ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14/15 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act 1993, WRC granted recognition to M.B. KHALSA COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, RAJMOHALLA SQUARE, SHAHID BHAGAT SINGH STATUE NEAR GANGWAL BUS STAND INDORE 452002 MADHYA PRADESH for D.Ed., B.Ed., B.Ed. (Addl.) and M.Ed. course vide order dated 26.09.2005, 20.04.2004, 01.03.2008 and 23.10.2009 respectively.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 26.11.2013 had applied for change of name of the institution from M.B. KHALSA COLLEGE OF EDUCATION to M.B. KHALSA INSTITUTION OF EDUCATION.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 204th meeting of WRC held on April 3-4, 2014 and the Committee decided as follows:-

"In this case there are two issues -

- (i) Relating to the institution not having NAAC Accreditation even though it conducts courses in B.Ed. (additional intake) and M.Ed.; and
- (ii) Change of name

With reference to the first point, the situation is that the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Indore Bench has passed an order dated 14.02.2014 in W.P. No.10922/2013. In this order, the Hon'ble High Court have quashed the 'order' dated 27.08.2013 of the first respondent (WRC), on the grounds of natural justice - that this order (de-recognition of additional B.Ed. and M.Ed.) was passed without issue of a Show Cause Notice. It is worthwhile to mention that no 'order' was issued by the WRC in this context. The communication dated 27.08.2013, referred to as annexure-1 in the court case is actually a letter which was issued by the Regional Director, WRC, NCTE, Bhopal to all those institutions which were conducting additional B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses. The Regional Director issued this letter in compliance of the directions from the NCTE hqrs. vide letter No.49-3/2011/NCTE/N&S/ A54872 dated 13.07.2012. In this letter of the NCTE hqrs.

"(5) An institution that has been granted additional intake in Bachelor of Education and Bachelor of Physical Education teacher training courses after promulgation of the Regulations, 2005 i.e. the 13th day of January 2006 shall have to get itself accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with a Letter Grade B under the new grading system developed by NAAC, on or before the 1st day of April, 2012 failing which the additional intake granted shall stand withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2012-2013. Similarly, all institutions having a Master of Education and Master of Physical Education courses shall have to get NAAC Accreditation with at least a Letter Grade B on or before the 1st day of April, 2012, failing which Master of Education or Master of Physical Education Recognition granted to the institutions shall stand withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2012-2013."

Thus the letter of the Regional Director dated 27.08.2013 is just a simple communication to apprise the institutions of the legal position of the provisions in the NCTE Regulations regarding necessity of the NAAC Accreditation for running additional B.Ed., and M.Ed. courses.

The Hon'ble High Court in their order dated 14.02.2014 have directed that the first respondent is at liberty to pass fresh order. At present no order can be passed by WRC, in any case, because actions cannot be taken under the NCTE Regulations. Hence, this situation be communicated to the Counsel of the NCTE, Bhopal.

With reference to the order dated 14.02.2014, the RD should also advise the NCTE Hqrs of the advice of the Counsel.

With respect to the second point, since Resolution of the Society accompanied by fee of Rs.50,000/- for change of name of the college has been submitted.

Hence, the change of name is permitted."


