CONTINUATION / SHIFTING ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition U/Section-14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **H.C.M.S.K. College of Education, Basaveshwara Road, Raichur – 584101, Karnataka** vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS01977/B.Ed./2004-2005/8863 dt 30.11.2004 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulation 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit to come under new Regulations vide dated 13.01.2015. Thereafter, the Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 374th Meeting held on 09th – 10th April, 2019 considered the decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, a withdrawal Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS01977/B.Ed/KA/2019/103501-3507 dated 22.04.2019 was issued to the institution.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No. 89-430/E-139680/2019 Appeal/1st Mtg.-2020/29th January, 2020 dated 17.02.2020 appeal remand back the order appealed against.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 385th Meeting held on 03rd March, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.03.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted its reply received on 04.06.2020. The SRC in its 394th Meeting held on 27th – 28th January, 2021 considered the matter and decided to constitute online VT for shifting of premisses. The institution has submitted written representation vide letter 22.09.2025 along with documents.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the online inspection was conducted on 19.12.2025 and VT Report downloaded from VT Portal 19.12.2026 for its consideration. The SRC in its 481st Meeting held on 08th January, 2026 considered the VT Report and decided as follows:-

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -



1. The institution has applied for shifting of premises on 22.09.2025 along with all required documents.
2. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 19.12.2025 on the new building of the institution. As per VT report, the facilities available in the institution are up to mark as per NCTE Rules & Regulations.
3. Apart from above, the institution fulfils all conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order i.e. 1 year B.Ed to 2 years B.Ed program as per NCTE Regulations 2014.

In view of the above, the SRC decided to grant permission to the institution for Shifting of its premises from H.C.M.S.K College of Education, Basaveshwara Road, Raichur-584101, Karnataka to H.C.M.S.K College of Education, Survey No. 157, 1-11-38, Basaveshwara Co-operative Housing Society, Lingsugur Road, Raichur District – 584101, Karnataka.

Further, the Recognition Continuation order for B.Ed. programme with annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic units) be issued to the institution.


8. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., H.C.M.S.K College of Education, Basaveshwara Road, Raichur-584101, Karnataka to shift its building/premises at new address at **H.C.M.S.K College of Education, Survey No. 157, 1-11-38, Basaveshwara Co-operative Housing Society, Lingsugur Road, Raichur District – 584101, Karnataka. Further, the Recognition Continuation order for B.Ed. programme with annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic units)** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

9. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

11. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as



land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 12.** The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 13.** The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
- 14.** The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.


If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
