RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya Mahavidyalaya, Plot Number-223KA, Street/Road-00, Village/Town/City-Shahpur, Post office-Rampur Karkhana, Tehsil/Taluka-Deoria, Town/City-Deoria, State-Uttar Pradesh** for offering B.Ed. course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 students vide Order no. F.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-3079/248th meeting/2015/127241 dated 01.02.2016.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, recognition was also granted to the aforesaid institution for offering D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 50 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/Recognition/D.El.Ed./2016/43468-3892 dated 03.03.2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, Under Secretary, Government of Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 06.01.2025 received in NRC office vide diary No. E-355509 dated 03.02.2025 *inter alia* informed that the institution was granted affiliation for offering D.El.Ed. course for 2 units of 100 students from the academic session 2024-2025.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, as per records of NRC, the institution was recognised for offering D.El.Ed. course for one unit of 50 students, the matter was considered by NRC in its 443rd Meeting (Volume-2) held on 09th to 10th July, 2025 and the Committee *inter alia* decided the recognition granted to the institution for offering D.El.Ed. & B.Ed. course be withdrawn under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order and the institution shall not be entitled to admit the students from the academic session 2025-2026 onwards.

Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 10.09.2025.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed W.P. (C) No. 15781/2025 & CM APPL. 64658/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi against the withdrawal order dated 10.09.2025 and the Hon'ble Court passed an order dated 24.12.2025 with the following directions:-

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- Accordingly, these writ petitions are allowed to the extent of quashing the withdrawal orders dated 10.09.2025 in all the three writ petitions. Respondents are directed to pass consequential orders for restoration of recognition of the Petitioner's institutes for course aforementioned, in respect of which there are no allegations. Further direction is issued to the Respondent to include the Petitioners courses for which NCTE shall issued necessary Public Notice and update the status authority, affiliating body and counselling and admit students for academic session 2025-26. The needful shall be done within three days from today.
 - It is, however made clear that this order will not preclude the concerned authorities to initiate investigation/inquiry and/or any other legal action in respect of the documents purportedly fake or forged in accordance with law.
 - Writ petitions stand disposed of along with pending applications.
6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by NRC in its 454th Meeting held on 29th & 30th December 2025 and the Committee decided that in view of the above directions passed by the Hon'ble Court, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for offering D.El.Ed. course with annual intake of 50 seats (1 unit) is restored. With regard to fake Corrigendum for 2 units of D.El.Ed. course, the matter is referred to the NCTE (HQ) for necessary investigation and appropriate action.
7. **AND WHEREAS**, the restoration Order for D.El.Ed. course vide No. F. No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-13624-D.El.Ed & NRCAPP-3079-B.ED./454th Meeting/ Sl. No. 07/UP/2025/236028-236037 dated 27.02.2026 was issued to the institution.
8. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted a representation dated 26.03.2026 received in NRC office on 13.04.2026 requesting to restore recognition for B.Ed. Course also.
9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 462nd Meeting Part-2 held on 16th & 17th April 2026 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, NCTE Rules 1997, NCTE Regulations 2014, Standards Operating Procedure (SoP) & Guidelines issued by NCTE (HQ) from time to time were placed before the Northern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- Recognition was granted to the aforesaid institution for offering B.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 50 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP-3079/248th meeting/2015/127241 dated 01.02.2016.
- Recognition was also granted to the aforesaid institution for offering D.El.Ed. course of two-year duration with annual intake of 50 students vide Order No. NRC/NCTE/Recognition/D.El.Ed./2016/43468-3892 dated 03.03.2016.
- Under Secretary, Government of Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 06.01.2025 received in NRC office vide diary No. E-355509 dated 03.02.2025 inter alia informed that the institution was granted affiliation for offering D.El.Ed. course for 2 units of 100 students from the academic session 2024-2025.

- Since, as per records of NRC, the institution was recognised for offering D.El.Ed. course for one unit of 50 students, the matter was considered by NRC in its 443rd Meeting (Volume-2) held on 09th to 10th July, 2025 and the Committee inter alia decided the recognition granted to the institution for offering D.El.Ed. & B.Ed. course be withdrawn under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 with effect from the end of academic session next following the date of communication of withdrawal order and the institution shall not be entitled to admit the students from the academic session 2025-2026 onwards.
- Aggrieved with the decision of NRC, the institution filed **W.P. (C)No. 15781/2025 & CM APPL.64658/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi** against the withdrawal order dated **10.09.2025**. The Hon'ble High Court passed an order dated **24.12.2025** with the following directions:-
 - Accordingly, these writ petitions are allowed to the extent of quashing the withdrawal orders dated 10.09.2025 in all the three writ petitions. Respondents are directed to pass consequential orders for restoration of recognition of the Petitioner's institutes for course aforementioned, in respect of which there are no allegations. Further direction is issued to the Respondents to include the Petitioners courses for which NCTE shall issue necessary Public Notice and update the status authority, affiliating body and counselling and admit students for academic session 2025-26.  - Now, the institution has submitted a representation dated 26.03.2026 received in NRC office on 13.04.2026 requesting to restore recognition for B.Ed. Course also.

Hence, in view of the above directions passed by the Hon'ble Court, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution for offering B.Ed. course with annual intake of 50 seats (1 unit) is restored.

Order shall be issued accordingly.

9. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the decision taken by NRC, the recognition granted to the institution namely Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya Mahavidyalaya, Plot Number-223KA, Street/Road-

00, Village/Town/City-Shahpur, Post office-Rampur Karkhana, Tehsil/Taluka-Deoria, Town/City-Deoria, State-Uttar Pradesh for offering B.Ed. Course of two-year duration with an annual intake of 50 students is hereby restored till a fresh withdrawal order is issued by NRC.
