ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 RAMARAJA WOMENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, CHITTOR REVENUE DIVISION, 18-1-90/14/4, YASODA NAGAR, K.T.ROAD, TIRUPATHI - 517 507, CHITTOR DT, ANDHRA PRADESH had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year from the academic session 2002-03 with an annual intake of 120 students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above-mentioned land.

Or

- The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in rented / temporary premises.
- iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5.00 Lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3704000
- iv) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and 10 teachers for the said course.


3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to RAMARAJA WOMENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, CHITTOR DT, ANDHRA PRADESH for B.Ed. Course of One year from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 100 students subject to fulfillment of the following :

- a) The institution will ensure that 10 faculty members duly approved by the affiliating body are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).



- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations and the institution shall be visited on any day after three months from the date of issue of recognition order for ensuring its satisfactory performance.
4. Further, recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government, etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant
6. This Order of recognition is subject to the outcome of C.A.No.7756, 7757 & 7758 of 2001 filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against order of the Hon'ble Division Bench in W.A.No. 626/2000 of the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above condition or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
