Subject: Decision of SRC 513th (Emergent) meeting held on 29th August, 2026 - regd.

Sir/Madam,

The matter of the Institution namely, VIJAYA College of Education, Plot no. 898, Chillamkur Village, Chirraju Palli Grampanchayat, Yerraguntla Mandal, Chilamakur - 516310, Cuddapah, Andhra Pradesh was placed in the 513th meeting of SRC held on 29th August, 2026 and the SRC decided as follows:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

(i) The SRC in its 456th Meeting had considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the Institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution through online mode on 11.04.2025. The institution did not submit any reply to the Show Cause Notice.

(ii) No PAR was filed by the institution for the year 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The SRC in its 461st Meeting held on 27th May, 2025 considered the matter and decided that

recognition granted to the institution be withdrawn U/s 17 of the NCTE Act, on the following grounds with effect from the academic session 2025-26.

i. The institution has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice.

(iii) Accordingly, the withdrawal order dated 02.06.2025 was issued to the institution.

(iv) The institution filed a Writ Petition no. W.P.(C)11966/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 19.08.2026 passed the following directions:

"8. In view of the above, issue notice. Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents accepts notice. He submits that the present petition ought not to be entertained for the reason that there is a statutory remedy available in terms of Section 18 of the NCTE Act, against the order of withdrawal of recognition.

9. However, on being queried by the Court, Mr. Kapoor fairly states that in similar matters notice has been issued and interim relief has also been granted.

10. Let counter affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.

11. Re-notify on 23.09.2026 alongwith W.P.(C) 8569/2025.

12. In the meanwhile, having regard to the submissions noted hereinabove, which prima facie appears to have substance, and further regard being had to the fact that in similar matters stay has been granted while issuing notice, the operation of the impugned withdrawal order dated 02.06.2025 is stayed till the next date of hearing and the petitioner are permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students in the academic session 2026-27.

13. It is further directed that, subject to verification, respondent/NCTE shall update the status of petitioner institutions as recognized institutions on their official website and will also intimate all concerned, including State Authority, Affiliating Authorities and Counselling Authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order dated 02.06.2025 in respect of such listed institutes have been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2026-2027, which shall be complied with

(v) The Hon'ble Court has granted interim relief to the petitioner.

2. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, the SRC decided as under:



A communication may be issued to the concerned State, Affiliating Body/University and Counselling Authority to the effect that the operation of the impugned withdrawal order no. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/SRCAPP14518/ dated 02.06.2025 has been stayed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and that the institution is permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students for the academic session 2026-27. This communication should also be uploaded on the NCTE website.

2. The above decision of the SRC is communicated hereby.
