RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Janta Vedic College, Baraut, Baghpat Uttar Pradesh-250611** for offering B.P.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide order no. F. No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-1741/1790-7100 dated 28.07.2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution had not consented to adhere with the NCTE Regulations 2014 and an affidavit in this regard was also not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.P.Ed. course two-year duration was not issued to the institution,

3. AND WHEREAS, in pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in 61st General Body Meeting held on 05.08.2024, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued requiring all the recognized Teacher Education institution (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 on the online NCTE Portal. The last date to submit PAR was 10.01.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

3. AND WHEREAS, the institution has not submitted Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 26.04.2025. The institution has not submitted reply of show cause notice dated 26.04.2025.

4. AND WHEREAS, as per decision of NRC taken in its 441st meeting held on 22.05.2025, the institution for offering B.P.Ed. course was withdrawn vide order no. NCTE/2025/PAR/Order/UP-1741 dated 07.06.2025

5. AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority passed an order dated 28.10.2025 setting aside the NRC order dated 07.06.2025 and remanding the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine

the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations documentary evidence furnished with appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 451st Meeting (Volume-1) held on 19th, 20th & 21st November, 2025 and the Committee decided as under:-


