**RESTORATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely **Lord Krishna Institute, 31, Institutional Area, Phase-1, Greater Noida Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh** for offering B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/f-3/UP-1203/2002/5632-5640 dated **05.08.2004** followed by revised recognition for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1203/2015/113941-47 dated **06.06.2015**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, in pursuance of the decision taken by the Council in 61<sup>st</sup> General body meeting held on 05.08.2024, a public notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued required all the recognized Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) to submit Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23 on the online NCTE Portal. The deadline to submit PAR was 10.01.2024 and the same was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 vide public notice dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has not submitted Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 09.04.2025 for non-submission of PAR. The institution has submitted reply of show cause notice but reply is not satisfactory or not filled both Session.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, as per decision taken by NRC in its 441<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 22.05.2025, the recognition of the institution for offering B.Ed. course was withdrawn vide order No. NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/UP-1203 dated 30.05.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, against the Withdrawal Order dated 30.05.2025. The institution filed an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before the Council and Appellate Authority vide its order dated 11.05.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PARs by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the NRC in its 466<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 02<sup>nd</sup> June 2026 and the Committee decided as under:-

“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- ❖ Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/f-3/UP-1203/2002/5632-5640 dated 05.08.2004 followed by revised recognition for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/UP-1203/2015/113941-47 dated 06.06.2015.
- ❖ Recognition of the institution was withdrawn by NRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/NRC/PAR/Order/UP-1203 dated 30.05.2025 on the grounds mentioned therein.
- ❖ The institution filed an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act 1993 before the Council and the Appellate Authority vide its Order dated 11.05.2026 remanded the case back to NRC with a direction to re-examine the submission of PAR by the institution and consider the documentary evidence furnished by it with the appeal in accordance with the provisions of the NCTE Regulations 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.


***In view of the above, the Committee considered the facts and documents related to the case and decided to restore the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course of two-year duration.***

***However, the said institution is also directed to submit the documents provided along with the appeal for scrutiny and verification by the Regional Committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the restoration order.***

***Order be issued accordingly.”***

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above decision taken by NRC, the recognition granted to the institution namely **Lord Krishna Institute, 31, Institutional Area, Phase-1, Greater Noida Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh** for offering B.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 100 students is hereby restored.
