## Order

WHEREAS Mahila College, Chaibasa, West Singhbhum, Jharkhand-833201 (Code No. APE00353) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 12.05.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- (i) The Institution shall ensure that one HOD and seven faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position before the commencement of academic session and a report to this effect shall be sent to the ERC within one month before the commencement of the academic session.
- (ii) The Institution shall ensure that all leachers are appointed on full time and regular basis as per NCTE norms.
- (iii) The institution shall submit a list of teachers duly counter signed by the competent authority of the affiliating University within one month of the commencement of the course.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that all the teachers and other staff are paid regular salary as per UGC/State Govt, pay scale and the acquaintance roll shall be sent to ERC, NCTE within 3 months of the commencement of the course.
- (v) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.
- (vi) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition.
- (vii) The Institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.
- 2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P. (PIL) No. 327 of 2011 has been filed by Shiv Shankar Munda Vs Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hars., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hars, issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-66/2014/NCTE/Insp./A86675 dated 01.05.2014 with the following observations:-
  - (i) The institution is deficient in respect of both infrastructural and instructional facilities.
  - (ii) The institution has not adhered to the prescribed norms and conditions of recognition relating to engagement of teaching and non-teaching staff.

- (iii) The institution does not maintain Reserve fund at all and Endowment fund is maintained in the name of institution for a period of two years from 20.09.2009 and it is also not being maintained in joint account with ERC, Bhubaneswar.
- 3. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 28.05.2014 in response to deficiency letter dated 01.05.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 171st Meeting held on 3-4 June 2014 considered the representation of the institution and found that non of the deficiencies are complied by the institution. As decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) to the institution was issued vide No. 26278 dated 17.06.2014.
  - The B.Ed. course is being conducted in one portion of the existing building of the general college namely the Mahila College. The existing B.Ed. block has nine room with a built up area of 3831 Sq. ft. which is less than the required 1500 Sq. Mts.
  - (ii) The multipurpose hall, staff room, common room for girls and boys and Art & Work Experience room are not available.
  - (iii) No land and building is specifically earmarked for the B.Ed. course.
  - (iv) One of the condition stipulated in the recognition order dated 12:05:2005 was that the institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition. The institution has failed to fulfill this condition even after more than eight years of recognition.
  - (v) The new building for B.Ed. Programme is under construction.

- 4. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 12.07.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 17.06.2014 to ERC, NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 174th Meeting held on 5th August 2014 considered the representation of the institution and as decided by ERC, Show Cause Notice u/s 17(1) was issued vide No. 26958 dated 18.08.2014 to the institution on the following grounds:-
  - (i) The B.Ed. course is being conducted in one portion of the existing building of the general college namely the Mahila College. The existing B.Ed. block has nine rooms with a built up area of 3831 Sq. ft. which is less than the required 1500 Sq. Mts.

- 5. AND WHEREAS the applicant institution had submitted its representation dated 30.08.2014 in response to show cause notice u/s 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 to ERC. NCTE. The Eastern Regional Committee in its 175th Meeting held on 9th September 2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hars, as well as the reply submitted by the institution. The matter was discussed in detail and observed that the institution is still having the following deficiencies which are contravened to the Norms and Standards prescribed in the Regulations of NCTE:-
  - (i) The B.Ed. course is being conducted in one portion of the existing building of the general college namely the Mahila College. The existing B.Ed. block has nine rooms with a built up area of 3831 Sq. ft. which is less than the required 1500 Sq. Mts.
  - (ii) The Multipurpose hall, staff room, common room for girls and boys and Art & Work Experience room are not available.
  - (iii) No land and building is specifically earmarked for the B.Ed. course.
  - (iv) One of the condition stipulated in the recognition order dated 12.05.2005 was that the institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition. The institution has failed to fulfill this condition even after more than eight years of recognition.
  - (v) Books in the library are only 748 which is less than the required 3000.

In view of the above, the committee decided as under:

The Committee concluded that the institution is running the B.Ed. course violating the NCTE Norms and Regulation 2009. The Committee, therefore, decided to withdraw the recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act. 1993 from the academic session 2015-2016.

- 6. NOW, THEREFORE, grant of recognition to Mahila College, Chalbasa, West Singhbhum, Jharkhand-833201 (Code No. APE00353) for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.
- 7. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, they may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act in the "Online mode" available at NCTE's website <a href="https://www.ncte-india.org">www.ncte-india.org</a> within 60 days of the issue of the order.
