Order

WHEREAS Ranchi Womens College, Circular Road, Ranchi, Jharkhand-834001 (Code No. APE00287) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 12.05.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The institution shall ensure that one HOD and seven faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position before the commencement of the B.Ed. course and confirmation to this effect may be sent to the ERC within one month from the commencement of the academic session.
- (ii) The institution shall ensure that all teachers are appointed on full time and regular basis as per NCTE norms.
- (iii) The institution shall submit a list of teachers duly counter signed by the competent authority of the affiliating University within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that all the teachers and other staff are paid regular salary as per UGC/State Govt. pay scale and the acquaintance roll shall be sent to ERC, NCTE within 3 months of the commencement of the course.
- (v) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (vi) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition.
- (vii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda - Vs - Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-41/2014/NCTE/Insp./A86393 dated 30.04.2014 with the following observations:-

- (i) The institution has failed to observe the NCTE prescribed norms related to instructional facilities and engagement of academic and supporting staff as it does not have.
 - > Well demarcated campus.
 - > Appropriately equipped Resource Rooms.
 - > Regular HOD.

- The required Teaching and supporting staff on regular basis.
- It is not maintaining Endowment and Reserve Funds jointly with the Regional Director, ERC, Bhubaneswar, as required.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted any representation in response to deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 within the stipulated period to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the matter and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26663 dated 03.07.2014 for compliance of the above deficiencies pointed out by NCTE Hqrs.

4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 10.07.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174th Meeting held on 5th August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26953 dated 18.08.2014.

(i) The institution has failed to observe the NCTE prescribed norms related to instructional facilities and engagement of academic and supporting staff as it does not have.

- Well demarcated campus.
- Appropriately equipped Resource Rooms.
- Regular HOD.
- The required Teaching and supporting staff on regular basis.
- It is not maintaining Endowment and Reserve Funds jointly with the Regional Director, ERC, Bhubaneswar, as required.

5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 30.08.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 175th Meeting held on 09.09.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqrs. as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-

- (i) Well demarcated campus and appropriately equipped Resource Rooms are lacking. The institution has not submitted any resolution for demarcated the land for exclusively B.Ed. Programme along with building map duly approved by the University Engineer. Also the institution has not submitted any application for shifting of B.Ed. department in the new demarcated land and building along with other required documents.
- (ii) The institution has not appointed the principal and other teaching staff, supporting staff on regular basis as per requirement of NCTE norms.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

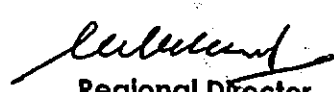
