WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Tilak Teachers Training College (for Women), Vishvesariya Nagar, Triveni Nagar, Gopal Pura Bye pass- Jaipur-302014, Rajasthan** vide Order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/RJ-400/4498 dated 01.07.2005 for **B.Ed.** course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students followed by Revised Order F.No./NRC/NCTE/RJ-400/2015/98391-396 dated 10.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 200 for four basic units of 50 students each from academic session 2015-2016.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter related with Revised Order compliance by TEIs was considered by NRC in its 281st Meeting held on 20th to 21st February 2018, wherein the Committee decided as under:

“NRC decided that Show-cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which did not submit affidavit for compliance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 in respect of these courses. The Committee also decided that show-cause notice be issued to all such institutions which did not submit compliance of the revised recognition orders”

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dated 26.03.2018 and the institution has submitted reply dated 13.04.2018 in response to show cause notice.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, matter was considered by WRC in its 316th Meeting held on 27th to 28th Aug & 4th Sep, 2020 wherein the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/S 17, according SCN dated 07.11.2020 was issued to the institution for compliance of conditions mentioned in Revised Recognition Order.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, verified complaint has been received from the Complaint Division, NCTE, HQrs. vide letter No. F.No.NCTE-C/PG011/13/2020-Complaint Section-HQ/129613 dated 22.04.2025 Computer No.39770 received in WRC office on 09.05.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, matter was considered by WRC in its 426th Meeting held on 03rd – 05th June 2025, wherein the Committee decided as under:-

“The Committee noted that the institution has not submitted the compliance of the revised recognition order issued dated 10.05.2015. The First Show Cause Notice dated 26.03.2018 was issued to the institution. The reply dated 13.04.2018 was submitted by the institution to the First Show Cause Notice. Thereafter, a Show Cause Notice dated 07.11.2020 has been issued to the institution. However, the reply has not been submitted by the institution.

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Further, a verified complaint vide letter dated 15.01.2020 has been forwarded by Complaint Division, NCTE, New Delhi, vide letter No. F.No. NCTE-C/PG011/13/2020-Complaint Section-HQ/129613 dated 22.04.2025 received in WRC on 09.05.2025 regarding misutilization of education qualification certificate submitted by Complainant during interview for the post of teaching faculty by the institution while not giving any appointment/selection letter to the complainant as alleged in complaint. The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language, the institution is also required to submit notarized copy of English version of land documents)
- ii. The institution is required to submit an attested notarized copy of land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- iii. The institution is required to submit a copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarized copy of Non - Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- iv. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarized copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognized Teacher Education programme).
- v. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarized copy of site plan showing all the plot/Survey No. mentioned in the land documents in one location alongwith land area and built-up area.
- vi. The institution is required to submit latest notarized copy of Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- vii. The institution is required to submit Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
- viii. The institution is required to submit Staff list/profile duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed format of NCTE. (In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by the Affiliating body for each of the recognized teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)
- ix. The institution is required to submit original FDRs to the WRC, NCTE The institution is required to submit a "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years alongwith a copy of the FDRS.
- x. Details of Teacher Education programme (s) being run by the Institution in the same campus

- xi. Details of other programme(s) (if any) being run by the institution in the same campus

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- xiii. URL of website maintained by the institution.

- xiv. The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details:

- Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the Institution
- Details of land & building now available with the Institution
- Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status

In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof with approval of the WRC, NCTE.

Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 (1) of NCTE, Act 1993 be issued to the institution with direction to submit reply/documents supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of notice."

Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued to the institution dated 23.07.2025.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice vide letter dated 04.08.2025 received in WRC office dated 02.09.2025 along with certain documents. The matter was considered by WRC in its 438th (Part-II) Meeting held on 13th -16th October 2025, wherein the Committee decided as under:

"The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

After issuance or revised recognition order dated 10.05.2015, First SCN notice u/S 17 was issued dated 26.03.2018 followed by another Show Cause Notice dated 07.11.2020. No reply was submitted by the institution.

A verified complaint was received from Complaint Division, NCTE vide letter dated 22.04.2025. Matter was considered in 426th meeting held on 03rd to 05th June 2025 where in Committee decided final Show Cause Notice be issued accordingly final SCN dated 23.07.2025 was issued to the institution to comply deficiencies mentioned therein.

