Subject: Decision of SRC 514th meeting held on 31st Aug to 03rd Sep, 2026.

Sir/Madam,

The matter of the institution namely, Nova College of Physical Education, R.S. No. 54/2, Vegavaram Post, Jangareddygudem, West Godavari – 534447, Andhra Pradesh was placed before the SRC in its 514th Meeting held during 31st August to 03rd September, 2026 and the Committee considered the matter and decided as under:-

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Court order, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were placed before the Committee and the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

- (i) The matter of the Institution namely, Nova College of Physical Education, R.S. No. 54/2, Vegavaram Post, Jangareddygudem, West Godavari – 534447, Andhra Pradesh was granted recognition vide SRC Order No. F.No.SRCAPP433/B.P.Ed/AP/45573 dated 27.08.2012 for conducting B.P.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.
- (ii) On promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted an affidavit on 23.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.P.Ed. course and adherence provisions of new Regulations, 2014 (Amendment from time to time). A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 19.05.2015 for conducting B.P.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (Two Section of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16.
- (iii) PAR was not filed by the institution for the year 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. Accordingly, the recognition the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order No. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/SRCAPP433/150910-150912 dated 02.06.2025 from the academic session 2025-2026 on the grounds of non-submission of PAR for the Academic Session 2021-2022 and 2022-2023.
- (iv) The institution has filed a Writ Petition W.P.(C) 12220/2026 & CM APPL. 56565/2026 before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi bearing title as "NOVA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION Versus NCTE & Others" whereby the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 21.08.2026 has directed the SRC as under:-

" 9. Mr. Anuj Kapoor, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, accepts notice. He submits that the present petition ought not to be entertained for the reason that there is a statutory remedy available in terms of Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the order of withdrawal of recognition.

10. However, on being queried by the Court, Mr. Kapoor fairly states that in similar matters, notice has been issued and interim relief has also been granted.

11. Let counter affidavit be filed within a period of 2 weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within a period of 2 weeks thereafter.

12. Re-notify on 23.09.2026 alongwith W.P.(C) 8569/2025.

13. In the meanwhile, having regard to the submissions noted hereinabove, which prima facie appears to have substance, and further regard being had to the fact that in similar matters stay has been granted while issuing notice, the operation of the impugned withdrawal orders/decisions is stayed till the next date of hearing and the petitioners are permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students in the academic session 2026-27.

14. It is further directed that, subject to verification, respondent/NCTE shall update the status of petitioner institutions as recognized institutions on their official website and will also intimate all concerned, including State Authority, Affiliating Authorities and Counselling Authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of such listed institutes have been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2026- 2027, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE in two weeks' time, by 03.09.2026."

(v) The Hon'ble Court has granted interim relief to the institution.

Keeping in view the above, the SRC decided as under:

A communication may be issued to the concerned State, Affiliating Body/University and Counselling Authority to the effect that the operation of the impugned withdrawal order no. NCTE/2025/SRC/PAR/ORDER/SRCAPP433 /150910-150912 dated 02.06.2025 has been stayed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and that the institution is permitted to participate in the counselling and admit students for the academic session 2026-27. This communication should also be uploaded on the NCTE website.

The decision of the committee is communicated hereby.
