WITHDRAWAL ORDER

1. **WHEREAS**, recognition u/s 14 Act of NCTE, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Siddhivinayak Shikshan Prasarak Mandal RK B.ED. College, Ram Nagar, Rawate Compound, Tembepada Road, Bhandup (W), Mumbai-78, Maharashtra** was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. of one year duration for 100 intake vide order No. WRC/5-6/101st/2008/27976-27982 dated. 29.01.2008.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulation 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit to come under new Regulations vide dated 14.02.2015. Thereafter, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 06.10.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16. The **Corrigendum** letter vide No. WRC/APW03737/123434/2015/153770-153773 was issued to the institution dated 07.10.2015 for correction in the name and address of the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the 255th Meeting of WRC held on 22nd-24th June, 2016 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice issued to the institution which have not submitted compliance. Show Cause Notice issued to the institution letter vide No. WRC/APW03737/123434/MH/2016/180607-608 dated 21.02.2017 which has not submitted the following documents in compliance of the conditions mentioned in the Revised Order:-

- (a) Staff Profile for the session 2015-16 duly approved by the affiliating body.
- (b) Originally notarized Change of land/Non-Encumbrance Certificate/ Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted representation vide letter vide No. S.V.S.P.M./161/2017 dated **17.07.2017** to reduce intake from 100 students to 50 students.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter vide No. WRC/APW03737/123434/2017/188972 dated 24.08.2017 was issued to the institution for reduce intake from 2 Units to 1 Unit required following documents to be submitted for taking further necessary action.

- (a) An affidavit in support of the decision to reduce intake.

The WRC acceded to the request of the institution and decided that the institution be directed to present itself in the next meeting of WRC."

13. AND WHEREAS, a letter vide No. WRC/APW03737/123434/B.Ed./314th/2020/208865 dated **06.08.2020** was issued to the Institution for requested to present yourself before WRC in its meeting scheduled for 10th August 2020 through virtual mode.

14. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in its **315th Meeting** of WRC held on 10th-11th and 14th August 2020 and the committee decided that:

"The Committee considered the matter keeping in view the directions of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 13922/2019 and noted that despite giving two opportunities for personal hearing, the institution has not presented itself for personal hearing before WRC.

The WRC decided that the file of the institution be examined by the office keeping in view the documents available in file and matter be put up in the next meeting before WRC for decision."

15. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted letters dated **05.09.2023, 18.09.2023, 29.09.2023** and letter dated **25.09.2023** regarding the correction of intake capacity of number from 50 to 100 Students.

16. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in its **413th Meeting** of WRC held on 27th-29th Jan 2025 and the Committee decided that:

"The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The Committee noted that the WRC in its 300th Meeting held on 10th to 11th and 14th August 2019 considered the matter keeping in view the directions of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 13922/2019 and also noted that despite giving two opportunities for personal hearing, the institution has not presented itself for personal hearing before WRC. The WRC decided that the file of the institution be examined by the office keeping in view the documents along with the letter dated 25.09.2023 submitted by institution and it is still deficient on the following grounds:

1. Staff profile for the session 2024-25 duly approved by the affiliating body in prescribed format:
 - a) The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned Registrar of affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection/appointment, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GoI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized representative of management along with copy of approval letter of affiliating body.
 - b) Notarized original affidavit on Rs.100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
 - c) The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty

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along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.

2. Originally notarized Change of Land Use/Non-Encumbrance Certificate, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate:
 - a) The institution is required to submit Blueprint of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as classrooms etc. The earmarked space for all the teacher education programmes being conducted in the premises and any proposed course to be run in the premises.
 - b) The institution is required to submit CLU (Change of Land Use Certificate) indicating Survey/Plot/Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority.
 - c) The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate indicating Survey/Plot/Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
 - d) The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate from the Competent Government Authority.
 - e) The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
 - f) The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
 - g) The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority in the format prescribed by NCTE.
3. The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts issued by Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, WRC, NCTE & Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
4. The institution is required to submit compliance of all points in light of Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution be given final opportunity by issuing Final Show Cause Notice u/S 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 with direction to submit above documents within 15 days along with affidavit by the authorized representative of the management:

17. AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of WR,C a Final Show Cause Notice vide No. WRC/NCTE/CF-86449/APW03737/123434/B.ED./413th/2025/362-366 was issued to the institution on **05.03.2025**.

18. AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice vide letter vide No. 22720125 dated **25.03.2025**.

19. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 427th WRC meeting held on 12-13 June, 2025, and the Committee decided as under:

"The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time. The Committee noted that the Final Show Cause Notice vide No.WRC/NCTE/CF-86449/APW03737/123434/B.ED./413th/2025/362-366 dated 05.03.2025 was issued to the institution. The institution has submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice vide letter vide No. 22720125 dated 25.03.2025 with certain documents. The Committee further noted that the reply of the institution is still deficient for the following:

- (a) The list of teaching staff submitted by the institution is neither approved by the affiliating body and nor in the NCTE prescribed format available on official website of WRC. The Aadhar Card Nos. of teaching facilities are not mentioned in the submitted list of teaching staff.
- (b) The affidavits on Rs.10 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of individual teaching faculty are not submitted by the institution.
- (c) The institution has submitted the faculties details and it is noted that the institution has not appointed the 04 faculties for Perspectives in Education, 02 faculties for Pedagogy (Math), 01 faculty for Science and 01 faculty for Social Science as per NCTE Norms and Standards for M.Ed. course (Appendix-5) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (d) The details of Ph.D. in Education or in any pedagogy subject is not mentioned. In Sr. No. 2 (Teaching Staff) Asst. professor have M.A. with 50% which is less than the required marks. In Sr. No. 11 Asst. Professor is not having Teacher Education degree and Sr. No. 12 is not having Post Graduate degree.
- (e) The institution has not submitted Affidavit on Rs.100/- non-judicial stamp paper by the authorized person of the management for appointment of Teaching Staff.
- (f) The institution has also not submitted on Rs.10 non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- (g) The institution has submitted Bank Statement (Bank of India) of the Siddhivinayak Shikshan Prasarak Mandal for the period of 01.04.2024 to 15.03.2025 regarding salary disbursement of its teaching staff (1+16) shows entry as follows: -
- (h) Feb 2025 Rs.2,53,800/-, Jan 2025 Rs.2,54,860/-, Dec 2024 Rs.1,92,308/-, Nov Rs.1,92,308/-, Oct 2024 Rs.1,92,308/- & Rs.8,000/-, Sep 2024 Rs 1,92,308/- & Rs.8,000/-, Aug 2024 Rs.1,92,308/- & 8000/-, July 2024 Rs.1,67,632/- & arrears Rs.23,876/- and May 2024, Rs.1,92,380/-. It is not clear whether salary paid to its teaching staff as per guidelines of UGC/State Govt. or not" The institution has submitted pay-bills for the month of Feb 2025 net amount show total salary Rs.4,16,400/- and net salary is Rs.4,00,404/-. In the bank statement Rs.2,53,800/- is reflected and salary bill for the month of Feb, 2025 net salary reflected Rs.4,00,400/- is not tallying.
- (i) The institution has submitted Building Plan dated 22.06.2006 for Rawate Compound C.T.S. 8, S.No. 158 (Part) Taluka: Kurla, Total built up area-

37966.50Sq.ft. and Total land area is not mentioned in the Building plan approved by Up-Pramukh Abhiyanta, Mumbai Mahanagar Palika and Executive Engineer. The institution has submitted True Copy of Site Plan approved by J.B. Bankar Adv. & Notary (15205).

