## Order

WHEREAS Tata College, Chaibasa, Singhbhum (West), Jharkhand-833202 (Code No. APE00292) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 18.03.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

(i) The Institution will ensure that Principal and at least 7 (seven) faculty members qualified as per NCTE norms and duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent the Eastern Regional Committee.

(ii) The institution will ensure that documentary evidence with regard to separate Deptt./autonomy with B.Ed. Department, library, educational, psychology and science laboratories, separate building for B.Ed. course, salary to the teaching ans non-teaching staff, maintaining reserve fund as per NCTE norms be submitted to ERC, NCTE before commencement of the academic session.

(iii) The institution shall ensure financial management with a separate budget for the Teacher Training Department. The Department of Teacher Education shall shift to its own building having separate campus within a period of 3 years.

(iv) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.

(v) That the Reserve fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the teachers and staff be created within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/institution, for a period of not less than sixty months (five years) in a Nationalized Bank.

(vi) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.

- 2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda Vs Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon! ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon! ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hars., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hars, issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-65/2014/NCTE/Insp./A86417 dated 30.04.2014 with the following observations:-
  - (i) The institution is deficient in terms of both infrastructural and instructional facilities.

(ii) The institution has not adhered to the prescribed norms relating to the terms and conditions of service of the teaching and non-teaching staff.

(iii) The institution is not maintaining endowment fund and reserve fund in the form of FDRs as required as per the prescribed NCIE norms.

3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted any representation in response to deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 within the stipulated period to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 172nd Meeting held on 17th June 2014 considered the matter and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26514 dt. 25.06.2014 for compliance of the above deficiencies pointed out by NCTE Hqrs.

- AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representations dated 14.06.2014 in response to NCTE Hars. deficiency letter dated 30.04.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 173rd Meeting held on 26th June 2014 considered the representation of the institution and as decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26692 dated 08.07.2014 on the following grounds:-
  - During granting recognition, the institution vide letter dated 21.02.2005 (i) committed that the college has earmarked a separate complete building for the Department of Education of the College of B.Ed. and separate psychology, Science lab, lecturers room and Library would be constructed in due course of time.

As per recognition order, the B.Ed. Deptt. shall be shift to its own building (ii) having separate campus within a period of 3 years.

As per VT report, the new building for the Department of education is under (iii) construction and the B.Ed. College is still functioning in the existing building of General College whereas the 08 years have already been elapsed. (iv)

Laboratories and Library is not available in the B.Ed. department.

All teaching faculty have been appointed on contractual basis for a period of less than one year. (vi)

No regular HOD has been appointed to supervise the work of the faculty.

Separate supporting staff for the B.Ed. department has not been appointed.

- (viii) Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh and Rs. 3.00 lakh are not submitted towards endowment fund and reserve fund respectively into joint account in the name of institution and RD, ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.
- AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had not submitted any representation in 5. response to show cause notice dated 08.07.2014 within the stipulated period to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 178th Meeting held on 11-12 December 2014 discussed the matter in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the
  - (i) During granting recognition, the institution vide letter dated 21.02.2005 committed that the college has earmarked a separate complete building for the Department of Education of the College of B.Ed. and separate psychology, Science lab, lecturers room and Library would be constructed in due course of time.
  - As per recognition order, the B.Ed. Deptt. shall be shift to its own building (ii) having separate campus within a period of 3 years.
  - (iii) As per VT report, the new building for the Department of education is under construction and the B.Ed. College is still functioning in the existing building of General college whereas the 08 years have already been elapsed.

- (v) All teaching faculty have been appointed on contractual basis for a period of less than one year.
- (vi) No regular HOD has been appointed to supervise the work of the faculty.
- (vii) Separate supporting staff for the B.Ed. department has not been appointed.
- (viii) Original FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakh and Rs. 3.00 lakh are not submitted towards endowment fund and reserve fund respectively into joint account in the name of institution and RD, ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar.

## In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

- 6. NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Tata College, Chaibasa, Singhbhum (West), Jharkhand-833202 (Code No. APE00292) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.
- 7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available at NCTE's website <a href="https://www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days of the issue of the order.