Reply of final SCN submitted by the institution was considered and Committee decided that following deficiencies are still persisting:

- Submitted Building plan is not legible and approving authority reflected therein is not clear. The institution is required to submit Building plan with earmarked and demarcated land area and built-up area for all recognized teacher education programmes and other courses being run in the campus as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
- Date of approval of Govt. authority is not reflected in the submitted copy of site plan. The institution is required to submit site plan showing contiguity of all plots used for various Teacher Education courses got recognition from NCTE and other courses, if any approved by competent Govt. authority.*

- iii. *Date of approval of Govt. authority is not reflected in the submitted copy of Building Completion Certificate. The institution is required to submit building plan in NCTE prescribed proforma indicating details of total land area, total built up area in respect of all recognized teacher education programmes vis-à-vis other courses running in the same campus certified by the competent Government Authority.*
- iv. *Submitted list of faculty is not approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed format of NCTE.*
- v. *The institution has not submitted faculty list for recognized M.Ed. and STC (D.El.Ed.) course duly approved/ countersigned by the concerned Affiliating Body in the NCTE prescribed proforma. The institution is required to submit faculties list of all courses approved by concerned affiliating body.*
- vi. *As per information on the website, Staff approval is under process vide letter dated 30.05.2024 sent to Registrar, University of Rajasthan.*
- vii. *Complete information as per Clause 7(14)(i), 8(14) and 10(3) is not uploaded on institutional website.*
- viii. *Reply of SCN dated 07.11.2020 on the compliance of Revised Recognition Order as mentioned to have submitted by the institution vide letter dated 07.12.2020 is not found attached on the institution file. A copy of the same is required to submit by the institution.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Last final opportunity be given to the institution to comply above deficiencies.

Accordingly, last final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 (1) of NCTE Act 1993 be issued to the institution with direction to submit compliance along with requisite documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of notice and reply received from the institution be placed for consideration of WRC."

Accordingly, Last Final Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued to the institution dated 17.02.2026. The institution has submitted reply letter dated 07.04.2026 received in WRC office on 15.04.2026 along with related documents.

7. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was considered by WRC in its 462nd Part-III Meeting held on 03rd -04th June 2026 wherein the Committee decided as under:

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The WRC considered the entire matter and noted the following :-

1. *Recognition was granted to B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake 100 vide order dated 01.07.2005 followed by additional intake of 100 vide order dated 30.06.2008. Revised order for B.Ed. course of two years duration with annual intake of 200 (four basic units of 50 each) vide order dated 10.05.2015 with direction to institution for compliance of conditions mentioned therein.*
2. *Matter was considered by WRC in its 316th meeting held on 27th to 28th August & 4th September, 2020 and Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued to the institution dated 07.11.2020 with a direction to submit compliance to the conditions mentioned/ stipulated in the Revised Recognition Order issued by NRC, NCTE.*

3. A verified complaint against the institution was received from the Complaints Division, NCTE HQrs. vide letter dated 04.08.2020 followed by reminder letter dated 22.04.2025. In the complaint, the complainant has stated regarding misutilization of education qualification certificate submitted during interview for the post of teaching faculty by the institution and not given any appointment/selection letter to the complainant as alleged in complaint.
4. Matter was considered by WRC in its 426th meeting held on 03rd – 5th June, 2025, wherein Committee noted that no reply is submitted in response to SCN dated 07.11.2020 and verified complaint against the institution is received from Complaints Division, NCTE. As per decision of Committee, final Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 was issued dated 23.07.2025 to the institution for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.
5. Reply of SCN submitted vide letter dated 04.08.2025 was considered by WRC in its 438th (Part-II) meeting of WRC held on 13th-16th October, 2025 and as per decision of Committee, last final Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued dated 17.02.2026 to the institution for compliance of deficiencies mentioned therein.

