RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Janata Shikshan Prasarak Mandals Womens B.Ed. College, OPP. R.T.O. Jahangirgar Colony, Railway Station, Aurangabad-431005, Maharashtra** for offering **B.Ed. (M) (CO-ED)** course vide order No.WRC/2-32/123177/74/2005/5064 dated **27.06.2005** with an annual intake **100** students. As per the records of WRC, the recognition of the institution was granted in a rented premises with a direction to shift to its own premises within a period of three years.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the Revised Recognition Order was issued to the institution vide order No. WRC/APW00843/123177/2015 dated **19.08.2015** for offering **B.Ed. programme** with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, The matter regarding institutions who have not complied with Regulations, 2014 was placed in the **255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016** and the Committee decided that **show cause notice** be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice issued to the institution on **02.01.2017**.

4. AND WHEREAS, the WRC in its **316th meeting held on 27th to 28th August, 2020 & 04 September 2020** had considered the entire issue in detail and noted that as per NCTE Regulations dated 13.11.2002 initially Institutions were permitted to start the course in a rented premises with a condition to shift to their own premises within a period of three years from the date of such recognition. It was observed by the Committee that many institutions have not yet shifted to their own premises neither they have applied to WRC for shifting of premises of their institutions. The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act be issued to reply within 30 days to all such institutions which have been permitted or given recognition/permission to run the programme in rented premises and have not yet applied for shifting of their institution. Further, the WRC also decided that the applications of the institutions who have applied for shifting of premises be examined by office at the earliest and placed before WRC for consideration and decision. **As per the decision of WRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2020.**

5. AND WHEREAS, the original file of the Institution along with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in its 321st & 322nd meeting held on 09th to 11th November, 2020 & 23rd to 24th November 2020 in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observations were made :-

1. Recognition was granted to the institution on 27.06.2005 on rented premises with a condition that to shift the institution in its own premises within a period of three years from the date of issue of recognition order.
2. The institution has not shifted the institution in its own premises till date.
3. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.10.2020.
4. The institution has not submitted the reply of the Show Cause Notice till date.

AND WHEREAS, in view of above, the Committee had decided that the recognition of B.Ed. programme of the institution be WITHDRAWN under clause 7(15) from the next academic session 2021-21. As per the decision of WRC, a **Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 19.12.2020**.

AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by the withdrawal order, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs against withdrawal order dt. 19.12.2020 and the Appeal Committee passed an order dt. **30.06.2021** as under:-

"Appeal Committee perused the submission made by appellant in its appeal memoranda with regard to non-mentioning of the condition to shift premises within three years in the recognition order dated 27/06/2005. Further the appellant has furnished evidence of having sent a reply dated 21/10/2020 to the Show Cause Notice (SCN) dated 09/10/2020. Reply to S.C.N. was sent by speed post and appellant has submitted copy of the track report which indicates delivery of the reply to WRC on 02.11.2020. Above reply is not found placed in the regulatory file.

Appeal Committee without going into the merits of averments made by the appellant in its appeal memoranda and reply dated 21/10/2020 to the S.C.N. decided that the Regional Committee is required to revisit the matter after the appellant submits copy of its reply dated 21/10/2020 with enclosures to WRC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order.

After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit documents on record and arguments advanced during online presentation, the Committee concluded to remand back the case to WRC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order. The Council hereby remands back the case of Janata Shikshan Prasarak Mandal Womens B.Ed. College, Khultabad, Aurangabad Road, Khultabad, Aurangabad, Maharashtra to the WRC, NCTE."

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dt. 09.07.2021 received on 15.07.2021 and 22.11.2021 received on 14.12.2021.

AND WHEREAS, WRC in its **349th Meeting held on December 29-31, 2021** had considered the original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines Issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observations were made:

1. The staff list submitted is not approved by the concerned affiliating university.
2. As the list submitted by the institution Principal and faculty members are not qualified as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, in view of the above, the Committee decided that **final show Cause Notice** prior to refusal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 14/15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN within a period of 30 days.

