are part-time - Music and Sports teacher. Thus there is a shortage of one lecturer.

Letter dated 24.02.2014 was issued to the institution to fulfill the above shortcomings. The institution replied vide letter dated 25.02.2014. It is seen from the reply received on 05.03.2014 that the petitioner institution has completed all the required formalities.

Hence, Recognition is restored."

NOW THEREFORE, WRC restored the recognition of MAHARISHI VEDVYAS MAHAVIDYALAYA, RUN BY- DHARAM SHIKSHA SAMITI, JUNGIPUR, GWALIOR, MADHYA PRADESH for conducting **B.Ed.** course of 1 year duration with an annual intake of 100 seats. The other clauses of Recognition order will remain same as mentioned in the earlier Recognition order dated 28.05.2008.
