RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, “Vasudev Excellence College, Khasra No. 188, 189, 190/1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 422/2, 191, Plot No. P.H. No. 68, Village + P.O. -Bararu, Teh./District Sagar, Madhya Pradesh-470003” was granted recognition for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2014-2015 vide Order No.WRC/APP129/223/203rd/B.Ed./2014/ 1161112-122 dated 03.03.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the institution had consented to come under new Regulation by affidavit and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 student (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 for compliance of certain.

3. AND WHEREAS, the standing decision of WRC taken in the 255th meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 Committee decided as under:-

“The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 15/02/2017 but no reply was submitted by the institution.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.”


Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.02.2017.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered in its 285th WRC meeting held on 19th to 21st December 2017 Committee decided as under:-

“The case file was seen. In response to the Show Cause Notice dated 02.02.2017, the institution has not submitted approved staff profile and Building Completion Certificate.

FDRs of Rs.4.00 lakhs (in joint name) not submitted in original.

Hence, Recognition is withdrawn. FDRs if any, be returned.”



Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC withdrawal order No. WRC/APP129/223/B.Ed./285th/2017/10233-10240 dated 02.01.2018

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed appeal which was remanded back by the Appeal Committee vide order F.No.89-645/E-8919/2018 Appeal/21st & 22nd November,2018/73494 dated 31.12.2018. The matter was considered by WRC in its 304th meeting held on 02nd to 04th April 2019 and WRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of WRC Show Cause Notice issued on 09.04.2019.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in its 310th Meeting held on 19th to 21st August 2019, Committee decided as under:-

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 09/04/2019 and reply received on 12/04/2019.

On perusal of the reply of the institution the committee observed that:

- *The institution has submitted the letter of approval issued by Registrar vide letter dated 11/04/2019. On comparing the staff contained in the letter with the staff profile it is observed that except Principal remaining staff is not qualified (Not having NET/ Ph.D) as per NCTE Amended Regulations 9/6/2017.*

Hence, the committee decided to confer last opportunity to the institution to submit the above within 30 days failing which recognition will be withdrawn under section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993."

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed in the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi Vide W.P. (c) 5918/2026 dated 07.05.2026. the matter was considered in its 460th Meeting held on 13th to 15th May 2026, Committee decided as under:-

"The Committee noted that the institution has filed the court case W.P. No- 5918/2026 before the hon'ble high court of Delhi and the court has passed order dated: 07.05.2026 with following directions:

1. *This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers:-*

"a. issue a writ of mandamus or any other suitable writ or order holding that the withdrawal order dated 02.01.2018 issued by WRC stands quashed/ annulled by the order dated 31.12.2018 passed by NCTE Appeal Committee; and/or

b. issue a writ of mandamus or any other suitable writ or order or direction to the Respondents to issue the order of restoration of recognition for B.Ed Course with 100 seats (two basic units); and/or

c. issue a writ of mandamus or any other suitable writ or order or direction to the Respondents to display the name of Petitioner institution in the list/ category of recognised institutions for conducting B.Ed Course on their website along


2. *with recognition/ restoration order for B.Ed Course and to inform the Affiliating University as well as Department of Higher Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh communicating the restoration order and recognition status of petitioner institution for conducting B.Ed Course with 100 seats (two basic units) enabling the petitioner to participate in the counselling & admission process for the academic year 2026- 27 and for subsequent years. ... ”*
3. *Mr. Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner was granted recognition by WRC on 03.03.2014 for conducting B.Ed Course with an annual intake of 100 seats. However, the recognition granted to the petitioner was withdrawn on 02.01.2018.*
4. *He submits that statutory appeal was preferred by the petitioner and, on 31.12.2018 the matter was remanded by the Appellate Committee to WRC to take further decision and withdrawal order was kept in abeyance.*
5. *He submits that the only grievance of the petitioner is that while the matter was remanded by the Appellate Committee, but it did not quash the withdrawal order dated 02.01.2018.*
6. *Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/NCTE, on instructions, affirms the aforesaid factual position.*
7. *In view of the above, it is deemed appropriate to dispose of the present petition by clarifying that the order dated 31.12.2018 passed by the Appellate Committee would be treated as quashing of the withdrawal order dated 02.01.2018.*
8. *Let WRC take a fresh decision and communicate the same to the petitioner.*
9. *The WRC is directed to issue an order of restoration of recognition within a period of one week from today, which will govern the rights and contentions of the parties, until and unless fresh withdrawal order is passed by the WRC.*
10. *The petitioner will be permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students for the academic session 2026-27 and also subsequently, till the time a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it.*
11. *The status of petitioners as recognized institution will also be reflected on the official website of respondents/NCTE and will be communicated by the NCTE to petitioners' affiliating body as well as to the concerned department of the State Government within 1 week.*
12. *The petition is disposed of in the above terms.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 06.05.2026, the recognition for the B.Ed. course is restored with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each).

The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government, and all concerned authorities for compliance."

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Court Order dated 07.05.2026, the Western Regional Committee hereby restore the recognition of "Vasudev Excellence College, Khasra No. 188, 189, 190/1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 422/2, 191, Plot No. P.H. No. 68, Village + P.O. -Bararu, Teh./District-Sagar, Madhya Pradesh-470003" for B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).