AND WHEREAS, in the meanwhile, the institution has submitted reply vide letter dt. **10.02.2022** received on **27.02.2022** with following documents: -

1. Colored Xerox copy of the staff list of 11 Assistant Professors submitted. Staff list in original not submitted by the institution. (As per appendix-4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014, For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, that is total students strength of 200, there shall 16 full-time faculty members is required.)
2. Staff is not qualified as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended vide notification dated 09 June 2017.
3. Faculty for Health and Physical Education, Fine Arts and Performing Arts not appointed.
4. Details of Principal not submitted.

AND WHEREAS, the WRC in its 359th meeting held on April 18, 2022 considered the original file of the Institution along with visiting team report and other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993. Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:-

1. Colored Xerox copy of the staff list of 11 Assistant Professors submitted. Staff list in original not submitted by the institution.
2. Staff list is not qualified as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended vide notification dated 09th June 2017.
3. Details of Principal not submitted.

AND WHEREAS, In view of the above, the Committee decided that show Cause Notice be issued to the institution u/s 17 (1) of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN within a period of 30 days. As per the decision of WRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.05.2022.

AND WHEREAS, In response, the institution submitted replies vide letter dated 02.06.2022 & 414 04.08.2022, received in WRC on 11.06.2022 & 26.08.2022 along with the affidavit dated 02.06.2022.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was Considered in WRC Meeting 374th (Part-1) of Held on 18th & 19th October 2022 and the Committee decided as under:-

"In view of the above, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order".

AND WHEREAS, Accordingly as per the decision of WRC, a **Withdrawal Order** vide No. F.No. WRC/APW00843/123177/374th/2022 was issued to the institution on 14.11.2022.

AND WHEREAS, the Institution filed **W.P. No.4311/2022** in the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay at Aurangabad and the Hon'ble Court had passed an order dated 23.09.2022. The operative part of the order is as under:-

"2. This matter was heard for some time. The learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that, the order is passed by respondent No.3. dated 30/06/2021, directing respondent No.2. to initiate appropriate action, after considering the entire record comprising of memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents on record and decide the issue within 15 days. Respondent No.2, despite receiving the order dated 30.06.2021 has still not decided the issue pertaining to withdrawal of recognition, which order was said to have been passed without hearing the petitioner.

3. The learned Advocate representing respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits on instructions that, respondent no.2 would decide the pending remanded proceedings on or before 21/10/2022, keeping in view that, pursuant to the show cause notice, the petitioner has already tendered a reply and the pleadings are complete.

5. In view of the above, this petition is disposed off, with a direction to respondent No.2, to decide the said proceedings, on or before 21/10/2022, on it's own merits.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal before the applicant authority under was disposed Vide Order No. 89-70-E-1773771/2021/Appeal/12th Meeting, 2024 APPLWRC202414772 Dated: 30.10.2024 as under:-

"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded that the WRC was justified in withdrawing the recognition and decided that the instant appeal deserves to be rejected and therefore, the impugned withdrawal order dated 14.11.2022 issued by WRC is confirmed."

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AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed W.P. No. 10295/2025, CM APPL.42715/2025 & 53812/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi Passed an order dated: 16.09.2025 with the following direction:

"...16 Consequently, the petition is allowed. The impugned withdrawal order dated 14.11.2022, as well as the impugned order dated 13.10.2024 of the appellate committee, are set aside, and the following directions are passed:

