Recognition Order

- WHEREAS, KALPATARU SHAIKSHANIK SEVA MANDAL, 19, Shambhaji Nagar, Shahda, district Nandurbar, Maharashtra, applied under section 14 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) for recognition of ADHYAPAK VIDYALAYA, RUN BY KALPATARU SHAIKSHANIK SEVA MANDAL, PLOT NO. 108/1, PRAKASHA, TH. SHAHADA, DIST. NANDURBAR-425409 MAHARASHTRA (Code No.- APW03714/122727), to conduct the D.ED. (MARATHI) (CO-ED) course of 2 years' duration with annual intake of 50;
2. AND WHEREAS, the Western Regional Committee of NCTE considered the application in its 92nd (2nd Sitting) meeting held on December 22-24, 2006, and decided to grant the recognition under Regulation 9(12) of the NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2005 to start the D.Ed. (Marathi) (CO-ED) course with annual intake of 50 and to send the visiting team to the institution again for verification of facilities pertaining to infrastructure due to complaint received by it. The recognition order dated 09.03.2007 came to be issued to the institution.
3. AND WHEREAS, the Western Regional Committee of NCTE considered the second inspection report in its 101st meeting held on January 16-19, 2008 and decided to refuse the recognition. This decision was taken after following the due procedure relating to issue of show cause notice and consideration of written representation submitted by the institution. This order of refusal dated 08.02.2008 was also upheld by the appellate authority vide its orders dated 19th August 2008;
4. AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay (Aurangabad Bench) directed WRC vide orders dated 16th October 2008, passed in Writ Petition No. 5189 of 2008, filed by the institution to challenge the refusal order of WRC as also the appellate order of NCTE, to carry out inspection of the institution established on its own land at the aforesaid address and to submit the report with its opinion as to sufficiency of infrastructure. The WRC placed its opinion in the light of directions received from NCTE Headquarters and in the light of proceedings of WR 2701 of 2008 pending in the Hon'ble High court of Bombay (Nagpur Bench). The Hon'ble High Court considered the opinion of WRC but it again directed vide orders dated 21.11.2008, passed in the aforesaid writ petition, to carry out the inspection of the institution and to submit its opinion as to sufficiency of infrastructure;
5. AND WHEREAS, the WRC complied with the directions and carried out the inspection of the infrastructure on 21st December, 2008 and considered the case in its 119th meeting held on May 27-29, 2009, and decided to issue formal recognition order under Regulation 7(11) of the NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2007. 4/13/2009

6. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, and in compliance of court order dated 16.10.2008 in W.P. No. 5189/08 the Western Regional Committee of NCTE hereby grants formal recognition to Adhyapak Vidyalaya, run by Kalpataru Shaikshanik Seva Mandal, Plot No. 108/1, Prakasha, Th. Shahada, Dist. Nandurbar-425409 Maharashtra for conducting D.Ed. (Marathi) (CO-ED) course of 2 years duration with an annual intake of 50 students under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation 2007.
7. This recognition will be effective from 9th March 2007 when the first order of recognition was issued as per decision of WRC in its 92nd (2nd Sitting) meeting held on December 22-24, 2006.
8. Institution to fulfill the usual condition of 180 teaching days, affiliation by examining body etc. as per clarification received vide NCTE letter No. 49-27/2007/NCTE/(N&S)/89496 dated 31.12.2008.
9. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Western Regional Committee.
10. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
11. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
12. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
13. Further, subject to the provision of NCTE Act 1993, The institution shall fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, applicable.
14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
15. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always following as mandatory disclosure:

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars.
- (iii) Staff Profile.
- (iv) Recognition letter.
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
