**RESTORATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition U/Section-14 of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Al-Meezan Educational Association's B.Ed. College, Highlands, Anandnagar Road, Hubli – 580024, Dharwad District, Karnataka** vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/4826 dated 21.12.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution submitted affidavit dated 30.01.2015 for its willingness & adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015.16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to Withdrawal the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Withdrawal Order vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO3724/B.Ed./{KAR}/2021/129746 dt. 30.12.2021 was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 23.12.2025 passed in W.P.(C) 14579/2025 titled "AL-MEEZAN Educational Associations B.ED. College Vs National Council for Teacher Education & ANR" inter-alia directed the SRC to pass the order of restoration in favour of the petitioner institution. The operative part of the order reads as under :-

*"5. Having heard learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner and counsel for the Respondents and looking to the fact that as of today the deficiencies that remain to be cured, even according to the Respondents are: (a) approved list of faculty; and (b) BCC. Petitioner is willing to furnish the documents within three weeks from today and on furnishing the documents, Respondents have no objection in reconsidering the withdrawal order. Petitioner is right in submitting that the withdrawal order was not communicated by the Respondents and despite best efforts, Mr. Rupal is unable to establish that communication was sent. It is trite that no order can be enforced until it is communicated to the effected party. This Court also finds merit in the contention of the Petitioner that there are serious discrepancies in the deficiencies/shortcomings pointed out in the show cause notices and the withdrawal/appellate orders and thus, the withdrawal order and consequently the appellate order are unsustainable in law.*

*6. Accordingly, this writ petition is allowed to the extent of quashing the withdrawal order dated 30.12.2021 as also appellate order dated 20.08.2025. As undertaken, Petitioner will furnish the approved list of the faculty as also the BCC within three weeks from today. On receipt of the documents, Respondents shall take a fresh decision on withdrawal of recognition within two weeks from the date of receipt of the documents and communicate the same to the Petitioner, who is at liberty to take recourse to legal proceedings in case of any surviving grievance.*

*7. Writ petition is disposed of along with the pending application."*

  
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5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution submitted written representation vide letter dated 29.01.2026 and received on 30.01.2026. The SRC in its 484<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2026 considered the Court matter and decided as follows:-

1. The institution is required to submit latest faculty list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed format developed by NCTE.
2. The institution is also required to submit an affidavit from the Management of the institution on Rs. 100/- judicial stamp paper as well as from individual affidavits from each faculty member on Rupees 10/- Non-Judicial stamp paper consenting there in to come under NCTE Regulation 2014 as amended from time to time and adherence of the same.

**Keeping in view of the above, the SRC decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution thereby providing final opportunity to the institution for making its representation within 21 days along with all relevant documents from the date of issue this notice.**

6. **AND THEREFORE**, the SCN is being issues. The institution is required to submit the representation/compliance accompanied with an affidavit from the authorized representation of the Management. The representation along with an affidavit must reach this office within the time specified at the end.

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, the matter was considered by 'SRC in its 485<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 considered the Court matter and decided as follows:-

*"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -*

*The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its order dated 23.12.2025 passed in W.P.(C) 14579/2025 titled "AL-MEEZAN Educational Associations B.ED. College Vs National Council for Teacher Education & ANR" inter-alia directed the SRC to pass the order of restoration in favour of the petitioner institution.*

1. *Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 24.01.2026.*
2. *The institution has submitted its reply on 30.01.2026 along with latest and duly approved faculty list as well as Affidavit an affidavit from Management on Rs 100/- stamp paper & individual Affidavits on Rs 10/- stamp paper from the individual faculty members.*

**Decision of SRC:**

***In compliance of the Order dated 23.12.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C)14579 of 2025 titled "Al-MEEZAN Educational Associations B.Ed. College Vs NCTE and others" the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 students be restored. A restoration order be issued to the institution. Further, the name of the institution be maintained on the NCTE website. State Government and Affiliating Body or University also be informed of the said restoration."***