On scrutiny of reply of last final SCN, the Committee noted that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds:

- i. Submitted Building plan is certified by registered Architect and Sahayak Abhiyanta, P.W.D. Sub-Division (without date) mentioning therein "only for Building Safety Certificate". However, the institution has not submitted approved Building Plan certified by the competent govt. authority reflecting earmarked and demarcated land area and built-up area for all recognized teacher education programmes (B.Ed., M.Ed., STC) and other courses being run in the campus as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- ii. The institution has not submitted site plan showing contiguity of all plots used for various Teacher Education courses got recognition from NCTE and other courses, if any approved by competent Govt. authority.
- iii. Submitted Building Completion Certificate showing land Ward No.77, total land area 4335.81 sq. mtr. total Built-up area 3619.05 sq. mtr. prepared by registered Architect and certified by Asst. Engineer, P.W.D. Jaipur (without date and legible office seal). However, BCC is not submitted indicating details of total land area, total built up area earmarked for all recognized teacher education programmes with name of course vis-à-vis other courses running in the same campus certified by the competent Government Authority.
- iv. Submitted D.El.Ed. course faculty list approved by Deputy Director, Primary Education, Govt. of Rajasthan dated 25.02.2026, which is not in the NCTE prescribed proforma and not approved/ countersigned by the concerned Affiliating Body. The institution has submitted faculty list comprising 01 Principal/HoD + 27 faculties (without mentioning course name), which is not duly approved/ countersigned by the concerned Affiliating University and not in the NCTE prescribed proforma, mentioning therein that "File submitted to UOR for approval awaited (except Principal-Approved by UOR Approval No.शैक्षणिक दितीय/2015/763 dated 15.07.2015).
- v. The institution has not submitted approved faculty list for M.Ed. course countersigned by Affiliating University.
- vi. As per letter of reply dated 07.04.2026 submitted by the institution, staff approval is under process and approval has been sought from the Affiliating University i.e. University of Rajasthan.

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- vii. *The website of the institution has not been found functional, maintained and updated in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.*

In view of the above, WRC decided that recognition to B.Ed. course of the institution be withdrawn under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 with a copy endorsed to State Govt., Affiliating Body and all other concerned and the same be displayed on NCTE website. The institution is not permitted to make admissions after issue of Withdrawal order by WRC-NCTE”.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, recognition granted for **B.Ed. programme** in respect of the institution viz. **“Tilak Teachers Training College (for Women), Vishvesariya Nagar, Triveni Nagar, Gopal Pura Bye Pass, Jaipur-302014, Rajasthan”** is hereby withdrawn from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said withdrawal order.

10. इसके अलावा, यदि संस्थान और संबद्ध निकाय को एनसीटीई अधिनियम, 1993 की धारा 17(4) के निम्नलिखित प्रावधानों के बारे में सूचित किया जाता है:-

(4) यदि कोई संस्था (1) के अधीन मान्यता वापस लेने वाले आदेश के प्रवृत्त होने के पश्चात अध्यापक शिक्षा में कोई पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रस्थापित करती है तो, या जहां अध्यापक शिक्षा में कोई पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रस्थापित करने वाली कोई संस्था नियत दिन के ठीक पूर्व अधिनियम के अधीन मान्यता या अनुज्ञा प्राप्त करने में असफल हो जाती है या उपेक्षा बरतती है वहां, ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण के अनुसरण में या ऐसी संस्था में पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण करने के पश्चात प्राप्त अध्यापक शिक्षा में अर्हता को, केन्द्रीय सरकार, किसी राज्य सरकार या विश्वविद्यालय के अधीन या केन्द्रीय सरकार या किसी राज्य सरकार द्वारा सहायता प्राप्त किसी विद्यालय, महाविद्यालय या अन्य शिक्षा निकाय में नियोजन के प्रयोजनों के लिए, विधिमान्य अर्हता नहीं मानी जाएगी।

11. Further, the institution and affiliating body are hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993:-

“If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purposes of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.”

12. इसके अलावा, यदि संस्थान इस आदेश से संतुष्ट नहीं है, तो इस आदेश की जारी होने की तिथि से 60 दिनों के भीतर एन.सी.टी.ई अधिनियम, 1993 के धारा 18 के अंतर्गत एक अपील की जा सकती है जो ऑनलाइन होगी तथा एन.सी.टी.ई की वेबसाइट www.ncte.gov.in पर उपलब्ध है।

13. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal against the aforesaid order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing the appeal may be seen on NCTE website.
