ORDER

WHEREAS, the Graduate School College for Women, Jamshedpur, Sakchi, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand – 831001 (Code No.APE00355) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 10.12.2004 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfillment of some conditions mentioned therein.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P.(PIL) No.327 of 2011 filed by Shiv Shankar Muhda -Vs- Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No.93-30/2014/NCTE/Insp./A86677 dated 01.05.2014 on reasons mentioned therein.

3. AND WHEREAS after considering the matter in various meetings, the ERC in its 176th meeting held on 09.10.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqrs. as well as reply submitted by the institution dated 30.08.2014 in response to ERC's show cause notice U/S 17(1) dated 18.08.2014 and as decided by ERC, withdrawn order was issued to the institution vide No.27794 dated 13.11.2014 from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of Section 17(1) of NCTE Act 1993 on the following grounds.

- (i) The B.Ed department is located in a part of the college building with a covered area of 443 Sq. Mts. which is less than the required 1500 Sq. Mts. as per NCTE norms.
- (ii) The institution has failed to create the required instructional facilities. For instance, Science Resource Center does not have the required apparatuses and the required consumables and chemicals are not available. Psychology Resource Centre has not been created. No separate ICT Resource Centre has been set up. Art and Craft Resource Centre has not been created. No separate provision has been made for Health and Physical Education.
- (iii) The departmental library has a stock of 800 books which is less than the required 3000 as per NCTE norms.
- (iv) The University has recruited eight lectures on contractual basis for 11 months for the year 2013-14 and posted them in this college on 03.09.2013. The services of the staff are terminated after 11 months and fresh appointments are made in the beginning of a session. The institution has not appointed teaching faculty on regular basis till date.

4. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqrs. against the ERC's order dated 13.11.2014. The Appellate Authority vide order No.89-07/2015-Appeal/2nd Meeting-2015/3761 dt.05.05.2015 remanded back the case to ERC with a direction grant 3 months time from the date of issue of appeal orders to submit a status report on compliance of the norms of NCTE Regulations, 2014 by fulfilling the deficiencies mentioned in the withdrawal order dated 13.11.2014.

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5. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 188th meeting held on 19-20 May 2015 considered the appeal order dated 05.05.2015 along with original file of the institution and as decided by the ERC, a letter was issued to the institution dated 25.05.2015.

6. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 191st meeting held on 14-15 July 2015 considered the letter dated 26.05.2015 received from the Director of Higher Education, Government of Jharkhand committed that all such requirements along with appointment of full time faculty will be complied with as per new Regulation 2014 by 31.10.2015, wherein the ERC has decided as under:

- (i) Recognition of the institution be continued.
- (ii) Review the status will be taken up after 31st Oct.2015. Deficiency found if any, will be communicated to the institution, concerned University and State Government for compliance.
- (iii) If the institution fails to comply the deficiencies, further course of action shall be taken as per norms.

7. NOW THEREFORE, the recognition of the institution viz. **Graduate School College for Women, Jamshedpur, Sakchi, Jamshedpur, Jharkhand - 831001 (Code No.APE00355) for B.Ed. Course is allowed to continue.**
