

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Sree Vyshnavi B.Ed College, No1-564, Janda Street, No. 498, Gooty Village and Mandal, Anantapur-515401, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting **B.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (Hundred) students from the academic session 2012-2013** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

"It may be true that the State Government as well as the first respondent have revised the situation as to the necessary or otherwise of according permission to establish new colleges of education in the State in future and that the existing institutions are found to be adequate. However, the right that is accrued to the petitioners on the basis of their application and consideration thereof by the first respondent cannot be taken away on account of the change in policy. It is settled principle of law that whenever an application is made, it must be considered and processed in accordance with the provisions of law that existed as on the date of presentation. Subsequent changes may apply to the applications that are made thereafter. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of directing the first respondent to take necessary steps as contemplated in its communication dated 24.11.2009 and pass appropriate orders. There shall be no order as to costs."

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 196th Meeting held on 15-16 September, 2010 considered the matter and directed the Management/institution to resubmit the old application returned by SRC along with necessary documents as originally submitted relating to land, building, FDR, Application fee, Building Completion Certificate from competent Government Engineer/authority and other relevant aspects for processing and for necessary action.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly letter was issued to the institution on 25.10.2010 and institution has submitted its reply on 18/03.2011 and 25.03.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the committee in its 203rd meeting held on 31st March & 1st April 2011 considered the written reply and other relevant documents submitted by the institution and decided to cause inspection for B.Ed (APS09644) course, and to ascertain infrastructural and instructional facilities. Accordingly inspection was conducted on 04.04.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided in 205th meeting of SRC to serve Show cause Notice for the following:

- **Non-Encumbrance certificate from the competent authority is to be submitted.**

AND WHEREAS, as per direction of SRC, Show Cause Notice issued on 30.06.2011. The institution has already submitted reply vide letter dated 20.06.2011, explaining and clarifying the points raised in the show cause notice.

AND WHEREAS, the Committee in its 208th Meeting of SRC considered the reply of the institution dated 01.06.2011, and decided to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulation, for grant of recognition to B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100(One hundred only)(one unit) subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

AND WHEREAS, a letter of intent was issued to the institution on 20.07.2011. The institution submitted in its reply on 07.09.2011. SRC considered the reply submitted by the institution in its 211th Meeting held on 21st - 23rd September and decided that Formal recognition be granted to B.Ed., course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (One hundred only) student for the academic year 2012-13, subject to the rectification of deficiencies in staff list, if any.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sree Vyshanavi Educational Society, S No. 498, Near Kalawagadda Anjaneya Swamy Temple, Gooti Anantapura District - 515 401, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE in the name of Sree Vyshnavi B.Ed College, No1-564, Janda Street, Gooty Village and Mandal, Anantapur-515401, Andhra Pradesh for seeking grant of recognition for conducting B.Ed Course of one year duration on 20.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the file was under process and in the meanwhile, in view of the recommendations of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter dated 07.01.2009 not to further Recognize/permit the institutions for conducting B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit course(s).

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 169th Meeting held on 12-13 January, 2009 having considered the letter dated 07.01.2009 of State Government of Andhra Pradesh and decided to give effect to the above decision of State Government of Andhra Pradesh as such, with immediate effect. A letter dated 07.02.2009 forwarded by Principal Secretary of Education requesting not to accord further recognition/permission to the new colleges/private B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit in the State of Andhra Pradesh as the above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required.

AND WHEREAS, a letter dated 17.03.2009 has been received from NCTE, Hqrs informing that "The recommendations of the Govt of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition/permission in respect of other courses like B.Ed, D.Ed and Physical Education courses have further been decided that no further Recognition/ Permission to any institution in the State of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-2010 for B.Ed, D.Ed, and Physical Education courses also".

AND WHEREAS, the State Government vide its letter dated 20.03.2009 informed that it has been decided not to recommend the name of this institution. The letters dated 07.01.2009, 07.02.2009, 17.03.2009 and 20.03.2009 was considered by SRC in its 172nd Meeting held on 25-26 March, 2009 and SRC decided to accept the recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, not to grant recognition to any of the Teacher Training Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009-2010 and decided to close the applications. As per the decision of SRC the application was closed on 27.04.2009 and original application was returned.

AND WHEREAS, the Institute has approached Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.11241/2009. Now, the Hon'ble High Court has passed an order on 16.12.2009 vide W.P.No.6712 of 2009 given as hereunder.
