**ORDER FOR RESTORATION OF RECOGNITION**

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution namely Rayat College of Physical Education, VPO – Rail Majra, Khasra No. 133/1 & 134/5, Near Ropar, Tehsil- Balachaur, Distt. Nawashahar-144533, Punjab was granted recognition for conducting B.P.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2006-2007 vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/PB-288/2006/4385-4394 dated 07.08.2004.

2. AND WHEREAS, the decision taken by the Council in 61<sup>st</sup> General Body Meeting held on 05.08.2024, a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued that required all the recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session(s) 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE portal. The deadline to submit PAR was 10.11.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 7.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE in its 437<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> April 2025 and as per decision taken by the Regional Committee, Show Cause Notice on the ground of **Non-submission of the PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23** was issued by NRC to the institution through online mode vide Communication F. No. NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/PB-288 dated 01.04.2025.

4. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE in its 440<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14.05.2025 and the committee decided that the recognition/permission for the B.P.Ed. Course granted to Rayat College of Physical Education, VPO – Rail Majra, Khasra No. 133/1 & 134/5, Near Ropar, Tehsil- Balachaur, Distt. Nawashahar-144533, Punjab be withdrawn under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 on the following grounds/reasons with effect from the academic session 2025-2026. The institution is not entitled to admit students in the above referred programmes from the academic session 2025-2026. The students admitted up to the academic session 2024-2025 shall complete their programme:

- The institution has not submitted any reply to the show cause notice.

Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution through online mode vide Order No. NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/PB-288 dated 20.05.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution had preferred an appeal against the NRC withdrawal Order dated 20.05.2025. The Appeal Committee vide its order No.89-45/E-396942/2026 Appeal 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting, 2026/APPLNRC202515475/E-89493/135 dated 26/02/2026 remanded the case back to NRC with the following decision: -

*“After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 20.05.2025 and remand back the case to NRC for fresh consideration strictly in accordance with the direction specified hereinabove. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the NRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of the Appeal order”.*

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the NRC in its 461<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> March 2026 and the Committee decided as under: -

*“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -*

- *Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.P.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide Order dated 07.08.2004.*
- *Recognition of the institution was withdrawn by NRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/PB-288 dated 30.05.2025.*
- *The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 26.02.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished by it with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.*

*In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.P.Ed. course of two-year duration.*

*However, the said institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order.*

*Order be issued accordingly.”*

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in the light of above decision of the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE, recognition granted to the institution namely **Rayat College of Physical Education, VPO – Rail Majra, Khasra No. 133/1 & 134/5, Near Ropar, Tehsil- Balachaur, Distt. Nawashahar-144533, Punjab** vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/F-3/PB-288/2006/4385

4394 dated **07.08.2004** for offering **B.P.Ed.** course is hereby **RESTORED** until a fresh withdrawal order is issued by NRC.

8. If the Institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations, and orders made of issued there under, the action including withdrawal of recognition shall be taken by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
