ORDER OF RESTORATION OF RECOGNITION

28 DEC 2011

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Vaishno Devi B.Ed. Training Degree College, Gondahi, Chergarh, Kunda, Pratagarh, Uttar Pradesh** had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting **B.Ed** Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students on 27.12.2004.

AND WHEREAS, As per decision taken by NRC in its 113th Meeting, the recognition was granted to the institution by NRC vide order no. - F.NRC/NCTE/F-7/13571-14000 dated 24.01.2007 for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred Only) students subject to condition of appointment of qualified staff through duly constuted selection committee as per the norms of NCTE/State Govt..Affiliation University.

AND WHEREAS, As per decision taken by NRC in its 141st Meeting, the recognition was refused vide order dated 25.01.2010.

AND WHEREAS the above said Institution, thereafter preferred an appeal before the Council under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the aforesaid order of NRC and Council reached the conclusion that there was no ground to accept the appeal and hence it should be rejected. Accordingly, the appeal was rejected and NRC's order dated 25.01.2010 was confirmed with the modification that the refusal of recognition may be changed withdrawal of recognition effective from ensuing academic session. The appeal order was placed in its **159th Meeting** and **NRC decided to implement the appeal committee for further action.** Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 24.06.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the above said institution file a Writ Petition No. 3836 (M/B)/2010 before the Hon'ble High Court, Lucknow Bench. The above court order dated 14.05.2010 was considered by the NRC in its **162nd Meeting held from June 24th-27th, 2010b** and **NRC decided to conducted the inspection under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.** Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 02.05.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the above said institution again filed a Writ Petition No. 7248/2010 before the Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad. The court had passed the order dated 20.04.2011 in this matter and the direction was issued to the NRC as below:-

"Sri Vinay Bhusan appearing for NCTE says that though he was not aware about the order dated 02.08.2010 passed by the Court but appropriate final orders, keeping in mind the aforesaid order, shall be passed by the Director within a maximum period of three weeks.

We are constrained to observe that in our order dated 14.05.2010 passed in Writ Petition No. 3836(MB)/2010 filed by the petitioner, one month's time was provided for passing of the final order but the NCTE has slept over the matter and has not complied with the aforesaid order till time.

The Director, therefore, shall also explain the reason as to why he has not passed orders within the time provided by the Court".

AND WHEREAS, the matter was place before NRC in its 183rd (2nd Sitting) Meeting held on June 8th-14th, 2011 in light of the order of Hon'ble High Court dated 02.08.2010 and NRC decided **that institution be asked to furnish the following:-**

1. Documents to clearly establish that the faculty as per NCTE Norms earlier approved by University continues to be available to for the forth coming academic session 2011-12.
2. The reason as to why the website of the institution is not functional.
