Subject: Decision of SRC 512th meeting held on 18th – 21st August, 2026.

Sir/Madam,

WHEREAS, the matter of the Institution namely, **Cattamanchi Ramalinga Reddy College of Education, Survey No. 135, Dinnedvrapadu Village Street, Ward No. 05, Kurnool Mandal, Grampanchayat Kurnool-518002, Andhra Pradesh** was granted recognition vide SRC Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2006-2007/2915 dated 16.05.2007 for B.Ed. (Secondary) Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit on 19.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence provisions of new Regulations, 2014 (Amendment from time to time). A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 06.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two Basic Units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Corrigendum was issued to the institution vide SRC's letter No. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO7036/B.Ed./AP/2015/77112 dated 27.10.2015 for grants recognition to **Cattamanchi Ramalinga Reddy College of Education, Survey No. 135, Dinnedvrapadu Village Street, Ward No. 05, Kurnool Mandal, Grampanchayat Kurnool-518002, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students of one basic unit from academic session 2015-2016.**

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 399th Meeting held on 15th & 16th June, 2021 had considered the matter and decided to issue Continuation Order to the Institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Continuation Order vide No. F.SRO/NCTE/AP/APSO7036/B.Ed./2021/126949-6955 dated 01.07.2021 was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, PAR was not filed by the institution for the year 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. Accordingly, the recognition the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order No. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/B.Ed/ dated 05.06.2025 from the academic session 2025-2026 on the grounds of non-submission of PAR for the Academic Session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed a Writ Petition No. W.P.(C)11449/2026 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court vide its order dated 11.08.2026 passed the following directions:

"8. In view of the above, issue notice.

9. Mr. Anuj Kapoor, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, accepts notice. He submits that the present petition ought not to be entertained for the reason that there is a statutory remedy available in terms of Section 18 of the NCTE Act, against the order of withdrawal of recognition.

10. However, upon being queried by the Court, Mr. Kapoor fairly states that in similar matters, notice has been issued and interim relief has also been granted.

11. Let counter affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.

12. Re-notify on 23.09.2026 alongwith W.P.(C) 8569/2025.

13. In the meanwhile, having regard to the submissions noted hereinabove, which prima facie appear to have substance, and further regard being had to the fact that in similar matters stay has been granted while issuing notice, the operation of the impugned withdrawal orders/decisions is stayed till the next date of hearing and the petitioners are permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students in the academic session 2026-27.

14. It is further directed that, subject to verification, respondent/NCTE shall update the status of petitioner institutions as "recognized institutions" on their official website and will also intimate all concerned, including State Authority, Affiliating Authorities and Counselling Authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of such listed institutes has been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2026-2027, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE in two weeks' time, by 31.08.2026.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 512th Meeting held on 18th – 21st August, 2026 considered the matter and decided as under:-

Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as under:

A communication may be issued to the concerned State, Affiliating Body/University and Counselling Authority to the effect that the operation



of the impugned withdrawal order no. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/B.Ed/ dated 05.06.2025 has been stayed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and that the institution is permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students for the academic session 2026-27. This communication should also be uploaded on the NCTE website.

8. The decision of the committee is communicate hereby.
