RECOGNITION RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution namely **Roorkee Degree College, 341, Dhanauri, Near Piran Kaliyar, Roorkee, Haridwar, Utrakhand-247667** was granted recognition for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/UR-43/13747 dated 05.02.2007 followed by revised recognition vide order No. F.No./NRC/NCTE/UR-43/2015/124888-92 dated 07.10.2015.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the decision taken by the Council in 61st **General Body Meeting** held on **05.08.2024**, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued that required all the recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session(s) 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE portal. The deadline to submit PAR was 10.11.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 7.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE in its 437th meeting held on 01st April 2025 and as per decision taken by the Regional Committee, Show Cause Notice on the ground of **Non-submission of the PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23** was issued by NRC to the institution through online mode on 04.04.2025, a copy of the Show Cause Notice was sent to the institution on 04.04.2025.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE in its 440th meeting held on **14.05.2025** and the committee decided that the recognition/permission for the **B.Ed. Course** granted to **Roorkee Degree College, 341, Dhanauri, Near Piran Kaliyar, Roorkee, Haridwar, Utrakhand-247667** be withdrawn under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the following grounds/reasons with effect from the academic session 2025-2026. The institution is not entitled to admit students in the above referred programmes from the academic session 2025-2026. The students admitted up to the academic session 2024-2025 shall complete their programme:

- The institution has not submitted any reply to the show cause notice.

Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution through online mode vide order No.NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/UR-43 dated 21.05.2025

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution had preferred an appeal against the NRC withdrawal Order dated 27.05.2025. The Appeal Committee vide its order No. O.89-297/e-373622/2025 Appeal/9th Meeting, 2025.APPLNRC202515074/132643 dated 13/09/2025 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision:-

After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hereinabove, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 21.05.2025 and remand back the case to Northern Regional Committee for fresh consideration in accordance with the directions specified hereinabove. The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order, the documents submitted along with the appeal, whereupon the Regional Committee shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the directions contained herein.

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6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 448th meeting held on 27th September 2025 and the Committee decided as under: -

“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -


- ❖ *The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order dated 05.02.2007.*
- ❖ *The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by NRC NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/UR-43 dated 21.05.2025.*
- ❖ *The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 13.09.2025 remanded the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.*

In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course of two-year duration. However, the said institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order. Order be issued accordingly.”

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in the light of above decision of the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE the recognition granted to the institution viz **Roorkee Degree College, 341, Dhanauri, Near Piran Kaliyar, Roorkee, Haridwar, Uttarakhand-247667** for offering **B.Ed.** course of two-year duration with an annual intake of **100 students is hereby RESTORED** until a fresh withdrawal order is issued by NRC.

8. If the Institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made of issued there under, the action including withdrawal of recognition shall be taken by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
