EXTRAORDINARY
RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Raja Foundation College of Education, Kona Road, Mylavaram, Kadapa-516439, Andhra Pradesh** vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07201/B.Ed/2007-2008/11442 dtd. 17.09.2007 for conducting **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 21.01.2015 and the Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic Units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on 07th to 09th January, 2020 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS07201 /B.Ed/AP/2019/113945-3951 dated 17.01.2020 was issued to the institution.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-61/E-155214/2020 Appeal/12th Mtg.-2020/24th July, 2020 dated 10.09.2020 and the Council remands back the case.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 389th meeting held on 12th and 14th October, 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.10.2020. The institution submitted its reply to the final show cause notice on 11.11.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 399th meeting held on 15th – 16th June, 2021 considered the matter and decided as to issue last reminder letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a last reminder letter was issued to the institution on 01.07.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 22.05.2025.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 09.01.2026 passed in W.P.(C) 19507/2025 titled "Raja Foundation College of Education Vs National Council

for Teacher Education & ANR" *inter-alia* directed the SRC to pass the order of restoration in favour of the petitioner institution. The operative part of the order reads as under :-

"3. Mr. Rupal, learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.1 submits that he has no objection in case a similar order is passed in the present petition.

4. In view of the above, it is clarified that the remand order dated 10.09.2020 would also be treated as quashing the withdrawal order dated 17.01.2020.

5. Accordingly, the Southern Regional Committee ("SRC") is directed to pass the order of restoration in favour of the petitioner institution for recognition of the concerned course in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today. The said order shall remain subject to further decision to be taken by the SRC.

6. A copy of the order of restoration of recognition of the petitioner institution for the concerned course will have to be communicated to all concerned. Once the order of restoration is passed, the petitioner institution would be entitled to participate in counselling and admission process for the Academic Year 2025-26 and subsequent years.


7. The application is disposed of in aforesaid terms. W.P.(C) 19507/2025 8. In view of the order in the above application, the present writ petition is disposed of."

8. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 484th Meeting held on 23rd January, 2026 considered the Court matter and decided as under:-

In compliance of the Order dated 09.01.2026 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in 19507/2025 titled "Raja Foundation College of Education" vs NCTE and arr" the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 is hereby restored. A restoration order be issued by SRC. Further, the name of the institution be maintained on the NCTE website. State Government and Affiliating Body or University also be informed of the said restoration.

9. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above order passed by Appeal Remand Back Case, the status of **Raja Foundation College of Education, Kona Road, Mylavaram, Kadapa-516439, Andhra Pradesh** for B.Ed. programme for **2 basic units of 50 students** (Total intake = 100 students) is restored.
