REVISED RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Amritha Akshitha College of Education, Khasara No. 862, Plot No. 36-242, Metpally Village, Wanaparthy Post and Taluk and City, Mahabubnagar District – 509103, Telangana** run by **MSC Educational Society, Plot No. 36-242, Pangal Road, Metpally Village, Wanaparthy Post and Taluk and City, Mahabubnagar District – 509103, Telangana** vide Order No. F.No./SRCAPP834/D.EI.Ed./TS/2016-2017/85099 dtd. 02.05.2016 for conducting **D.EI.Ed.** course of two-year duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one unit)** from the academic session 2013-2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the recognition of the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order No. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/SRCAPP834 dated 16.05.2025 on the grounds of non-submission of PAR for the Academic Session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.

3. AND WHEREAS, against, the withdrawal order dated 16.05.2025 the institution has filed Writ Petition bearing No. 9177/2025 & CM APPL.38955/2025 before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi titled as "**Amritha Akshitha College of Education Versus NCTE & others**" whereby the Hon'ble High Court vide Order dated 20.03.2026 has passed following directions:-

"1. The learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioners urges the Court that the present petitions may also be disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court on 15.12.2025 in batch of petitions, lead case being W.P.(c) 5369/2025 titled as Teacher Training College Mirza vs. National Council of Teacher Education & Anr.

2. Mr. Anuj Kapoor and Ms. Geetanjali Mohan learned counsels appearing on behalf of respondents/NCTE submit that they have no objection in case such an order is passed.

3. In view of the above, the present petitions along with pending applications are disposed of in terms of order dated 15.12.2025, the benefit of which shall also ensure to the present petitioners."

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 499th Meeting held on 26th May, 2026 considered the matter and decided as under:-



"In compliance of the decision of SRC in its 497th Meeting held on 18.05.2026, Legal Consultant, SRC has prepared a detailed Report and put up before the Committee. The Report is taken on record. As per the said Report it has been provided that the present matter falls within the ambit of 68th General Body Meeting of NCTE and Order dated 15.12.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in PAR matters lead case being W.P.(C)5369 of 2025 titled "Teachers Training College Mirza vs National Council for Teacher Training" and that filing of review petition against Order dated 20.03.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi is not recommended.

Keeping in view of the above, the SRC decided as follows:

1. *A restoration order be issued to the institution for the D.El.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 50 students (1 basic unit of 50 students) and the name of the institution be maintained on the website in the list of the recognised institutions. The State Government/Affiliating Body/University concerned also be informed accordingly. In the meanwhile, the petitioner institution is permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-2026 and admit students for the said academic session."*
5. **AND WHEREAS**, a Restoration Order dated 29.05.2026 was issued and the institution was permitted to participate in the counselling for the academic session 2025-2026 and admit students for the said academic session.
6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed a contempt case bearing no. CONT.CAS(C) 1056/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The contempt petition was heard by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 17.06.2026. The operative part of the order is as under:

"5. In view of the above, the Respondents are directed to issue a revised restoration order in respect of the Petitioner, specifically permitting it to participate in the counselling process from the Academic session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26. The said shall also be communicated to the concerned university.
7. **AND WHEREAS**, the O/o SRC received the order of the Court dated 17.06.2026 through the representation made by the petitioner institute via email dated 21.06.2026.
8. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 505th Meeting held on 22nd June, 2026 considered the above Court directions and decided as under:-

"The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

- *The institution filed a contempt case bearing no. CONT.CAS(C) 1056/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The contempt petition was heard by the Hon'ble*



High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 17.06.2026. The operative part of the order is as under:

"5. In view of the above, the Respondents are directed to issue a revised restoration order in respect of the Petitioner, specifically permitting it to participate in the counselling process from the Academic session 2026-27 instead of 2025-26. The said shall also be communicated to the concerned university.

6. Let the needful be done before 19.06.2026."

The O/o SRC received the order of the Court dated 17.06.2026 through the representation made by the petitioner institute via email dated 21.06.2026.

Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as follows:

"In compliance of the directions passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 17.06.2026 in Cont.Cas(C)1056/2026, a revised Restoration Order be issued to the institution permitting the institution to participate in the counselling from the Academic Session 2026-27 for D.El.Ed. programme with annual intake of **50 students (One Basic Unit)**. The same shall be communicated to the affiliating body/university as well."

9. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above, Revised Restoration order is hereby issued to **Amritha Akshitha College of Education, Khasara No. 862, Plot No. 36-242, Metpally Village, Wanaparthi Post and Taluk and City, Mahabubnagar District – 509103, Telangana** permitting the institution to participate in the counselling from the Academic Session 2026-27 for D.El.Ed. programme with annual intake of **50 students (One Basic Unit)**. It is also communicated to the affiliating body/university as well.