- (i) the matter is remanded to the respondent no.2-WRC to pass a fresh order on the basis of inspection;*
- (ii) the NCTE is directed to carry out fresh inspection under Section 13 NCTE Act and inform the petitioner institution about recommendations, if any, on the basis of such inspection;*
- (iii) in the event any deficiencies are pointed out in the recommendations, NCTE will grant reasonable time to the petitioner institution to rectify the same; and*
- (iv) if no deficiencies are recommended, or in case deficiencies recommended by NCTE are rectified by petitioner institution during the time period granted to it, the WRC will restore the recognition of petitioner institution for B.Ed. course (two basic units-100 seats), and consequently, the NCTE shall communicate about the restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner institution, as well as, to the State Government. Further, NCTE will also do the needful with regard to updation of the status of petitioner institution on its website.*

17. The petition along with pending applications, is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

18. The date already fixed i.e. 27.10.2025 stands cancelled."

AND WHEREAS, the above court matter was considered by WRC in its 443rd meeting(Part-I) held on 18-20 December, 2025 and has decided as under:-

" The Committee noted the direction of Hon'ble Court and decided that Visiting Team be constituted for inspection of the institution under Section 13 of NCTE Act 1993 in order to ascertain and scrutinize all the essential documents and at the time of verification, VT shall also check/verify all building and land related documents, NEC, CLU, Mutation Certificate, Building Plan, Building Completion Certificate, Building Safety Certificate, Fire Safety Certificate, List of Teaching staff approved by the Affiliating body and payment of salary as per NCTE norms, Not-for-Profit certificate and website so as to assess institution's preparedness for running the B.Ed. course as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time."

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of WRC, an email was sent to the institution on 12 February 2026 with a request to fill up the proforma and submit it to WRC for conduct of VT as per the court order immediately.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide their reply mail dated 23rd February, 2026 and 25th February, 2026 has requested to restore the permission of Janata Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's B.Ed. college, Khuladabad.

AND WHEREAS, in the meantime, the institution has approached Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide W.P. No. 10295/2025 & CM APPL 21898-2026 and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 10.04.2026, has directed as under:-

"...7. In view of the above, para 16 of the judgment dated 16.09.2025 is modified/corrected to read as under:

" 16 Consequently, the petition is allowed. The impugned withdrawal order dated 14.11.2022, as well as, the impugned order dated 13.10.2024 of the appellate committee, are set aside, and the following directions are passed:-

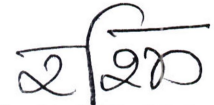
- i. The matter is remanded to the respondent no.2-WRC;*

- ii. *The WRC will restore the recognition of petitioner institution for B.Ed. course (two basic units-100 seats) and consequently, the NCTE/WRC shall communicate about the restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner institution, as well as, to the State Government. Further, NCTE/WRC will also do the needful with regard to updation of the status of petitioner institution on its website.*
 - iii. *The NCTE is directed to carry out fresh inspection under Section 13 of NCTE Act and inform the petitioner institution about recommendations, if any, on the basis of such inspection; iv. In the event any deficiencies are pointed out in the recommendations, NCTE will grant reasonable time to the petitioner institution to rectify the same; and*
 - iv. *If no deficiencies are recommended, or in case deficiencies recommended by NCTE are rectified by petitioner institution during the time period granted to it, the restoration order will continue and in case deficiencies are not rectified, it will be open to WRC to initiate action under Section 17 of the Act in accordance with law."*
8. *The application stands disposed of in the above terms"*

AND WHEREAS, the WRC in its 457th meeting held on 20-22 April, 2026 decided that in accordance with the **directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide its order dated 10.04.2026,** the recognition for the **B.Ed. course** is restored **with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each).** The restoration order shall be displayed on the NCTE website, with the institution's status updated in the list of recognized institutions. The order shall also be forwarded to the affiliating body, State Government and all concerned authorities for compliance.

NOW THEREFORE, the Western Regional Committee hereby restores recognition of **Janata Shikshan Prasarak Mandals Womens B.Ed. College, OPP. R.T.O. Jahangirgar Colony, Railway Station, Aurangabad-431005, Maharashtra** for offering **B.Ed. programme 2 years duration** with an annual intake of **100 (two units of 50 each).**
