RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS recognition was granted for P.T.C course of two years duration with annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2006-2007 to the institution namely "Garaiya Bachubhai Govind bhai PTC College Managed B Gyanjyot Education Trust, Near Aryanagar Committee Hall, Pedak Road, Rajkot, Gujarat- 360003" vide Order No. WRC/5-6/88th/2006/ dated 15.09.2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding non-submission of PAR by the institution for the academic session 2022-23 was considered by WRC in its 416th meeting held on 20th March, 2025 and as per decision of the Committee, Show Cause Notice under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 vide letter dated 31.03.2025 was issued to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 423rd meeting held on 15th May, 2025 and the Committee decided that the recognition/permission granted to Garaiya Bachubhai Govindbhai PTC College Managed B Gyanjyot Education Trust, Near Aryanagar Committee Hall, Pedak Road, Rajkot, Gujarat- 360003 as referred above be withdrawn under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds/reasons mentioned therein with effect from the academic session 2025-2026. Accordingly, withdrawal order vide order No. NCTE/2025/WRC/PAR/ORDER/APW02185/322246/2803-2807 dated 16.05.2025 was issued to the institution.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi having Special W.P. (C) No. 6641 of 2026, and the Hon'ble Court passed Order dated 14.05.2026, the operative part of court order is as follows: -

"...5. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed, holding that the directions passed by the Coordinate Bench in paragraph Nos. 12 to 16 of the judgment of Teacher: Training College Mirza (supra) shall apply to the Petitioner as well, including the direction permitting the petitioner to participate in the counselling session for the academic session 2025-26. The said paragraph Nos. 12 to 16 are reproduced hereinbelow for ease of reference:

"12. In light of the above, and having regard to the decision taken by the NCTE in its 68th (General) Body Meeting as noted above, as well as, the statement made by Mr. Kapoor, the present petitions are allowed and the impugned orders are set aside.

13. Resultantly, the respondent NCTE will pass an "order of restoration" of recognition in each case and the names of the petitioners shall be included in the list of recognized institutions maintained on the website of the respondents.

14. Simultaneousl, status of the petitioners as "recognized."institution" shall also be communicated to the concerned State Government and Affiliating, Body or University.

15. The above exercise of passing an order of restoration of recognition as well as communicating the State Government and Affiliating Body/University shall be completed before the issuance of public notice us mentioned in para 8(ii) above.

16. In the meanwhile, petitioner institutes are permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-26 and admit students for the said academic session."

6. The present petition, along with pending application(s), if ny, stands disposed of.

7. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith."

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the similar PAR matter and related court direction was considered by WRC in its 460 (Part-III) meeting (Item No. 4, page No. 7 & 8 of minutes) held on 13th - 15th May, 2026 and the Committee decided as under: -

"...In consideration of Orders passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in each case, the Committee directed that all concerned may ensure strict and time-bound compliance with the Court order.

Further, the Committee decided that the compliance on similar court matters be carried out on the above lines after due verification of records by the office of WRC, NCTE."

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in compliance of directions of Court Order, recognition for P.T.C. course with an annual intake of 50 students in respect of institution viz. Garaiya Bachubhai Govindbhai PTC College Managed B Gyanjyot Education Trust, Near Aryanagar Committee Hall, Pedak Road, Rajkot, Gujarat- 360003" is hereby restored.

7. The terms and conditions shall remain unchanged as mentioned in the recognition order dated 15.09.2006.