- (j) The institution has submitted copy of letter dated 12.02.2020 in regional language claiming land use. The institution has not submitted Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra/Survey/Plot Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (k) The institution has submitted True Copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate dated 02.01.2020 C.T.S. No. 8 (Part) Survey No. 158 (P) of village Bhandup approved by Tahsildar, Kurla Mulund. The land area is mentioned 520059 Sq. Yrd. and built-up area 35260.25 Sq.ft., the built-up area which does not match with Building Plan.
- (l) The institution has submitted stability report dated 13.01.2024 issued by Private Chartered Engineer instead of Building Safety Certificate. The institution has not submitted Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (m) The institution has submitted copy of Govt. license to M/s. Fire link Services LLP with the copy of Certificate dated 19.03.2025 and certified that inspection report of fire prevention and Life Safety measures installed in the building during the period 01.07.2024 to 31.12.2024 and submitted Certificate to certify that the Fire Extinguishers installed in the clinic of S.S.P.M., R.K. B.Ed. College approved by Fire link Services LLP, date of refilling is 18.03.2026. The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Maharashtra verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Maharashtra.
- (n) The institution has not submitted Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (o) The institution has submitted True Copy of Building Completion Certificate dated 14.01.2020 approved by Asst. Engineer's' Ward Assistant Commissioner Office, Bhandup however, the same is not prescribed format of NCTE (17 points). The built-up area mentioned in it is 30755.50 Sq.ft., which does not match NEC, BCC and Building plan.
- (p) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance with provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that a letter issued to the institution with directions to submit reply/documents supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of the letter."

20. AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of WRC, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution vide letter No. **WRC/NCTE/CF-86449/ APW03737/ 123434/B.Ed./427th/2025/7242-7243** dated 23.07.2025.

21. AND WHEREAS, vide letter No. **22779/25** dated **12.08.2025**, institution submitted their reply as per the query raised by WRC-NCTE.

22. AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by the institution has been considered by WRC 462nd meeting held on 03rd to 4th June 2026 and the committee noted the following deficiencies.

- (i) The list of teaching staff submitted by the institution is neither approved by the affiliating body and nor in the NCTE prescribed format available on official website of WRC.
- (ii) The affidavits on Rs.10 Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of individual teaching faculty are not submitted by the institution.
- (iii) The institution has not submitted the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Govt Authority.
- (iv) The institution has submitted stability report dated 13.01.2024 issued by Private Chartered Engineer instead of Building Safety Certificate. The institution has not submitted Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (v) The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Maharashtra verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Maharashtra.
- (vi) The institution has not submitted Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly issued by the Competent Government Authority.

In view of the above, the WRC decided that the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed course be withdrawn u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the date of issue of order.

23. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby **withdrawing the recognition** granted to **Siddhivinayak Shikshan Prasarak Mandal RK B.ED. College, Ram Nagar, Rawate Compound, Tembepada Road, Bhandup (W), Mumbai-78, Maharashtra** for conducting **B.Ed. programme** of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (2 basic units)** from the **academic session 2025-26**. After withdrawal of recognition, the institution is not permitted to make fresh admissions in the B.Ed. programme. However, the students admitted earlier be allowed to complete the respective programme. On withdrawal of recognition, the affiliation if any granted under Clause 8(10) of NCTE Regulation, 2014 by the concerned affiliating body shall also be withdrawn.

Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission

under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."

इसके अलावा, संस्था और संबद्ध निकाय को एनसीटीई अधिनियम की धारा 17(4) के निम्नलिखित प्रावधानों के बारे में सूचित किया जाता है: -

"यदि कोई संस्था उप-धारा (1) के तहत मान्यता वापस लेने के आदेश के लागू होने के बाद शिक्षक शिक्षा में कोई पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करती है या जहां कोई संस्थान नियत दिन से ठीक पहले शिक्षक शिक्षा में पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने में विफल रहता है या इस अधिनियम के तहत मान्यता या अनुमति प्राप्त करने हेतु उपेक्षा करता है, तो ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण के अनुसार या ऐसी संस्था में पाठ्यक्रम या प्रशिक्षण लेने के बाद प्राप्त शिक्षक शिक्षा में योग्यता को केंद्र सरकार, किसी राज्य सरकार या विश्वविद्यालय या केन्द्रीय सरकार या किसी राज्य सरकार द्वारा सहायता प्राप्त किसी स्कूल, कॉलेज या अन्य शैक्षिक संस्था में रोजगार के उद्देश्य के लिए वैध योग्यता के रूप में नहीं माना जाएगा।"

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
