RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition u/s 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely, **Saraswathi College of Teacher Training, Plot/Khasra No. 989/2, Giddalur Village and Post, Giddalur City and Taluk, Prakasam District – 523357, Andhra Pradesh** vide Order No. SRCAPP802/D.El.Ed./AP/2012/46230 dated 18.09.2012 for conducting D.El.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students from the academic session 2012-2013.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the recognition of the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide Order No. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/SRCAPP802 dated 19.05.2025 on the grounds of non-submission of PAR for the academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Public Notice was issued on 01.10.2025, whereby stay on withdrawal order was implemented.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, against the withdrawal order, the petitioner Institution filed a W.P.(C)15027 of 2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Writ Petition was disposed of vide a common order dtd. 15.12.2025, the operated part of which is reproduced hereunder:

"12. In light of the above, and having regard to the decision taken by the NCTE in its 68th (General) Body Meeting as noted above, as well as, the statement made by Mr. Kapoor, the present petitions are allowed and the impugned orders are set aside.

13. Resultantly, the respondent NCTE will pass an "order of restoration" of recognition in each case and the names of the petitioners shall be included in the list of recognized institutions maintained on the website of the respondents.

14. Simultaneously, status of the petitioners as "recognized institution" shall also be communicated to the concerned State Government and Affiliating Body or University.

15. The above exercise of passing an order of restoration of recognition as well as communicating the State Government and Affiliating Body/University shall be completed before the issuance of public notice as mentioned in para 8 (ii) above.

16. In the meanwhile, petitioner institutes are permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-26 and admit students for the said academic session

13. Resultantly, the respondent NCTE will pass an "order of restoration" of recognition in each case and the names of the petitioners shall be included in the list of recognized institutions maintained on the website of the respondents.

14. Simultaneously, status of the petitioners as "recognized institution" shall also be communicated to the concerned State Government and Affiliating Body or University.

15. The above exercise of passing an order of restoration of recognition as well as communicating the State Government and Affiliating Body/University shall be completed before the issuance of public notice as mentioned in para 8 (ii) above.

16. In the meanwhile, petitioner institutes are permitted to participate in the counselling for academic session 2025-26 and admit students for the said academic session.

17. Pending applications stand disposed of."

- Further, the institution has filed CONTEMPT PETITION (CIVIL) NO. Nil OF 2026.
- The Contempt Petition has not been listed till date.

Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as under:

- The recognition granted to the Saraswathi College of Teacher Training, Plot/Khasra No. 989/2, Giddalur Village and Post, Giddalur City and Taluk, Prakasam District – 523357, Andhra Pradesh vide Order No. F.No. SRCAPP802/D.El.Ed./AP/2012/46230 dated 18.09.2012 for D.El.Ed. programme for 50 students be restored.
- The restoration order be communicated to the State Government/Affiliating Body and other concerned and the same be uploaded on the NCTE website.

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above decision of SRC, the recognition granted to the Saraswathi College of Teacher Training, Plot/Khasra No. 989/2, Giddalur Village and Post, Giddalur City and Taluk, Prakasam District – 523357, Andhra Pradesh vide Order No. F.No. SRCAPP802/D.El.Ed./AP/2012/46230 dated 18.09.2012 for D.El.Ed. programme for 50 students is hereby restored.
