RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, “Shiv Shiksha Mahavidyalaya Run by Ch. Shivkumar Shiksha Prasar Samiti, Plot No. 249/1, 249/2, 250/1, 250/2, Pawai Road, Village-Semarpura, P.O. -Pidora, Tehsil + District-Bhind-477001, Madhya Pradesh was granted recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2014-2015 vide Order No. WRC/5-6/WRCAPP2438/223/2015st/MP/2013 /115287-294 dated 24.02.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the institution had consented to come under new Regulation by affidavit and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution 26.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 student (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 for compliance of certain.

3. AND WHEREAS, the standing decision of WRC taken in the 255th meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 Committee decided as under:-

“The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 15/02/2017 but no reply was submitted by the institution.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.”

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.02.2017.

4. AND WHEREAS, the standing decision of WRC taken in the 287th meeting held on January 30-31, 2018 Committee decided as under:-

“The case file was seen. The institution vide letter dated 18.12.2017 has requested for reducing the intake to one unit. This request will be considered as soon as qualified staff 1+7 approved by the competent authority is received. Otherwise, Recognition is liable to be withdrawn.

Hence, Show Cause Notice be issued as to why recognition should not be withdrawn. Reply should be submitted within one month.”

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.02.2018.

5. AND WHEREAS, the standing decision of WRC taken in the 310th meeting held on August 19th to 21st, 2019 Committee decided as under:-

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 02/02/2018. The summary of the case submitted reveals that the institution has not submitted reply of the Show Cause Notice.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Withdrawal Order No. WRC/APP2438/223 /B.Ed./310 /2019/205982-205989 was issued to the institution on 04.09.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the standing decision of WRC taken in the 316th meeting held on August 27th to 28th & 04th September 2020 Committee decided as under:-

"The Committee considered the matter in view of the order of the Appellate Authority, Agenda Note and observed the following:-

- The institution has not submitted the documents, as directed by the Appellate Authority.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to submit documents as directed by the Appellate Authority within 30 days u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed course."

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed W.P. (c) 5036/2026 in the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi which was disposed of vide Court Order dated 06.05.2026. The matter was considered in its 460th Meeting held on 13th to 15th May 2026, Committee decided as under:-

"The Committee noted that the institution has filed the court case W.P. No- 5036/2026 before the honorable high court of Delhi and the court has passed order dated: 06.05.2026 with following directions:

1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:- (a) Pass an appropriate order, direction or writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing the respondent No.2/WRC to comply with the directions passed by the respondent No. 1/NCTE in its Appeal Order dated 02.03.2020 and also to comply with the directions passed in W.P.(c) NO. 7151/2021 vide order dated 28.07.2021 and to issue restoration order of recognition for conducting B.Ed. course.

(b) Pass an appropriate order, direction or writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing the respondents to reflect the status of the petitioner as a recognized institution on its official website and permit the petitioner/institution to participate in the

counselling and admit students for the year 2026-2027, in the interest of justice and in the facts and circumstances of the case and/or

(c) Pass an order directing the respondent no.2 to send copy of such restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner namely "Jiwaji University, Gwalior" ..."

2. This order is being passed in view of a similar order dated 07.04.2026 passed in W.P.(C) 4499/2026, covering the present issue. Based upon the said order and using the same reasons and expressions, this order is being passed.

3. Mr. Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner was granted recognition by Western Regional Committee ("WRC") on 24.02.2014 for conducting B.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 100 seats. He states that statutory appeal was preferred by the petitioner and the matter was remanded by the Appellate Committee to WRC to take further decision.

4. He submits that the only grievance of the petitioner is that while the matter was remanded by the Appellate Committee the impugned withdrawal order was quashed and set aside and till date the WRC has not issued the restoration order.

5. For the said reasons, issue notice.


6. Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on instructions, affirms the aforesaid factual position.

7. Let WRC take a fresh decision and communicate the same to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 06.05.2026, the recognition for the B.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each).

The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance."

8. NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Court Order dated 06.05.2026, the Western Regional Committee hereby restore the recognition of "Shiv Shiksha Mahavidyalaya Run by Ch. Shivkumar Shiksha Prasar Samiti, Plot No. 249/1, 249/2, 250/1, 250/2, Pawai Road, Village-Semarpura, P.O. -Pidora, Tehsil + District-Bhind-477001, Madya Pradesh for B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).


