Withdrawal Order U/S-17

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely, SRI SATYA SAI COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, H.E. HOSPITAL, HABIBGANJ, BHOPAL - 462024 MADHYA PRADESH under section 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting **B.ED.** course vide order dated 22.04.1999 with an intake of 100 students.

2. AND WHEREAS, One Shri Pawan Dubey filed a PIL in the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Jabalpur. The Hon'ble High Court directed to inspect all B.Ed. institutions in the State of Madhya Pradesh. Since the institutions are existing institutions, the inspection was conducted by NCTE Hqrs. u/s 13 of the NCTE Act.

3. AND WHEREAS, the Inspection (U/s-13) was conducted by NCTE Hqrs. on 18.11.2014.

4. AND WHEREAS, the letter for AFFIDAVIT REGARDING ACCEPTANCE AND COMPLIANCE OF NCTE REGULATIONS, 2014 was issued to the institution on 19.01.2015 and the reply was received on 04-11-2015.

5. AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to the institution for two basic units of (50 students each) on 31.05.2015.

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "... The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

7. AND WHEREAS, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 21.07.2016 for not submitting the following documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order:

- 1) Original Staff Profile (1-Principal+15-Faculties) for the session 2015-16 duly approved by the affiliating body,
- 2) Originally notarized (not xerox) CLU, NEC, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate.

8. AND WHEREAS, the reply of Show Cause Notice was received on 12.08.2016 by the institution & the matter was placed in 284th Meeting of WRC held on November 28th-29th, 2017 and the Committee decided that "... In response to the Show Cause Notice dated 21.07.2016, the institution has submitted a list of 1+9 faculty members, which is not approved by the Registrar. The staff profile as per Appendix-IV of NCTE Regulations, 2014, approved by the affiliating body should be submitted in original.

It has not submitted the Building Completion Certificate countersigned by the Govt. Engineer.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which Recognition will be withdrawn."

9. AND WHEREAS, letter of Clarification was issued to the institution on 01.12.2017 and the reply was received on 21.12.2017.

10. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 301st Meeting of WRC held on January 17th-18th, 2019 and the Committee decided that "... Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice dated 21.07.2016 followed by Clarification letter dated 01.12.2017 were issued.

The institution in its reply dated 19.12.2017 has submitted a staff list of 1+16 faculty members approved by the Registrar. It is observed that one faculty member of Fine Arts is not appointed. Building Completion Certificate showing total built-up area duly signed by Government Engineer not submitted.

Hence, Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month."

11. AND WHEREAS, letter of Seeking Clarification was issued to the institution on 24.01.2019 and the reply was received on 18.02.2019.

12. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 310th Meeting of WRC held on August 19th-21st, 2019 and the Committee decided that "... The clarification letter was issued to the institution vide letter dated 24/01/2019 and reply received on 13/02/2019.

On perusal of the reply of the institution the committee observed that:

- The institution has submitted scanned copy of staff profile of 1+10+6. The staff at Sr. 4 is not qualified as fine Arts teacher.
- Percentage of marks in P.G. not mentioned at Sr. No. 1.
- Staff at Sr. No. 4,5 & 10 having less than 55 % in P.G. subject.
- Building Completion Certificate is not in prescribed format.
- The institution has not submitted approved building plan.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

13. Hence, in exercise of the powers conferred U/S 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition of the institution is hereby withdrawn from the end of the academic session next following the date of order of Withdrawal.

14. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 **online** against this order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines for filing the appeal may be seen on NCTE website.
