**RESTORATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Basant Degree College, Village-Tendui, Post- Sarayinyat, District- Allahabad, State-Uttar Pradesh** for offering B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005 vide order No F.NRC/NCTE/UP-959/5413 dated **05.08.2004** followed by revised recognition order for two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order no. F. No. NRC/NCTE/UP-959/2015/103935-40 dated **25.05.2015** was issued to the institution.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, in pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in 61<sup>st</sup> General body Meeting held on 05.08.202, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued requiring all the recognized Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session 2021-22 and 2022-2023 on the online NCTE Portal. The last dated to submit PAR was 10.01.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.04.2025. The institution has not submitted reply of show cause notice dated 29.04.2025.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, as per the decision of NRC taken in its 441<sup>st</sup> Meeting, the recognition for B.Ed. course was withdrawn vide order dated 30.05.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 before the council and the Appellate Authority passed an order dated 26.09.2025 remanding the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 449<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Volume-2) held on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 and the Committee considered the representation dated 09.10.2025 and the Committee decided as under:-

***“The file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -***

- *The recognition was granted to the institution namely Basant Degree College, Village-Tendui, Post-Sarayinyat, District-Allahabad, State-Uttar Pradesh for B.Ed. course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005 vide order No. F. No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/UP-959/5413 dated 05.08.2004 followed by revised recognition order for two year duration with annual intake 100 students from the academic session 2015-2016 vide order no. F. No. NRC/NCTE/UP-959/2015/103935-40 dated 25.05.2015.*
- *In pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in 61<sup>st</sup> General body Meeting held on 05.08.2024, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued requiring all the recognized Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session 2021-22 and 2022-2023 on the online NCTE Portal. - *The institution filed an appeal under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 before the council and the Appellate Authority passed an order dated 26.09.2025 remanding the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.*

***The Committee considered the appeal order dated 26.09.2025, the fact and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course for two- year duration.***

***Further, the said institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Regional Committee within 15 days of receipt of the restoration order.***

***Order be issued accordingly.”***



7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the decision taken by NRC, the recognition granted to the institution namely Basant Degree College, Village-Tendui, Post- Sarayinyat, District- Allahabad, State-Uttar Pradesh offering B.Ed. course of two year duration with an annual intake of 100 students i.e. two basic unit 50 students each is hereby restored.
