**ORDER**

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely AP College of Elementary Education, Plot No.609, Duddeda Village and Post Office, Kondapak Taluk and City, Medak District-502277, Andhra Pradesh (Now Telangana) run by Rao's Educational Cultural and Welfare Society, Plot No.609, Ramapally Road, Duddeda Village and Post Office, Kondapak Taluk and City, Medak district-502277, Andhra Pradesh vide order No.F.No.SRCAPP546/D.EI.Ed./AP/2012/45878 dated 05.09.2012 for conducting D.EI.Ed. Course of two-years duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2012-2013.

2. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 329<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06<sup>th</sup> – 07<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 considered the VT Report and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.03.2017. The institution submitted its reply along with documents on 27.03.2017 and written representation along with application for shifting of premises and documents on 11.08.2017.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 345<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2017 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide 13.10.2017. The institution submitted its written representation along with shifting application on 13.10.2017 and written representation on 24.10.2017.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 348<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup>& 06<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 considered the matter and decided a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 12.12.2017. The institution submitted its reply along with documents on 24.01.2018 and 13.04.2018.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 360<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> -24<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 (P-considered the matter and decided to issue a Show cause Notice. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.05.2018. Now, the institution submitted its reply along with documents on 16.10.2018.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 367<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 considered the matter and decided as a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 13.03.2019. The institution submitted its reply to the show cause notice on 04.02.2019 and letter dated 05.04.2019.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 375<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO0546/D.El.Ed/TS/2019/104752-4757 dated 29.05.2019 was issued to the institution.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.91-26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> Mtg./2019-/Appeal/82834 dated 07.10.2019 and the Council remands back the case.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> Oct & 01<sup>st</sup> Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue a letter to SCERT, Telangana. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the SCERT on 21.11.2019. The institution has submitted its reply along with the documents vide letter dated 10.09.2020.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 388<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 considered and decided to constitute the Visiting Team for inspection. As per the direction of SRC, the inspection was conducted on 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.

11. **AND WHERAES**, the SRC in its 395<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021 was considered the matter and decided to issue a letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 08.03.2021. The institution has submitted a NOC vide letter dated 02.02.2023 along with court order dated 22.07.2022.

12. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution was filed W.P. No.30351 of 2022 and Hon'ble High Court of Telangana at Hyderabad, while disposing the WP had passed a judgement on 22.07.2022.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 421<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2023 has considered the matter and decided to obtain from the institution the status of the Society/Trust since inception of the institution till date alongwith the location, address where the institution was first recognised and now whether the institution is functioning from the same place or not which is to be duly authenticated by the concerned Revenue and affiliating authority. Accordingly, as



per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 21.02.2023. A letter dated 11.07.2023 has been submitted by the institution regarding the Status Report.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 428<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2023 considered the matter and decided as under:-

***“The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -***

***The reply submitted by the institution dated 11.07.2023 with reference to the Letter dated 21.02.2023 is found satisfactory, therefore, the institution A.P. College of Elementary Education, Plot No.609, Duddeda Village and Post Office, Kondapak Taluk and City, Medak District-502277, Telangana stands as recognized for running D.El.Ed. programme with 1 basic unit of 50 students”.***

15. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. A.P. College of Elementary Education, H.No.1-9-149/7/2, Karasgutti Road, Narayankhed Mandal, district Sangareddy-502286, Telangana run by Rao's Educational Cultural and Welfare Society, Plot No.609, Ramapally Road, Duddeda Village and Post Office, Kondapak Taluk and City, Medak district-502277, Andhra Pradesh (Now Telangana) stands as recognized for running D.El.Ed. Programme with 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

16. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.



17. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

18. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

19. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

20. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

21. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the




Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
